Agate Lake

- This small lake is a great place to practice your paddling skills and enjoy some fishing. The ramp is open and the lake is full.

Agency Lake

- Henzel and Petric Park's boat ramps are open and boarding docks are installed.

Applegate Reservoir

- UPDATE: Hart-Tish, Copper and French Gulch boating access sites are open and have more than 50 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Ana Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open, and the fishing is good.

Antelope Reservoir (Malheur County)

- NEW: This boating access site is open. The gravel ramp is great for small boats and paddlecraft to launch. This is a nice place to paddle and fish.

Ben Irving Reservoir

- The boat ramp and the dock are open.

Beulah Reservoir

- Beulah Reservoir is 98% full. Water is approximately 24 feet over the end of the ramp.

Big Lake

- Big Lake West, Big Lake campgrounds, and Big Lake Day Use areas are open.

Blue River Reservoir

- The Saddle Dam boat ramp and Lookout boat ramp are both open. There is more than 20 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The reservoir is full.

Brownlee Reservoir

- The Hewitt Park boat ramp is open and the moorage and fishing docks are floating. The new vault toilet has been installed. There is approximately 36 feet of water at the end of the ramp.
- The Spring Recreation Campground and both boat ramps are open and the docks are installed. The water is approximately 18 feet over the end of the boat ramp.
- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is open. The water level is 26 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Farewell Bend State Park is open and water level is approximately 36 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open. There is approximately 54 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.

Bully Creek Reservoir

- Reservoir is full, and the docks are installed and floating.

Cape Kiwanda

- NEW: Construction will create limited access beginning in October until the spring of 2024. [Parks Department | Tillamook County OR](#)

Carmen Smith Reservoir

- The closure has been extended to the spring of 2025.

Chetco River

- US Army Corps of Engineers is scheduled to begin dredging at the Port of Brookings Harbor on June 10th. The work will be ongoing for 2-3 weeks and will intermittently impact access.

Chickahominy Reservoir

- The lake is nearly full, and the boat ramp is open.

Clackamas Lake

- UPDATE: Clackamas Lake Campground is now open. This small, shallow lake is a great place to go paddling.

Clackamas River

- Moore Creek, Sandstone, and Hole-in-the-Wall Boat Access sites are open. Areas along the Clackamas River are still heavily impacted by wildfire. Visitors are recommended to exercise caution if pulling out from non-designated areas.

Clear Lake (Linn County)

- The boating access is open for paddlecraft to launch.

Coast Fork-Willamette River

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dille Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025. Coffenbury Lake

- Fort Stevens State Park Boat Launch is open, and the lake is full

Columbia River

- UPDATE: Floating Restroom at Government Island near McGuire Island is installed.
- UPDATE: Umatilla Marina will be closed on June 23rd and 24th for Umatilla Landing Days. <https://www.umatillalandingdays.org/>
- Hammond Marina in Warrenton is open, with four launch lanes. There is a \$10 launch and parking fee. The moorage currently has a waiting list.
- Warrenton Marina at the Skipanon is open with two launch lanes. There is a \$10 launch and parking fee. The moorage currently has a waiting list.

- Chinook Landing pumpout and dump station is back online. More repairs to the electrical line are anticipated later in June, which will shut down the station for a day or two. [Check here](#) for updates.
- Port of The Dalles boat ramp, short-term tie-up dock, restroom and pumpout and dump station are open. The marine fuel station is operated by the Yacht Club and diesel is currently available.
- City of St. Helens Courthouse Docks are open and the pumpout and dump station are operational. There will be some construction in the park throughout the summer; however, access will remain open. The bull rails on the docks are in poor condition so larger vessel operators need to be cautious when tying up. Sand Island North and South are open.

Cooper Creek Reservoir

- NEW: The City of Sutherlin has installed two “SolarBees” near the dam. The devices improve water quality by turning over the water. Boaters should be cautious when operating in proximity of the equipment.
- Cooper Creek East and West boat ramps are open, and the docks are installed.

Coos Bay

- Empire Boat Ramp has one set of docks installed.
- Repairs are underway to the North Jetty. Construction is expected to last until December 2025. <https://www.nwp.usace.army.mil/Media/News-Releases/Article/3327429/corps-of-engineers-to-begin-critical-repairs-to-coos-bay-north-jetty-closes-roa/>
- The California Street boat ramp and docks are open.

Coquille River

- Coquille Boat Ramp is closed for launching but, paddlecraft can carry down to the water.
- Arago boat ramp is open. The Boarding docks are anticipated to be installed by the end of June.
- Coquille River Bass Derby starts June 3rd from 8:00 am through September 10th at 5:00 pm. Disabled veterans and children under 12 can register at any of the over-the-counter ticket outlets. Also, registration for veterans and children can be accomplished at Sturdivant Park or Bryant’s Boat ramp on Screening Days. [Port of Coquille River \(thepocrd.com\)](#)

Cottage Grove Reservoir

- Lakeside Boat Ramp is open, and the docks are floating. There is approximately 40 feet of water over the end of the ramp.

- Wilson Creek Boat Ramp is open. There is approximately seven feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Cougar Reservoir

- Slide Creek Campground is open; however, the water is approximately 25 feet below the bottom of the ramp. Paddlers can carry down, but the terrain is difficult.
- Echo Park remains closed. The water is approximately 25 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

Crane Prairie

- Crane Prairie and Rock Creek Boat Ramps and campgrounds are open, and the docks are installed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 86% full.
- Quinn River boat ramp and campgrounds are open.

Crescent Lake

- Crescent Lake Campground is open and the low water ramp is available. The reservoir is 20% full.

Crystal Creek

- Malone Springs Day Use is located approximately 45 minutes northwest of Klamath Falls. This small paddle access is part of the Upper Klamath Canoe Trail meandering through marshes and is part of the Upper Klamath National Wildlife Refuge. [Upper Klamath Canoe Trail in Oregon | Paddling.com](#)

Cullaby Lake (Warrenton)

- The Cullaby Lake Regatta is scheduled June 17th beginning at 10:00 am and runs through June 18th at 6:00am. [Columbia Outboard Racing Association | Astoria OR | Facebook](#)

Davis Lake

- East Davis Lake boat launch is open.
- The lake level is still very low. Limited boat launching is available at North Lava Flow Campground and the West Davis day use site.

Deschutes River

- Heritage Landing is open and the ramp is in the water.
- The Bull Bend boating access site and campground are open.
- The Wyeth boating access site is open.

- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day Use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. Detroit Lake

- NEW: Fireworks Over the Lake is scheduled for July 1st from 10:00 pm to 11:00 pm. [Detroit Lake Fireworks - Detroit Oregon](#)
- NEW: The Detroit Lake Marina pumpout and dump station are temporarily closed for repairs. The replacement part will be delivered early next week.
- The water level at State Park D is fluctuating at the bottom of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Hoover campground, Cove Creek Campground and Southshore have more than 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramps.
- Mongold upper boat ramp is open and docks are floating with 80 feet of water at the end of the low water ramp.
- Kane's Marina is open with 10 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- State Park G Loop has 25 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Dexter Reservoir

- Dexter State Park boat ramps will be closed on June 24th and 25th during the US Regional Masters Rowing Competition. - Lowell and Dexter State Park boat ramps are open except for event closure as noted above. The water is approximately 10 feet above the bottom of the ramps.

Diamond Lake

- The North End boat ramp and restrooms are open. The South End and Thielson View are still closed for the season.

Digit Point

- NEW: Digit Point campground and boat launch are scheduled to open July 1st.

Dorena Reservoir

- Baker Bay boat ramp is open and has more than 65 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Harms Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Dog Lake

- The Dog Lake Campground and boat launch are open.

Duncan Reservoir

- Silver Lake, off Highway 31, is open. This is a great location for paddling.

East Lake

- Hot Spring boat ramp is open.

Eel Lake

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

Emigrant Lake

- The lake is 68% full. The North ramp is open and the West ramp has one lane open. Take caution. The inflow of water is creating high levels of woody debris throughout the lake.

Estacada Lake

- Timber Park's nonmotorized boat launch is open. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid for by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass is available by calling or emailing: 503-464-8515, pgeparks@pgn.com.

Fall Creek Reservoir

- North Shore's low water ramp is open. The water is 21 feet over the end of the ramp. All other ramps are out of the water and gated for now.

Faraday Lake

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2024. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

Fern Ridge Reservoir

- Perkins Peninsula Park is temporarily closed and is being used for firefighting efforts. Parks - Lane County
- Fern Ridge Shores has more than six feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately nine feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

- Richardson Park Marina is open. There is approximately eight feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Foster Reservoir

- The Calkins Park boat ramp is open with approximately six feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Gedney Creek is open and there is 18 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- Sunnyside Boat ramp is open. The water is approximately 25 feet over the end of the ramp.

Fourmile Lake

- Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp is closed. The US Forest Service anticipates reopening in July. The reservoir is approximately 64% full.

Galesville Reservoir

- The Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The County has removed the docks for repair. The high water is floating woody debris, keep a lookout when boating.

Garrison Lake (Port Orford)

- NEW: The 12th Street boat ramp and docks are open.
- NEW: The Pinehurst gravel ramp is open. This is a great access site for paddlecraft to access the lake.

Gold Lake

- UPDATE: As of June 13, the road to Gold Lake is open for day use. The campground is closed. For updates, call the Gold Lake information line at 541-782-5235.

Grand Ronde River

- Mud Creek Campground and boat ramp are open. The water system will be turned on pending the results of system testing.

Green Peter Reservoir

- UPDATE: Reservoir levels have dropped another five feet. Thistle Creek still has approximately 70 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. Whitcomb has approximately 20 feet of water.
- Thistle Creek and Whitcomb Creek boat ramps are open. Boarding docks and the floating restrooms are installed. Keep watch for debris.

Green Point Reservoir/ Kinglsey Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

Haystack Reservoir

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 90% full. The boat ramp is open, and the docks are floating.

Heart Lake

- Heart Lake Landing is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Hells Canyon Reservoir

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

Henry Hagg Lake

- NEW: Take a Soldier (Veterans/Active-Duty) Fishing event is being held on June 17th from 5:00 am to 4:00 pm. Take a Soldier Fishing is a non-profit organization whose sole purpose is to provide outdoor fishing opportunities for veterans and active-duty military from any branch of the armed services. Volunteers with boats take them fishing for the day or assist with bank fishing. The event is free, including fishing licenses for the day. The organizers provide morning refreshments and lunch.
- Ramp A and C are open, and the reservoir is full.

Hills Creek Reservoir

- Packard Creek Boat Ramp is open and there is approximately 72 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Bingham boat ramp is open; however, the water is approximately seven feet below the bottom of the ramp.
- CT Beach is open. The water level is approximately six feet over the bottom of the ramp. This is a nice location for paddlers to carry down.

Holbrook Reservoir

- Holbrook Reservoir Campground is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Howard Prairie Reservoir

- UPDATE: The newly relocated Howard Prairie Marina and boat ramp are open! The water level is approximately 51% full. Grizzly Park, Klum Landing, and Willow Point campgrounds are open. Hyatt Lake

- NEW: C Loop ramp will open on June 16th.

- UPDATE: Wildcat Campground is open and has a small undeveloped boat ramp. The Mountain View boat ramp will open June 16.

John Day River

- There is some flooding between McDonald Crossing and J.S. Burres State Park. The boat ramp access remains open.

Kingsley Reservoir/Green Point Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

Lake Billy Chinook

- Perry South Day Use is open. Perry South Day Use, Cove Palisades Resort and Marina, Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps are open.

Lake Harriet

- Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are open.

Lake Marie

- Umpqua Lighthouse State Park is open to paddlecraft. This is a beautiful coastal lake for paddlers to explore. Paddlers can carry down and launch from the shoreline.

Lake of the Woods

- Aspen Point, Sunset Campground, and Rainbow Bay boating access sites are open.
- Lake of the Woods Resort is open <https://lakeofthewoodsresort.com/>.

Lake Owyhee Reservoir

- NEW: McCormack boat ramp is closed.
- UPDATE: The reservoir is full. Gordon Gulch and Indian Creek boat ramps are open, and docks are floating. The docks are open at Gordon Gulch and are out of alignment. State Parks is investigating repairs.
- Leslie Gulch boat ramp is open.

Lake Simtustus

- Pelton Park Marina and boat launch are open.

- Reservations for Indian Park Campground are now available online through the Warm Springs Fisheries Department. [Indian Park Camping – Check Availability – Department of Fisheries \(warmsprings-nsn.gov\)](http://www.warmsprings-nsn.gov)

Lava Lake

- Lava Lake campground, boating access, and docks are open.

Lofton Reservoir

- Lofton Reservoir is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Rd (Forest Road 3790). The small boat ramp and shore provide easy access for small boats and paddlecraft.

Lookout Point Reservoir

- UPDATE: Black Canyon water level is approximately 20 feet below the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Water is approximately 60 feet over the end of the Signal Point boat ramp.

Loon Lake

- Loon Lake Recreation Site is now open. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year around. Paddlecraft can carry down from the day use area.

Lost Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: Joseph Steward and Takelma boating access sites have more than 40 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramps.

Luckiamute River

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

McKenzie River

- Frisell, Paradise, McKenzie Bridge, Bruckart Landing, Hamlin, Forest Glen, Finn Rock, Helfrich Landing, Goodpasture, Greenwood Landing, Leaburg Landing, Deerhorn Landing, Hendricks Bridge, Bellinger Landing, Hayden Bridge, and Armitage are all open.
- Silver Creek Boat Launch is open. Please be careful. The viewing platform has not yet been rebuilt since the Holiday Farm Fire.
- Approximately ¼ mile below Ollalie Campground there is a full-spanning strainer. To find or report boating obstructions or hazards [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](http://arcgis.com)
- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park's single boat ramp is open. The facilities have a restroom, road, and parking, but no other amenities due to the Holiday Fire.

Mercer Lake

- Mercer Lake Landing is open.

Middle Fork Willamette River

- The Middle Fork boat ramp near the Dexter Dam will be closed beginning September 11, 2023, through the summer of 2026. The exact construction completion date is currently unknown. The closure is for an upgrade to the Dexter Fish Facility.
- The Westfir take out, also known as Turtle Island Park, is on the North Fork of the Middle Fork and is open for the season.
- Pengra Access ramp is open.

Morgan Lake

- Morgan Lake boating access is open.

Munsel Lake

- Munsel Lake boating access is open.

Neawana Creek

- Broadway Park boating access is open.

Necanicum River

- Quatat Marine Park and Cartwright Park boating access sites in Seaside are open.

Nehalem River

- NEW: The Nestucca, Trask, Wilson, and Nehalem water levels are getting too low to safely drift boat. Lower drifts are still floatable, but drift boats should expect to drag in a few spots.

- NEW: The Nestucca, Trask, Wilson, and Nehalem water levels are getting too low to safely drift boat. Lower drifts are still floatable, but drift boats should expect to drag in a few spots.

North Fork Reservoir

- Promontory Park and North Fork's lower launch are open.

North Santiam River

- NEW: Greens Bridge access is closed for the summer. Anglers who wish to launch or retrieve from this site must apply for a key by calling the local ODFW office at 541-757-4186 and provide your fishing license number.
- NEW: Greens Bridge to Jefferson is very dangerous. Jefferson Fire District recommends staying off this section of the river. There are very large strainers,

strong currents, cold water, undercurrents/whirlpools, and low head dams. Please plan for alternate access put-ins and take-out access points ahead of time as part of your regular trip planning. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](https://arcgis.com)

- The Buell Miller boat ramp is open.
- Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open; however, there will be no sanitation available. Please plan ahead. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](https://arcgis.com)
- Lyons-Mehama and Stayton Bridge boat ramps are open.

North Twin Lake

- The campground and boating access are open.

North Umpqua River

- Horseshoe Bend Campground is open.
- Boulder Flat raft launch, Horseshoe Bend raft launch and Gravel Bin are all open.

Ochoco Lake

- The reservoir is 71% full. The boat launch is open, and four docks are floating.

Odell Lake

- Sunset Cove is open.

Olalla Reservoir

- The boat launch is open, and the reservoir is full.

Paulina Lake

- Hazard tree inspectors identified more than 300 hazard trees within Paulina Lake Campground. Crews removed a majority of these trees last fall; however, some hazard tree removal work remains. The remaining hazard tree work will resume as soon as snow levels allow. In anticipation of this work, the opening date for Paulina Lake Campground will be delayed by two weeks to June 30. Phillips Reservoir

- NEW: Union Creek boat ramp and docks are in the water and open.
- NEW: Mason boat ramp is in the water.
- NEW: Southwest Shore Campground is open and paddlers can carry down to launch on the shore. This site is near marsh area with lots of birds.

- NEW: Social Security Point is open and paddlers can carry down or if you have high clearance, vehicles can launch off the beach area.
- NEW: Black Mountain Road, aka Southwest Shore, is open. Paddlers or small boats can launch for the rustic gravel ramp.

Pilcher Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: Pilcher Creek ramp is open, the docks are floating and reservoir is full.

Pine Hollow Reservoir

- The 53rd Annual NW Radio Control Seaplane Championship is scheduled from June 23rd beginning at 8:00 am through June 25th at 3:00 pm.

Plat I Reservoir

- NEW: Father's Day Weekend (June 16-18) is the "Float and Fly" RC airplane and boat enthusiast weekend.
- The reservoir is full and open for recreation.

Prineville Reservoir

- Prineville State Park Day Use is open. The boarding docks and moorage dock are damaged and are in the process of being repaired.
- The Powderhouse Cove ramp is open, and the dock is installed.
- Prineville reservoir is full. The Bureau of Reclamation is expecting to surcharge the reservoir, resulting in levels in excess of six feet above full pool. Be cautious when using the swim area as it is collecting debris.

Rogue River

- NEW: Rogue Valley Kennel Club Dog Show will be at Indian Mary Park Friday, June 16th beginning at 2:00 pm through Monday, June 19th at noon. This is a private event and will use the entire park. The boat ramp will be closed to the public and no put-in or take-out will be available here. Hog Creek or Ennis Riffle access are both available.
- The Rooster Crow Hydroplane Race is scheduled for June 24th from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm. The race will be between Savage Creek to the I-5 twin bridges.
- Port of Gold Beach is hosting the 2023 North American Jet Boat Championship. [2023 North American Jet Boat Championship | Facebook](#)
- Access at Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to impacts from the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek boat launch is accessible via Lower Grave Creek Rd.

- Casey, Rogue Elk, Shady Cove, Dodge Bridge, TouVelle State Park, Valley of the Rogue State Park, Dees Landing (Coyote Evans Wayside), Pierce Riffle, Chinook Park, Baker Park, Schroeder, Lathrop Landing, Matson, Griffin Park, Ferry Hole, Robertson Bridge, Hog Creek, Indian Mary, Ennis Riffle, Galice, Rand and Alameda boating access are all open.

Sandy River

- NEW: Oxbow Regional Park has two accessible parking spaces near the bottom of the boat launch.

Siletz River

- UPDATE: The obstructions located approximately 1 mile downstream of Moonshine Park have been removed! Moonshine Boat Ramp is open.
- Old Mill Park is open, and the ramp is in the water.
- Hee Hee Ilahee is open, and the ramp is in the water.

Siltcoos Lake

- NEW: Darlings Marina Independence Day Celebration is scheduled for July 1st from 10:00 pm to 11:00 pm. [Florence, OR RV Park Camping — Darlings Marina & RV Resort \(darlingsresortrv.com\)](http://darlingsresortrv.com)
- Westlake County Park is open

Siuslaw River
