Agate Lake

- This small lake is a great place to practice your paddling skills and enjoy some fishing. The ramp is open, and the lake is full.

Agency Lake

- Henzel and Petric Park's boat ramps are open and boarding docks are installed.

Applegate Reservoir

- NEW: Rogue Valley Bassmasters fishing tournament is June 3rd beginning at 6:00 am and runs through June 4th at 3:00 pm. [Home \(roguevalleybass.com\)](#)
- Hart-Tish, Copper and French Gulch boating access sites are open and have more than 55 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Ana Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open, and fishing has been good.

Ben Irving Reservoir

- The boat ramp and dock are open.

Beulah Reservoir

- Beulah Reservoir is full. Water is approximately 24 feet over the end of the ramp.

Big Lake

- UPDATE: Big Lake West and Big Lake campgrounds, Big Lake Day Use are open.

Blue River Reservoir

- Saddle Dam boat ramp and Lookout boat ramp are open. There is more than 20 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The reservoir is full.

Brownlee Reservoir

- NEW: Hewitt and Holcomb Parks annual Creating Memories Fishing Tournament for Disabled Children is scheduled for June 5th from 5:30 am – 5:00 pm.

- UPDATE: The Hewitt Park boat ramp is open, and the moorage and fishing docks are floating. The new vault toilet has been installed. There is approximately 35ft of water at the end of the ramp.
- The Spring Recreation Campground and both boat ramps are open, and docks are installed. The water is approximately 18 feet over the end of the boat ramp.
- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is open. The water level is 26 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Farewell Bend State Park is open and water level is approximately 36 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open. There is approximately 47 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.

Bully Creek Reservoir

- The water is approximately 35 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp. The docks are installed and floating.

Cape Kiwanda

- NEW: Construction will create limited access from October 2023 until the spring of 2024. [Parks Department | Tillamook County OR](#)

Carmen Smith Reservoir

- The closure has been extended to the spring of 2025.

Chickahominy Reservoir

- The lake is nearly full, and the boat ramp is open.

Clackamas Lake

- UPDATE: 2023 opening is delayed due to issues with the water systems. Plan ahead. When Timothy Lake campgrounds are full, consider going to Clackamas Lake and enjoy paddling.

Clackamas River

- Moore Creek, Sandstone, and Hole-in-the-Wall Boating Access sites are open. Areas along the Clackamas River are still heavily impacted by wildfire. Visitors are recommended to exercise caution if pulling out at non-designated areas.

Clear Lake (Linn County)

- Boat access is open for paddlecraft.

Coast Fork-Willamette River

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025. Coffenbury Lake

- Fort Stevens State Park Boat Launch is open, and the lake is full.

Columbia River

- NEW: Port of The Dalles boat ramp, short-term tie-up dock, the restroom and the pumpout and dump station are open. The marine fuel station is operated by the Yacht Club and diesel is currently available.

- NEW: Umatilla Marina will be closed June 23rd and 24th for a community event.
- UPDATE: Chinook Landing pumpout and dump station is shut off while repairs to the electric line are completed. Anticipated reopening is June 3rd.
- City of St. Helens Courthouse Docks are open and the pumpout and dump station are operational. There will be some construction in the park throughout the summer; however, access will remain open. Bull rails on the docks are in poor condition and larger vessel operators need to be careful tying up. Sand Island North and South are open.

Cooper Creek Reservoir

- Cooper Creek East and West boat ramps are open, and the docks are installed.

Coos Bay

- Empire Boat Ramp has one set of docks installed.
- Repairs are occurring to the North Jetty. Construction to last until December 2025. <https://www.nwp.usace.army.mil/Media/News-Releases/Article/3327429/corps-of-engineers-to-begin-critical-repairs-to-coos-bay-north-jetty-closes-roa/>
- The California Street boat ramp and docks are open.

Coquille River

- NEW: Coquille Boat Ramp is closed for launching but paddle craft can carry down to the water.
- NEW: Arago boat ramp is open. The Boarding docks are anticipated to be installed by mid-June.
- NEW: Coquille River Bass Derby starts June 3rd beginning at 8:00 am through September 10th ending at 5:00 pm. Disabled veterans and children under 12 can register at any of the over-the-counter ticket outlets. Also, registration for veterans and children can be accomplished at Sturdivant Park or Bryant's Boat ramp on Screening Days. [Port of Coquille River \(thepocrd.com\)](http://thepocrd.com)

Cottage Grove Reservoir

- Lakeside Boat Ramp is open, and the docks are floating. There is approximately 40 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- Wilson Creek Boat Ramp is open. There is approximately seven feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your

trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Cougar Reservoir

- UPDATE: Slide Creek Campground is open; however, the water is approximately 35 feet below the bottom of the ramp. Paddlers can carry down but the terrain is difficult.
- Echo Park remains closed. The water is approximately 35 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

Crane Prairie

- NEW: Rogue Valley Bassmasters fishing tournament is June 3rd from 6:00 am, through June 4th at 3:00 pm. [Tournament Schedule \(roguevalleybass.com\)](http://roguevalleybass.com)
- UPDATE: Crane Prairie and Rock Creek Boat Ramps and campgrounds are open, and the docks are installed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 86% full.
- UPDATE: Quinn River boat ramp and campgrounds are open.

Crescent Lake

- NEW: Crescent Lake Campground is open, and the low-water ramp is available. The reservoir is 18% full.

Crystal Creek

- Malone Springs Day Use is located approximately 45 minutes northwest of Klamath Falls. This small paddle access is part of the Upper Klamath Canoe Trail that meanders through marshes and is part of the Upper Klamath National Wildlife Refuge. Davis Lake

- NEW: East Davis Lake boat launch is open.
- The lake level is still very low. Limited boat launching is available at North Lava Flow Campground and West Davis day use site.

Deschutes River

- NEW: Heritage Landing is open, and the ramp is in the water. On June 13th and 14th from 9 am until 5 pm, there will be a multi-agency oil spill deployment exercise on Deschutes River to the Columbia River. The exercise will create some anticipated congestion. The sand bar at the mouth of the Deschutes may result in reduced access to the Columbia River during periods of low water.
- NEW: Bull Bend boating access site and campground are open.

- NEW: The Wyeth boating access is open.
- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day Use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. Detroit Lake

- The water level at State Park D is fluctuating at the bottom of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on to and off your trailer which can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp, causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Hoover campground, Cove Creek campground and Southshore have more than 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramps.
- Mongold upper boat ramp is open, and the docks are floating.
- Kane's Marina is open with 10 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- State Park G Loop has 25 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Dexter Reservoir

- NEW: Dexter State Park boat ramps will be closed June 24th and 25th during the US Regional Masters Rowing Competition. [2023 USRowing Northwest Masters Regional Championships \(eugenecascadescoast.org\)](https://www.eugenecascadescoast.org/2023-US-Rowing-Northwest-Masters-Regional-Championships)
- Lowell and Dexter State Park boat ramps are open except for event closure as noted above. Water is approximately 10 feet above the bottom of the ramps.

Diamond Lake

- The North End boat ramp and restrooms are open. The South End and Thielson View are still closed for the season.

Dorena Reservoir

- Baker Bay boat ramp is open and has more than 65 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Harms Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Dog Lake

- Dog Lake Campground and Boat launch are open.

Duncan Reservoir

- Located near Silver Lake off Highway 31 is open. This is a great location for paddling.

East Lake

- NEW: Hot Spring boat ramp is open.

Eel Lake

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

Emigrant Lake

- UPDATE: The lake is 72% full. The North ramp is open, and the West Ramp has one lane open. Use caution. The inflow of water is creating high levels of woody debris throughout the lake.

Estacada Lake

- Timber Park nonmotorized boat launch is open. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid for by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass available by calling or emailing: 503-464-8515, pgeparks@pgn.com.

Fall Creek Reservoir

- North Shore low water ramp is open. Water is 21 feet over the end of the ramp. All other ramps are out of the water and gated, for now.

Faraday Lake

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2023. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

Fern Ridge Reservoir

- NEW: Perkins Peninsula Park is temporarily closed and is being used for fire mitigation. Parks - Lane County
- Fern Ridge Shores has more than six feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately nine feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Richardson Park marina is open. There is approximately eight feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Foster Reservoir

- Calkins Park Boat Ramp is open with approximately six feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- Gedney Creek is open with 18 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- Sunnyside Boat ramp is open. The water is approximately 25 feet over the end of the ramp.

Fourmile Lake

- Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are closed. The US Forest Service anticipates reopening in July. The reservoir is approximately 60% full.

Galesville Reservoir

- Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The County has removed the docks for repair. The high water is floating significant woody debris. keep a lookout when boating.

Gold Lake

- Access is closed from the Cedar Creek Fire Emergency. The Forest Order identifies the closure is in effect through June 25, 2023, unless rescinded sooner. [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](#). As of May 19, US Forest Service is requesting people not to drive on closed roads. They are monitoring snow and road conditions and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. For updates, call the Gold Lake information line at 541-782-5235.

Green Peter Reservoir

- Thistle Creek and Whitcomb Creek boat ramps are open. Boarding docks are available. The floating restrooms are installed. Keep a watch for debris.

Green Point Reservoir/ Kinglsey Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

Haystack Reservoir

- NEW: High Desert Show Down 1000 Foot Drag Boat Races will be held on June 9th, beginning at 8:00 am through June 11th at 6:00 pm. [Drag Boat Racing | Columbia Drag Boat Association | United States \(cdbaracing.com\)](#)
- UPDATE: The boat ramp is open, and the docks are floating. The reservoir is 71% full.

Heart Lake

- Heart Lake Landing is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Hells Canyon Reservoir

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

Henry Hagg Lake

- NEW: I'm Hooked Inc. Great Outdoor Experience is being held on June 3rd, from 7:00 am through June 4th at 5:00 pm. This Event will include fishing education, water safety, boat and shoreline fishing, boat education, health & wellness experience, outdoor education experiences, and medical safety training. - Ramps A and C are open, and the reservoir is full.

Hills Creek Reservoir

- Packard Creek Boat Ramp is open and there is approximately 72 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Bingham boat ramp is open; however, water is approximately seven feet below the bottom of the ramp.
- CT Beach is open. The water level is approximately six feet over the bottom of the ramp. This is a nice location for paddlers to carry down.

Holbrook Reservoir

- Holbrook Reservoir Campground is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790)

Howard Prairie Reservoir

- UPDATE: Howard Prairie Marina opens on June 2. Please take caution when boating in the area. The water level is approximately 52% full.
- Grizzly Park, Klum Landing, and Willow Point campgrounds are open. Boat Ramps remain closed due to low water. [Grizzly Park at Howard Prairie Lake \(jacksoncountyor.org\)](https://jacksoncountyor.org)

Hyatt Lake

- The lake is 59% full. Water is at the bottom of the C Loop ramp; however, it remains closed due to snowpack. BLM anticipates opening the C Loop ramp and Wildcat Campground for Memorial Day Weekend. John Day River

- NEW: There is flooding between McDonald Crossing and J.S. Burres State Park. Boat ramp access remains open.

Kinglsey Reservoir/Green Point Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

Lake Billy Chinook

- NEW: Festival of the Land is being held on June 3rd during OPRD's Free Camping Weekend, with free day-use parking or shuttle service for the event on Saturday. The hours of the event are from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm in the Crooked River Day Use Area. - [Oregon State Parks](#)
- Perry South Day Use is open.
- Cove Palisades Resort and Marina are open for the summer.
- Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps are open.

Lake Harriet

- Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are open.

Lake Marie

- Umpqua Lighthouse State Park is open to paddlecraft. Paddlers must carry down because there is no formal launch or dock.

Lake of the Woods

- Aspen Point, Sunset Campground, and Rainbow Bay boating access sites are open.
- Lake of the Woods Resort is open. <https://lakeofthewoodsresort.com/>

Lake Owyhee Reservoir

- NEW: Gordon Gulch dock is scheduled for adjustment after June 6th. Until then, use caution because the dock is currently out of alignment.
- UPDATE: The reservoir is 80% full. Gordon Gulch and Indian Creek boat ramps are open, and the docks are floating.
- Leslie Gulch boat ramp is open.

Lake Simtustus

- Pelton Park Marina and Boat launch are open.
- Reservations for Indian Park Campground are now available online through the Warm Springs Fisheries Department. [Indian Park Camping – Check Availability – Department of Fisheries \(warmsprings-nsn.gov\)](#)

Lava Lake

- NEW: Lava Lake boating access and docks are open; however, the campground is closed.

Lofton Reservoir

- Fees are being collected at a rate of \$6/night for a single unit and \$2/night per extra vehicle. Lofton Reservoir is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Rd (Forest Road 3790).

Lookout Point Reservoir

- UPDATE: Signal Point Ramp will be closed from June 4th beginning at 4:00 pm through June 5th at 5 pm for construction.
- Black Canyon water level is approximately five feet below the boat ramp.

Loon Lake

- UPDATE: Loon Lake Recreation Site is now open. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year around. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

Lost Creek Reservoir

- Joseph Steward and Takelma boating access sites have more than 50 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramps.

Luckiamute River

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

McKenzie River

- Frisell, Paradise, McKenzie Bridge, Bruckart Landing, Hamlin, Forest Glen, Finn Rock, Helfrich Landing, Goodpasture, Greenwood Landing, Leaburg Landing, Deerhorn Landing, Hendricks Bridge, Bellinger Landing, Hayden Bridge, and Armitage are all open
- Silver Creek Boat Launch is open. Please be careful as the viewing platform has not yet been rebuilt since the Holiday Farm Fire.
- Approximately ¼ mile below Ollalie Campground there is a full-spanning strainer. To find or report boating obstructions or hazards visit: [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](#).
- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park: The single boat ramp is open. There are no park facilities except a restroom, road, and parking due to the Holiday Fire.

Mercer Lake

- Mercer Lake Landing is open.

Middle Fork Willamette River

- The Middle Fork boat ramp near the Dexter Dam will be closed beginning September 11, 2023, through Summer 2026. The exact construction completion date is currently unknown. The closure is for the Dexter Fish Facility Upgrade.
- The Westfir Take Out, also known as Turtle Island Park, is on the North Fork of the Middle Fork Willamette River is open for the season.
- Pengra Access ramp is open.

Morgan Lake

- Morgan Lake boating access is open.

Munsel Lake

- Munsel Lake boating access is open.

Neawana Creek

- Broadway Park boating access is open.

Necanicum River

- Quatat Marine Park and Cartwright Park boating access sites in Seaside are open.

North Fork Reservoir

- Promontory Park and North Fork Lower Launch are open.

North Santiam River

- Buell Miller Boat Ramp is open.
- Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open; however, there will be no sanitation available. Please plan ahead. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](https://arcgis.com)
- Lyons-Mehama and Stayton Bridge boat ramps are open.

North Twin Lake

- The campground and boating access are open.

North Umpqua River

- Boulder Flat raft launch, Horseshoe Bend raft launch and Gravel Bin are open. Horseshoe Bend campground is closed.

Ochoco Lake

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 73% full. The boat launch is open, and four docks are floating.

Odell Lake

- Sunset Cove is open.

Olalla Reservoir

- The boat launch is open, and the reservoir is full.

Paulina Lake

- Hazard tree inspectors identified more than 300 hazard trees within Paulina Lake Campground. Crews removed a majority of these trees last fall; however, some hazard tree removal work remains. The remaining hazard tree work will resume as soon as snow levels permit this spring. In anticipation of this work, the opening date for Paulina Lake Campground will be delayed by two weeks to June 30. Pilcher Creek Reservoir

- Pilcher Creek site is open, and the reservoir is 75% full.

Plat I Reservoir

- The reservoir is full and open for recreation.

Prineville Reservoir

- NEW: 13th Annual Rip-N-Lips Invitational bass tournament to raise money for Wildland Firefighter Foundation will be held June 3rd from 5:00 am to 3:00 pm. [American Power Boat Association | Boat Racing USA \(apba.org\)](https://www.apba.org/)
- Prineville State Park Day Use is open. The boarding docks are damaged and being repaired. The Moorage Dock is not installed.
- Powderhouse Cove ramp is open, and dock installed.
- Prineville reservoir is full. The Bureau of Reclamation is expecting to surcharge the reservoir, resulting in levels in excess of six feet above full pool. Be cautious when using the swim area as it is collecting debris.

Rogue River

- Access at Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek boat launch is accessible via Lower Grave Creek Road.
- Casey, Rogue Elk, Shady Cove, Dodge Bridge, TouVelle State Park, Valley of the Rogue State Park, Dees Landing (Coyote Evans Wayside), Pierce Riffle, Chinook Park, Baker Park, Schroeder, Lathrop Landing, Matson, Griffin Park, Ferry Hole, Robertson Bridge, Hog Creek, Indian Mary, Ennis Riffle, Galice, Rand and Alameda boating access are all open.

Siletz River

- Moonshine Boat Ramp in Lodgsen is closed. There is a tree approximately one mile downstream of Moonshine Park that spans the river. Due to high water levels, obstruction cannot be removed at this time. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](#)

Siuslaw River

- Bender Landing, Deadwood, Farnham, Mapleton, Schindler, Tiernan, Konnie Memorial, Tide County Parks and Linslaw are open.
- The Port of Siuslaw boat ramp is open and boom logs have been removed for the season.

Smith and Bybee Lake

- NEW: The vegetation in the lake is still manageable for paddling.

Snake River

- UPDATE: Ontario State Park boarding docks have some broken decking. Use caution when using the dock. Repairs are anticipated to occur in June.

- Dug Bar and Pittsburg Landing Campground are all open.
- Hells Canyon Creek boat launch is closed.

South Santiam River

- Waterloo County Boat Ramp is open

Spring Creek

- NEW: Collier Memorial Park and Spring Creek Day Use are open.

Summit Lake

- UPDATE: Summit Lake is closed due to snowpack. The tentative opening is June 9th, depending on snow conditions.

Suttle Lake

- Blue Bay, Link Creek, South Shore and Suttle Lake Boating access sites are open, and docks are installed.

Tahkenitch Lake

- Tahkenitch boat ramp is damaged and is temporarily closed. The U.S. Forest Service is converting several campsites in the campground to day-use only to help accommodate boating access.

Tenmile Lake

- UPDATE: Tenmile County Ramp ramps are open; however, sidewalk construction continues.

Thief Valley Reservoir

- Thief Valley Reservoir is full, and the boat ramp is open. The dock has been installed.

Thompson Reservoir

- Eastbay campground is open. Fees are being collected at a rate of \$10 per night for a single unit and \$5 per night per extra vehicle.
- Thompson Reservoir Campground is open. Fees are being collected at a rate of \$6 per night for a single unit and \$2 per night per extra vehicle.

Tillamook Bay

- Both floating restrooms are installed.
- Upland public Restroom Remodel scheduled to be completed by mid-June.

Timothy Lake

- North Arm, Oak Fork, Pine Point, and West Shore Day Use areas are open.

Triangle Lake

- Triangle Lake Park is open.

Trojan Pond

- Trojan Park is open year-round for paddling and day use.

Tualatin River

- UPDATE: The Stark (Rivergrove) Boat Launch is open. Please obey posted hours.
- The Rood Bridge Park boat launch is open.
- The Farmington Boat Launch restroom building is closed. Portable restrooms are available.

Turner Lake

- North Turner Lake is open.

Umpqua River

- NEW: Pickett Park vault toilet is open. The park will be closed from June 12th to June 20th for paving.
- Scottsburg Park ramp is open, and docks are installed.

Upper Klamath Lake

- The floating restroom is installed near Bare Island.
- Odessa campground, Rocky Point Boat Launch and Wocus Bay ramp and docks are open.

Unity Reservoir

- The reservoir is full and the State Park boat ramp and docks are open.

Waldo Lake

- Access is closed from the Cedar Creek Fire Emergency. The Forest Order identifies the closure is in effect through June 25, 2023, unless rescinded sooner. [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](#). As of May 19, U.S. Forest Service is requesting people not to drive on closed roads. Wallowa Lake

- Wallowa County Park and Wallowa Lake State Park are open, and docks are floating.

Warm Springs Reservoir

- The boating access is open, and the reservoir is full.

Wickiup Reservoir

- Gull Point and Reservoir Campground Boating access is closed for 2023 so the U.S. Forest Service can address 679 hazardous trees. [Deschutes National Forest - News & Events \(usda.gov\)](#)
- North Wickiup Boating access is open. The fish cleaning station is not open yet. The reservoir is 58% full.

Lower Willamette (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)

- NEW: PGE will begin flashboard installation at Willamette Falls during the week of June 19. Construction activities will affect the flow and upstream pool elevation in the weeks before the flashboard installation. During the week of June 5, low pool elevation will occur to complete repairs to one of the bags of the flow control structure. During the week of June 12, low pool elevation will occur to clear debris from the Falls and concrete cap. All activities may result in debris falling to lower areas of the Falls. For everyone's safety, PGE requests that boaters remain clear of active construction areas until the flashboard installation is complete.

- Sportcraft Landing, the boat ramp, boarding docks and lower parking area are open. The ODOT bridge contractor is working. Watch for barges and work boats in the area.

- Jon Storm Park dock, restrooms and pumpout and dump station are open, but the parking lot will be closed until completion of the I-205 bridge widening project.

Middle Willamette (Willamette Falls to Salem)

- NEW: Riverview Park will be closed from July 1st through July 4th for the annual Independence Days celebration. There will be no vehicle access to the park and boaters are strongly encouraged to choose a different take-out location for that weekend. The Sports Park motorized ramp will remain open.
- NEW: Wallace Marine Park docks were installed on June 1st.
