Agate Lake

- UPDATE: This small lake is a great place to practice your paddling skills and enjoy some fishing. The ramp is open, and the lake is 86% full.

Agency Lake

- Henzel and Petric Park's boat ramps are open and boarding docks are installed.

Applegate Reservoir

- UPDATE: Hart-Tish, Copper and French Gulch boating access sites are open and have more than 45 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Ana Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open, and fishing has been good.

Antelope Reservoir (Malheur County)

- This boating access is open. The gravel ramp is great for small boats and paddlecraft. This is a nice place to paddle and fish.

Ben Irving Reservoir

- Boat ramp and dock open.

Beulah Reservoir

- Beulah Reservoir is full. Water is approximately 24 feet over the end of the ramp.

Big Lake

- Big Lake West and Big Lake campgrounds, Big Lake Day Use are open.

Blue River Reservoir

- UPDATE: Water levels continue to subside. Saddle Dam boat ramp is open with approximately 50 feet of water over the end of the ramp. Lookout boat ramp is open with approximately 15 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Brownlee Reservoir

- The Hewitt Park boat ramp is open, and the moorage and fishing docks are floating. The new vault toilet has been installed. There is approximately 36 feet of water at the end of the ramp.
- The Spring Recreation Campground and both boat ramps are open, and docks are installed. The water is approximately 18 feet over the end of the boat ramp.
- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is open. The water level is 26 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Farewell Bend State Park is open and water level is approximately 36 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open. There is approximately 54 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.

Bully Creek Reservoir

- Reservoir is full, and the docks are installed and floating.

Campbell Lake

- NEW: Campbell Lake campground and boat ramp are now open.

Cape Kiwanda

- Construction will create limited access from October 2023 until Spring of 2024. [Parks Department | Tillamook County OR](#)

Carmen Smith Reservoir

- The closure has been extended to the spring of 2025.

Cheadle Lake

Chetco River

- UPDATE: US Army Corps of Engineers are scheduled to begin dredging at the Port of Brookings Harbor in July. The work will be ongoing for 2-3 weeks and will intermittently affect access.

Chickahominy Reservoir

- The lake is nearly full, and the boat ramp is open.

Clackamas Lake

- Clackamas Lake Campground is now open. This small, shallow lake is a great place to go paddling.

Clackamas River

- Moore Creek, Sandstone, and Hole-in-the-Wall Boat Access sites are open. Areas along the Clackamas River are still heavily impacted by wildfire. Visitors are recommended to exercise caution if pulling out at non-designated areas.

Clear Lake (Linn County)

- Boat access is open for paddlecraft.

Coast Fork-Willamette River

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025. Coffenbury Lake

- Fort Stevens State Park Boat Launch is open, and the lake is full.

Columbia River

- Port of The Dalles boat ramp, short-term tie-up dock, restroom and pumpout and dump station are open. The marine fuel station is operated by the Yacht Club offers both diesel and gasoline.
- M. James Gleason restroom facility is currently closed. Portable toilets are available while repairs are underway.

- Floating Restroom at Government Island near McGuire Island is installed.
- Hammond Marina in Warrenton is open. Moorage currently has a waiting list.
- Warrenton Marina is open Moorage currently has a waiting list.
- Chinook Landing pumpout and dump station is online.
- City of St. Helens Courthouse Docks are open and the pumpout and dump station are operational. There will be some construction in the park throughout the summer, however access will remain open. Bull rails on the docks are in poor condition – larger vessels should take caution. Sand Island North and South are open.

Cooper Creek Reservoir

- The City of Sutherlin has installed two “SolarBees” near the dam. They are to improve water quality by turning over the water. Boaters should be cautious when operating near that area, and to avoid this equipment.
- Cooper Creek East and West boat ramps are open, and the docks are installed.

Coos Bay

- Empire Boat Ramp has one set of docks installed.
- Repairs to North Jetty. Construction to last until December 2025.

- The California Street boat ramp and docks are open.

Coquille River

- Arago boat ramp is open. The boarding docks are installed.
- Coquille Boat Ramp is closed for launching but, paddle craft can carry down to the water.
- Coquille River Bass Derby starts June 3rd, 8:00 am through September 10th, 5:00 pm. Disabled Veterans and Children under 12 Can register at any of the over-the-counter ticket outlets. Cottage Grove Reservoir

- Lakeside Boat Ramp is open, and docks are floating. There is approximately 40 feet of water over the end of the ramp.

- Wilson Creek Boat Ramp is open. There is approximately seven feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Cougar Reservoir

- Slide Creek Campground is open; however, the water is approximately 25 feet below the bottom of the ramp. Paddlers can carry down, but the terrain is difficult.
- Echo Park remains closed. The water is approximately 25 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

Crane Prairie

- NEW: Browns Mountain ramp is open.
- NEW: Quinn River boat launch is now open.
- Crane Prairie Day Use and Rock Creek Boat Ramps and campgrounds are open, and the docks are installed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 87% full.

Crescent Lake

- NEW: Spring boat launch is closed due to damage.
- Crescent Lake Campground is open, and the low water launch is available. The reservoir is 20% full.

Crystal Creek

- Malone Springs Day Use is located approximately 45 minutes northwest of Klamath Falls. This small paddle access is part of the Upper Klamath Canoe Trail that meanders through marshes and is part of the Upper Klamath National Wildlife Refuge. Cultus Lake

- NEW: Cultus Lake campground and ramp are now open.

Davis Lake

- East Davis Lake boat launch is open.
- Lake level is still very low. Limited boat launching is available at North Lava Flow Campground and West Davis day use site.

Deadhorse Lake

- Deadhorse Lake Campground and ramp are open.

Deschutes River

- NEW: Tenino boat launch is open.

- Heritage Landing is open, and the ramp is in the water.
- Bull Bend boating access site and campground are open.
- Wyeth Boating Site is open.
- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day Use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. Detroit Lake

- UPDATE: Kane's Marina pumpout and dump station is open.

- The water level at State Park D is fluctuating at the bottom of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Hoover campground, Cove Creek campground and Southshore have more than 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramps.
- Mongold upper boat ramp is open, and docks are floating with 80 feet of water at the end of the low water ramp.
- Kane's Marina is open with eight feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- State Park G Loop has 25 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Devils Lake

Digit Point

- UPDATE: Digit Point campground and boat launch are open.

Dorena Reservoir

- Baker Bay boat ramp is open and has more than 60 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Harms Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately five feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Dog Lake

- Dog Lake Campground and boat launch are open.

Duncan Reservoir

- Located near Silver Lake off Highway 31 is open. This is a great location for paddling.

East Lake

- NEW: Water levels are low, making boat launching difficult.
- NEW: Cinder Hill low water ramp is available.
- The Hot Spring boat ramp is open.

Eel Lake

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

Emigrant Lake

- UPDATE: The West dock has been tied to the top of the ramp while repairs are underway. The lake is 64% full. The North ramp is open.

Estacada Lake

- Timber Park nonmotorized boat launch is open. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid for by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass available by calling or emailing – 503-464-8515, pgeparks@pgn.com

Fall Creek Reservoir

- North Shore low water ramp is open. The water is 21 feet over the end of the ramp. All other ramps are out of the water and gated for now.

Faraday Lake

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2024. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

Fern Ridge Reservoir

- Perkins Peninsula Park has been reopened and has approximately seven feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Fern Ridge Shores has more than six feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately nine feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Richardson Park marina is open. There is approximately eight feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Foster Reservoir

- Calkins Park Boat Ramp is open with approximately six feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Gedney Creek is open and there is 18 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- Sunnyside Boat ramp is open. The water is approximately 25 feet over the end of the ramp.

Fourmile Lake

- UPDATE: Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are closed. Road access is allowing USFS to address hazards and a phased reopening may be required. [Fremont-Winema National Forest - Fourmile Lake Campground \(usda.gov\)](http://usda.gov)
- The reservoir is approximately 54% full.

Galesville Reservoir

NEW: Oregon Health Authority (OHA) issued a recreational use health advisory today for Galesville Reservoir due to the presence of a cyanobacteria bloom. OHA encourages people to visit Galesville Reservoir and enjoy activities such as fishing, camping, hiking, biking, picnicking, bird watching, canoeing, and kayaking. Boating is safe as long as speeds do not create excessive water spray.

- Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The County has replaced the repaired docks. The high water is floating woody debris, keep a lookout when boating.

Garrison Lake (Port Orford)

- 12th Street boat ramp and docks are open.
- Pinehurst gravel ramp is open. This is a great access site for paddle craft to access the lake.

Gold Lake

- NEW: The Gold Lake Campground is now open.

Grand Ronde River

- Mud Creek campground and boat ramp are open. Water system opening pending system testing.

Green Peter Reservoir

- UPDATE: Reservoir levels continue to drop. Thistle Creek still has approximately 65 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. Whitcomb has approximately 15 feet of water.
- Thistle Creek and Whitcomb Creek boat ramps are open. Boarding docks are available. Floating restrooms are installed.

Green Point Reservoir/ Kinglsey Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

Haystack Reservoir

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 73% full. The boat ramp is open, and the docks are floating.

Heart Lake

- Heart Lake Landing is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Hells Canyon Reservoir

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

Henry Hagg Lake

- UPDATE: Ramp A and C are open, and the reservoir is 98% full.

Hills Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: Packard Creek Boat Ramp is open and there is approximately 69 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Bingham boat ramp is open. However, water is approximately 10 feet *below* the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: CT Beach is open. The water level is approximately three feet over the bottom of the ramp. This is a nice location for paddlers to carry down.

Holbrook Reservoir

- Holbrook Reservoir Campground is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Hosmer Lake

- NEW: Hosmer Lake ramp is now open.

Howard Prairie Reservoir

Hyatt Lake

- C Loop ramp is open.
- Wildcat Campground is open and has a small undeveloped boat ramp. Mountain View Boat Ramp is open.

Kinglsey Reservoir/Green Point Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

Lake Billy Chinook

- Elodea, an aquatic weed, is growing at the Perry South launch area and may interfere with boating. An update will be posted when the weed is successfully removed.
- Perry South Day Use, Cove Palisades Resort and Marina, Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps are open.

Lake Harriet

- Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are open.

Lake Marie

- Umpqua Lighthouse State Park is open to paddlecraft. This is a beautiful coastal lake for paddlers to explore. Paddlers can carry down and launch from the shoreline.

Lake of the Woods

- Aspen Point, Sunset Campground, and Rainbow Bay boating access sites are open.

Lake Oswego

- Lake Oswego is holding a fireworks display on July 4th from 10-11pm.

Lake Owyhee Reservoir

- McCormack boat ramp is closed due to low water levels.

Lake Simtustus

- Pelton Park Marina and Boat launch are open.

Lookout Point Reservoir

- NEW: Hampton boat ramp is closed.
- UPDATE: Black Canyon water level is approximately 30 feet below the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Water is approximately 50ft over the end of Signal Point ramp.

Loon Lake

- Loon Lake Recreation Site is open. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year-round. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

Lost Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: Joseph Steward has approximately 35 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Takelma has more than 100 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Luckiamute River

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

McKenzie River

- Frisell, Paradise, McKenzie Bridge, Bruckart Landing, Hamlin, Forest Glen, Finn Rock, Helfrich Landing, Goodpasture, Greenwood Landing, Leaburg Landing, Deerhorn Landing, Hendricks Bridge, Bellinger Landing, Hayden Bridge, and Armitage are all open
- Silver Creek Boat Launch is open. Please be careful as the viewing platform has not yet been rebuilt since the Holiday Farm Fire.

- Union Creek boat ramp and docks are in the water and open.
- Mason boat ramp is in the water.
- Southwest Shore Campground is open, and paddlers can carry down to launch on the shore. This site is near marsh area with lots of birds.
- Social Security Point is open, and paddlers can carry down or if you have high clearance vehicle can launch off the beach area.
- Black Mountain Road aka Southwest Shore is open. Paddlers or small boats can launch from the rustic gravel ramp.

Pilcher Creek Reservoir

- Pilcher Creek ramp is open, the docks are floating, and the reservoir is full.

Plat I Reservoir

- The reservoir is full and open for recreation.

Prineville Reservoir

- Prineville State Park Day Use is open. The boarding docks and moorage dock are damaged and being repaired.
- Powderhouse Cove ramp is open, and dock installed.
- Prineville reservoir is 92% full.

Rogue River

Skipanon River

- Warrenton Marina is open. Moorage currently has a waiting list.

Smith Reservoir

- NEW: The campground and launch will remain closed until 2026 as part of EWEB's work to retrofit, refurbish and upgrade equipment at our Carmen-Smith Hydroelectric facility. The McKenzie River Trail and associated trailheads will remain open throughout the reconstruction period.

Snake River

- Nyssa boat ramp and docks are open. There are large voids between the boat ramp concrete planks. Use caution when launching and retrieving.
- Hells Canyon Creek boat launch is open.
