### **Agate Lake**

- This small lake is a great place to practice your paddling skills and enjoy some fishing. The ramp is open and the lake is full.

### **Agency Lake**

- Henzel and Petric Park's boat ramps are open and boarding docks are installed.

### **Applegate Reservoir**

- Hart-Tish, Copper and French Gulch boating access sites are open and have more than 55 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

### **Ana Reservoir**

- The boat ramp is open and fishing has been good.

### **Ben Irving Reservoir**

- The boat ramp and the dock are open.

### **Beulah Reservoir**

- Beulah Reservoir is full. Water is approximately 24 feet over the end of the ramp.

## **Big Lake**

- Big Lake West, Big Lake campgrounds, and Big Lake Day Use are open.

## **Blue River Reservoir**

- Saddle Dam boat ramp and Lookout boat ramp are open. There is more than 20 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The reservoir is full.

## **Brownlee Reservoir**

- NEW: The Grand Reopening is on June 13<sup>th</sup> at Hewitt Park. Parking is free for the event.
- The Hewitt Park boat ramp is open, and the moorage and the fishing docks are floating. The new vault toilet has been installed. There is approximately 36 feet of water at the end of the ramp.
- The Spring Recreation Campground, both boat ramps are open, and docks are installed. The water is approximately 18 feet over the end of the boat ramp.
- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is open. The water level is 26 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Farewell Bend State Park is open and water level is approximately 36 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open. There is approximately 54 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.

## **Bully Creek Reservoir**

- The water is approximately 35 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp. The docks are installed and floating.

## **Cape Kiwanda**

- NEW: Construction will create limited access beginning in October 2023, and lasting until the spring of 2024. [Parks Department | Tillamook County OR](#)

## **Carmen Smith Reservoir**

- The closure has been extended to the spring of 2025.

## **Chetco River**

- NEW: US Army Corps of Engineers are scheduled to begin dredging at the Port of Brookings Harbor on June 10<sup>th</sup>. The work will be ongoing for 2 to 3 weeks and will intermittently impact access.

### **Chickahominy Reservoir**

- The lake is nearly full, and the boat ramp is open.

### **Clackamas Lake**

- The 2023 opening is delayed due to issues with the water systems. Plan ahead. When Timothy Lake campgrounds are full, consider going to Clackamas Lake to enjoy paddling.

### **Clackamas River**

- Moore Creek, Sandstone, and Hole-in-the-Wall Boating Access sites are open. Areas along the Clackamas River are still heavily impacted by wildfire. Visitors are recommended to exercise caution if pulling out in non-designated areas.

### **Clear Lake (Linn County)**

- Boat access is open for paddlecraft.

### **Coast Fork-Willamette River**

- The Highway 58 Bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor on an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025. ### **Coffenbury Lake**

- Fort Stevens State Park Boat Launch is open, and the lake is full.

### **Columbia River**

- NEW: The floating restroom at Government Island is scheduled to be installed on June 12<sup>th</sup>.
- NEW: The Hammond Marina in Warrenton is open, with four launch lanes. There is a \$10 boat launch and parking fee. The moorage currently has a waiting list.

- NEW: The Warrenton Marina at Skipanon is open, with two launch lanes. There is a \$10 boat launch and parking fee. The moorage currently has a waiting list.
- UPDATE: Chinook Landing pumpout and dump station is back online. More repairs to the electrical line are anticipated later in June, which will shut down the station for a day or two. Check [here](#) for updates.
- Port of The Dalles boat ramp, short-term tie-up dock, restroom and pumpout and dump station are open. The marine fuel station is operated by the Yacht Club and diesel is currently available.
- Umatilla Marina will be closed June 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> for a community event.
- City of St. Helens Courthouse Docks are open and the pumpout and dump station are operational. There will be some construction in the park throughout the summer; however, access will remain open. Bull rails on the docks are in poor condition so larger vessel operators need to be cautious when tying up. Sand Island North and South are open.

### **Cooper Creek Reservoir**

- Cooper Creek East and West boat ramps are open, docks are installed.

### **Coos Bay**

- Empire Boat Ramp has one set of docks installed.
- Repairs are happening to the North Jetty. Construction is expected to last until December 2025. <https://www.nwp.usace.army.mil/Media/News-Releases/Article/3327429/corps-of-engineers-to-begin-critical-repairs-to-coos-bay-north-jetty-closes-roa/>
- The California Street boat ramp and docks are open.

### **Coquille River**

- Coquille Boat Ramp is closed for trailered launching, but paddlecraft can carry down to the water.
- Arago boat ramp is open. The boarding docks are anticipated to be installed in mid-June.
- Coquille River Bass Derby starts June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 8:00 am and runs through September 10<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm. Disabled veterans and children under 12 can register at any of the over-the-counter ticket outlets. Registration for veterans and

### **Cottage Grove Reservoir**

- Lakeside Boat Ramp is open, and docks are floating. There is approximately 40 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- Wilson Creek Boat Ramp is open. There is approximately seven feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

### **Cougar Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Slide Creek Campground is open; however, the water is approximately 25 feet below the bottom of the ramp. Paddlers can carry down but the terrain is difficult.
- Echo Park remains closed. The water is approximately 25 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Crane Prairie**

- Crane Prairie and Rock Creek Boat Ramps and campgrounds are open, and the docks are installed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 86% full.
- Quinn River boat ramp and the campgrounds are open.

### **Crescent Lake**

- Crescent Lake Campground is open and the low water launch is available. The reservoir is 18% full.

### **Crystal Creek**

- Malone Springs Day Use is located approximately 45 minutes northwest of Klamath Falls. This small paddle access is part of the Upper Klamath Canoe Trail that meanders through marshes and is part of the Upper Klamath National Wildlife Refuge. ### **Cullaby Lake (Warrenton)**

- The Cullaby Lake Regatta is scheduled for June 17<sup>th</sup> beginning at 10:00 am to June 18<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 am. [Columbia Outboard Racing Association | Astoria OR | Facebook](http://ColumbiaOutboardRacingAssociation.com)

### **Davis Lake**

- East Davis Lake boat launch is open.

- Lake level is still very low. Limited boat launching is available at North Lava Flow Campground and West Davis day use site.

### **Deschutes River**

- Heritage Landing is open, and the ramp is in the water. On June 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, there will be a multi-agency oil spill deployment exercise on Deschutes River to the Columbia River which will create some anticipated congestion. The sand bar at the mouth of the Deschutes may result in reduced access to the Columbia River during periods of low water.
- The Bull Bend boating access site and campground are open.
- The Wyeth boating access site is open.
- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day Use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. ### **Detroit Lake**

- The water level at State Park D is fluctuating at the bottom of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- Hoover campground, Cove Creek Campground and Southshore have more than 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramps.
- Mongold upper boat ramp is open, and docks are floating.
- Kane's Marina is open with 10 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- State Park G Loop has 25 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

### **Dexter Reservoir**

- Dexter State Park boat ramps will be closed June 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> during the US Regional Masters Rowing Competition. [2023 USRowing Northwest Masters Regional Championships \(eugenecascadescoast.org\)](https://www.eugenecascadescoast.org/)
- Lowell and Dexter State Park boat ramps are open except for the event closure as noted above. The water is approximately 10 feet above the bottom of the ramps.

### **Diamond Lake**

- NEW: Blackbird 5K Trout Derby is scheduled on June 24<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 am to 4:00 pm. [21st ANNUAL \\$5K BLACKBIRD FISHING DERBY | Facebook](#)
- The North End boat ramp and restrooms are open. The South End and Thielson View are still closed for the season.

### **Dorena Reservoir**

- Baker Bay boat ramp is open and has more than 65 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Harms Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Dog Lake**

- Dog Lake Campground and the boat launch are open.

### **Duncan Reservoir**

- Duncan Reservoir is located near Silver Lake, off Highway 31, and is open. This is a great location for paddling.

### **East Lake**

- The Hot Spring boat ramp is open.

### **Eel Lake**

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

### **Emigrant Lake**

- The lake is 70% full. The North ramp is open, and the West ramp has one lane open. Use caution. The inflow of water is creating high levels of woody debris throughout the lake.

### **Estacada Lake**

- The Timber Park nonmotorized boat launch is open. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid for by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass available by calling or emailing at 503-464-8515, [pgeparks@pgn.com](mailto:pgeparks@pgn.com).

### **Fall Creek Reservoir**

- The North Shore low water ramp is open. The water is 21 feet over the end of the ramp. All other ramps are out of the water and gated for now.

### **Faraday Lake**

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2024. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

### **Fern Ridge Reservoir**

- Perkins Peninsula Park is temporarily closed and is being used for firefighting efforts. [Parks - Lane County](#)
- Fern Ridge Shores has more than six feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately nine feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Richardson Park marina is open. There is approximately eight feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

### **Foster Reservoir**

- Calkins Park Boat Ramp is open with approximately six feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- Gedney Creek is open, with 18 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- Sunnyside Boat ramp is open. The water is approximately 25 feet over the end of the ramp.

### **Fourmile Lake**

- Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are closed. The US Forest Service anticipates reopening in July. The reservoir is approximately 62% full.

### **Galesville Reservoir**

- Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The County has removed the docks for repair. The high water is floating woody debris, so keep a lookout when boating.

### **Gold Lake**

- Access is closed from the Cedar Creek Fire Emergency. The Forest Order identifies the closure is in effect through June 25, 2023 unless rescinded sooner. [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](#). As of June 7, U.S. Forest Service is requesting people not to drive on closed roads. They are monitoring snow and road conditions and will open the gate as soon as the road becomes passable and safe for travel. For updates, call the Gold Lake information line at 541-782-5235.



### **Grand Ronde River**

- NEW: Mud Creek campground and boat ramp are open. Water system opening pending receipt of system testing.

### **Green Peter Reservoir**

- NEW: Green Peter Kokanee Derby is scheduled on June 10<sup>th</sup> beginning at 5:00 am until 4:00 pm. [Derby - Oregon \(kokaneepoweroregon.com\)](http://kokaneepoweroregon.com)
- UPDATE: Reservoir levels have dropped approximately 10 feet. Thistle Creek still has approximately 75 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. Whitcomb has approximately 25 feet of water.
- Thistle Creek and Whitcomb Creek boat ramps are open. Boarding docks are available. Floating restrooms are installed. Keep a watch for debris.

### **Green Point Reservoir/ Kinglsey Reservoir**

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

### **Haystack Reservoir**

- NEW: High Desert Show Down 1000' Drag Boat Races will be held on June 9<sup>th</sup> beginning at 8:00 am through June 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. [Drag Boat Racing | Columbia Drag Boat Association | United States \(cdbaracing.com\)](http://cdbaracing.com)
- UPDATE: The reservoir is 63% full. The boat ramp is open, and the docks are floating.

### **Heart Lake**

- Heart Lake Landing is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

### **Hells Canyon Reservoir**

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

### **Henry Hagg Lake**

- Ramp A and C are open, and the reservoir is full.

### **Hills Creek Reservoir**

- Packard Creek Boat Ramp is open and there is approximately 72 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- Bingham boat ramp is open; however, water is approximately seven feet below the bottom of the ramp.

- CT Beach is open. The water level is approximately six feet over the bottom of the ramp. This is a nice location for paddlers to carry down.

### **Holbrook Reservoir**

- Holbrook Reservoir Campground is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790)

### **Howard Prairie Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Howard Prairie Marina is open. The water level is approximately 52% full.
- Grizzly Park, Klum Landing, and Willow Point campgrounds are open. The boat ramps remain closed due to low water. [Grizzly Park at Howard Prairie Lake \(jacksoncountyor.org\)](http://jacksoncountyor.org)

### **Hyatt Lake**

- UPDATE: Wildcat Campground will open on June 9<sup>th</sup>. The Mountain View Boat Ramp will open on June 16.

### **John Day River**

- There's some flooding between McDonald Crossing and J.S. Burres State Park. The boat ramp access remains open.

### **Kingsley Reservoir/Green Point Reservoir**

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

### **Lake Billy Chinook**

- Perry South Day Use, Cove Palisades Resort and Marina, Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps are open.

### **Lake Harriet**

- The Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are open.

### **Lake Marie**

- UPDATE: The Umpqua Lighthouse State Park is open to paddlecraft. This is a beautiful coastal lake for paddlers to explore. Paddlers can carry down and launch from the shoreline.

### **Lake of the Woods**

- Aspen Point, Sunset Campground, and Rainbow Bay boating access sites are open.
- Lake of the Woods Resort is open <https://lakeofthewoodsresort.com/>.

### **Lake Owyhee Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Gordon Gulch boarding dock is being investigated for adjustment this week. Until then, use caution as it is currently out of alignment.
- UPDATE: The reservoir is 80% full. Gordon Gulch and Indian Creek boat ramps are open, and docks are floating.
- Leslie Gulch boat ramp is open.

### **Lake Simtustus**

- Pelton Park Marina and boat launch are open.
- Reservations for Indian Park Campground are now available online through the Warm Springs Fisheries Department. [Indian Park Camping – Check Availability – Department of Fisheries \(warmsprings-nsn.gov\)](https://www.warmsprings-nsn.gov/Indian-Park-Camping-Check-Availability-Department-of-Fisheries)

### **Lava Lake**

- UPDATE: Lava Lake campground, boating access, and docks are open.

### **Lofton Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Lofton Reservoir is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Rd (Forest Road 3790). The small boat ramp and shore provide easy access for small boats and paddlecraft.

### **Lookout Point Reservoir**

- Black Canyon water level is approximately five feet below the boat ramp.

### **Loon Lake**

- The Loon Lake Recreation Site is now open. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year around. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

### **Lost Creek Reservoir**

- Joseph Steward and Takelma boating access sites have more than 50 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramps.

### **Luckiamute River**

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

## **McKenzie River**

- Frisell, Paradise, McKenzie Bridge, Bruckart Landing, Hamlin, Forest Glen, Finn Rock, Helfrich Landing, Goodpasture, Greenwood Landing, Leaburg Landing, Deerhorn Landing, Hendricks Bridge, Bellinger Landing, Hayden Bridge, and Armitage are all open.
- Silver Creek Boat Launch is open. Please be careful as the viewing platform has not yet been rebuilt since the Holiday Farm Fire.
- Approximately ¼ mile below Ollalie Campground there is a full-spanning strainer. To find or report boating obstructions or hazards, visit: [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](https://arcgis.com).
- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park: the single boat ramp is open. There are no park facilities except restroom, road, and parking due to the Holiday Fire.

## **Mercer Lake**

- Mercer Lake Landing is open.

## **Middle Fork Willamette River**

- The Middle Fork boat ramp near the Dexter Dam will be closed beginning September 11, 2023, through Summer 2026. The exact construction completion date is currently unknown. The closure is for the Dexter Fish Facility upgrade.
- The Westfir take out, also known as Turtle Island Park, is on the North Fork of the Middle Fork and is open for the season.
- Pengra Access ramp is open.

## **Morgan Lake**

- Morgan Lake boating access is open.

## **Munsel Lake**

- Munsel Lake boating access is open.

## **Neawana Creek**

- Broadway Park boating access is open.

## **Necanicum River**

- Quatat Marine Park and Cartwright Park boating access sites in Seaside are open.

### **North Fork Reservoir**

- Promontory Park and North Fork lower launch are open.

### **North Santiam River**

- Buell Miller boat ramp is open.
- Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open; however, there will be no sanitation available. Please plan ahead. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](https://arcgis.com)
- Lyons-Mehama and Stayton Bridge boat ramps are open.

### **North Twin Lake**

- The campground and boating access are open.

### **North Umpqua River**

- NEW: Horseshoe Bend Campground is open.
- Boulder Flat raft launch, Horseshoe Bend raft launch and Gravel Bin are open.

### **Ochoco Lake**

- The reservoir is 73% full. The boat launch is open, and four docks are floating.

### **Odell Lake**

- Sunset Cove is open.

### **Olalla Reservoir**

- The boat launch is open, and the reservoir is full.

### **Paulina Lake**

- Hazard tree inspectors identified more than 300 hazard trees within Paulina Lake Campground. Crews removed a majority of these trees last fall; however, some hazard tree removal work remains. The remaining hazard tree work will resume as soon as snow levels permit this spring. In anticipation of this work, the opening date for Paulina Lake Campground will be delayed by two weeks to June 30. ### **Pilcher Creek Reservoir**

- Pilcher Creek site is open, and the reservoir is 75% full.

### **Pine Hollow Reservoir**

- 53<sup>rd</sup> Annual NW Radio Control Seaplane Championship is scheduled June 23<sup>rd</sup> beginning at 8:00 am and runs through June 25<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm.

### **Plat I Reservoir**

- The reservoir is full and open for recreation.

### **Prineville Reservoir**

- NEW: Wildland Firefighter retreat at the Prineville Resort June 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>.
- UPDATE: Prineville State Park Day Use is open. The boarding docks and moorage dock are damaged and being repaired. The reservoir is full.
- The Powderhouse Cove ramp is open, and dock installed.

### **Rogue River**

- UPDATE: The Rooster Crow Hydroplane Race is scheduled June 24<sup>th</sup> from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm. The race will occur between Savage Creek to the I-5 Twin Bridges.
- Port of Gold beach is hosting the 2023 North American Jet Boat Championship. [2023 North American Jet Boat Championship | Facebook](#)
- Access at Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek boat launch is accessible via Lower Grave Creek Rd.
- Casey, Rogue Elk, Shady Cove, Dodge Bridge, TouVelle State Park, Valley of the Rogue State Park, Dees Landing (Coyote Evans Wayside), Pierce Riffle, Chinook Park, Baker Park, Schroeder, Lathrop Landing, Matson, Griffin Park, Ferry Hole, Robertson Bridge, Hog Creek, Indian Mary, Ennis Riffle, Galice, Rand and Alameda boating access sites are all open.

### **Siletz River**

- Moonshine Boat Ramp in Lodgsen is closed. There is a tree approximately 1 mile downstream of Moonshine Park that spans the river. Due to high water levels, obstruction cannot be removed at this time. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](#)
- Old Mill Park is open, and the ramp is in the water.
- Hee Hee Ilahee is open, and the ramp is in the water.

### **Siltcoos Lake**

- Westlake County Park is open.

### **Siuslaw River**

- Bender Landing, Deadwood, Farnham, Mapleton, Schindler, Tiernan, Konnie Memorial, Tide County Parks and Linslaw are open.
- The Port of Siuslaw boat ramp is open and boom logs have been removed for the season.

### **Skipanon River**

- NEW: Warrenton Marina and boat ramp are open. \$10 boat launch and parking fee. Moorage currently has a waiting list.

### **Smith and Bybee Lake**

- The vegetation in the lake is still manageable for paddling.

### **Snake River**

- NEW: Hells Canyon Creek boat launch is open.
- Ontario State Park boarding docks have some broken decking. Use caution when using the dock. Repairs are anticipated to occur in June.
- Dug Bar and Pittsburg Landing Campground are all open.

### **South Santiam River**

- Waterloo County Boat Ramp is open.

### **Spring Creek**

- Collier Memorial Park and Spring Creek Day Use are open.

### **Summit Lake**

- UPDATE: Summit Lake is closed due to snowpack. Tentative opening is July 1<sup>st</sup> depending on snow conditions.

### **Suttle Lake**

- Blue Bay, Link Creek, South Shore and Suttle Lake Boating access sites are open, and the docks are installed.

### **Tahkenitch Lake**

- Tahkenitch boat ramp is damaged and is temporarily closed. The US Forest Service is converting several campsites in the campground to day-use only to help accommodate boating access.

### **Tenmile Lake**

- Tenmile County Ramp ramps are open; however, sidewalk construction continues.

### **Thief Valley Reservoir**

- Thief Valley Reservoir is full, and the boat ramp is open. The dock has been installed.

### **Thompson Reservoir**

- UPDATE: Water system is now open at Eastbay. The campground is open. Fees are being collected at a rate of \$10 per night for a single unit and \$5 per night per extra vehicle.
- UPDATE: Thompson Reservoir Campground is open and the water system is on. Fees are being collected at a rate of \$6 per night for a single unit and \$2 per night per extra vehicle.

- North Turner Lake is open.

### **Umpqua River**

- Pickett Park vault toilet is open. The park will be closed June 12-20 for paving.
- The Scottsburg Park ramp is open, and the docks are installed.



### **Upper Klamath Lake**

- The floating restroom is installed near Bare Island.
- Odessa campground, Rocky Point Boat Launch and Wocus Bay ramp and docks are open.

### **Unity Reservoir**

### **Waldo Lake**
