Agate Lake (Jackson County)

- UPDATE: Agate Lake boat launch is open. The lake is 76% full.

Agency Lake (Klamath County)

- UPDATE: Henzel Park boating access is open while the new drinking water well is being installed.
- Petric Park boat ramp is open.

Allen Creek Reservoir (Crook County)

- Open May 15 – September 15, this primitive boat ramp is located on the southeast corner of the reservoir. The access road is primitive and rough, please drive slowly.

Alsea River

- The Port of Alsea boat launch and kayak dock are open.
- Salmonberry Park and Campground are open for the season.

Ana Reservoir (Lake County)

- The boat ramp and boarding docks are open.

Antelope Flat Reservoir (Crook County)

- The Antelope Flat boating access site is open.

Anthony Lakes (Baker County)

- Anthony Lakes Campground and boat launch are open for the season.

Applegate Reservoir (Jackson County)

- UPDATE: Hart-Tish ramp is open. There is more than 40 feet over the end of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: French Gulch boating access site has more than 100 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Copper ramp is open. There is more than 50 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.

Badger Lake (Hood River County)

- UPDATE: Badger Lake Campground is open. [Mt. Hood National Forest | Badger Lake Campground | Forest Service](#)

Ben Irving Reservoir (Douglas County)

- The boating access is open.

Benson Lake (Multnomah County)

- Benson Lake State Park is open. The park is only accessible to eastbound traffic, from exit #30. The restroom is open.

Beulah Reservoir (Malheur County)

- UPDATE: The boating access site is open and there is approximately 14 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.

Big Lake (Linn County)

- Big Lake West, Big Lake campgrounds, and Big Lake Day Use boating access sites are open for the season.

Blair Lake (Lane County)

- Blair Lake Campground is closed due to the Cedar Creek Fire.

Blue Lake (Multnomah County)

- Blue Lake Regional Park is open.

Blue River Reservoir (Lane County)

- UPDATE: Saddle Dam boat ramp is open. There is approximately 35 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Lookout Campground is open, and the water is approximately 6 feet over the bottom of the ramp.

Bradley Lake (Coos County)

- Bradley Lake Boat Ramp is open.

Brownlee Reservoir (Baker County)

- NEW: During the week of July 14 construction activities will be underway on Upper Brownlee Reservoir at the Burnt River confluence. Bank stabilization efforts are planned via heavy equipment and helicopter at the Railroad Bridge/Burnt River confluence. Boaters in the area should be aware and proceed with caution. Launching from Farewell Bend State Park and Spring Recreation Site may be impacted.
- UPDATE: Farewell Bend State Park boating access is open. There is more than 30 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Hewitt Park low-water ramp and docks are open with approximately 38 feet of water over the end of the ramp. Hewitt Park day use ramp (middle ramp) is open.
- UPDATE: Holcomb Park boat ramp and docks are open; the water is approximately 27 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open. There is more than 50 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: The Spring Recreation Campground and boating access are open. The boarding docks are installed and the restroom and drinking water are available. The water is approximately 19 feet over the bottom of the ramp.

Bull Prairie Reservoir (Grant County)

- Bull Prairie Campground is open.

Bully Creek Reservoir (Malheur County)

- UPDATE: The park and boat ramp are open. There is approximately 28 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.

Campbell Lake (Lake County)

- Campbell Lake Campground is open.

Cape Meares Lake (Tillamook County)

- Cape Meares Lake boat ramp is open. Use caution when launching as you may encroach on Bay Ocean Rd.

Carmen Smith Reservoir (Lane County)

- U.S. Forest Service has closed Carmen Reservoir from the center of the reservoir up the high-water line and extends to the spillway area to the southwest and Forest Service Roads 2600-750 and 2600-751 to vehicle and pedestrian traffic through April 2027. Cheadle Lake (Linn County)

- The boat ramp is open.

Chetco River

- The Port of Brookings Harbor boat ramp is open. The Port recently completed boat trailer parking area surface and striping improvements.
- Alfred A. Loeb State Park access to the gravel bar is open. There is a drop off on the access to the gravel bar.
- Miller Bar, Nook Bar, Redwood Bar, and South Fork Campgrounds and Day Use areas have large drop offs on the access to the gravel bar.

Chickahominy Reservoir (Harney County)

- The boat ramp is open. The docks have a temporary connection to the abutment and piling.

Clackamas Lake

- UPDATE: Clackamas Lake Campground is open for the season. This small, shallow lake is a great location, especially when Timothy Lake is full.

Clackamas River

- NEW: Mt. Hood National Forest is doing river restoration work at the confluence of the Clackamas River and Collawash River. Nonmotorized boaters are not anticipated to be impacted but keep a lookout when operating in the area. [Mt. - Clackamette Park is open, however the boat ramp is closed for safety. Paddlecraft may launch from shore.
- Carver Park and Barton Parks are open.
- Milo McIver State Park boat ramp is open.
- Moore Creek, Hole-in-the-Wall, Sandstone and Carter Bridge Boat Access sites are open.
- Fish Creek boat slide remains closed from the 2020 Fire. [Mt. Hood National Forest | Fish Creek Campground & Day Use | Forest Service](#)

Clear Lake (Linn County)

- Coldwater Cove is open for the season.
- Clear Lake Resort, Marina and boat ramp are open year-round.

Clear Lake (Wasco County)

- UPDATE: Clear Lake Campground is open, and the lake is 10% full. [Hydromet Pacific Northwest Region | Bureau of Reclamation](#)
- UPDATE: Clear Lake Day Use and Campground are open.

Cleawox Lake (Lane County)

- Honeyman State Park boating access is open.

Coffenbury Lake (Clatsop County)

Cold Springs Reservoir (Umatilla County)

- UPDATE: Cold Springs primitive boating access is open. The reservoir is 38% full. [Hydromet Pacific Northwest Region | Bureau of Reclamation](#).

Collawash River

- NEW: Mt. Hood National Forest is doing river restoration work at the confluence of the Clackamas River and Collawash River. Nonmotorized boaters are not anticipated to be impacted but keep a lookout when operating in the area. [Mt. Columbia River

- NEW: Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife have implemented a new program for limited entry parking at Sauvie Island Beaches on weekends and holidays. This would apply to nonmotorized boaters carrying down and launching from the beaches. [New pilot program for limited entry parking at Sauvie Island Beaches; Free pass required summer weekends and holidays began on July 4.](#)
- Rainier Marina is open and the pumpout and dump station are operational.
- Rainier Riverfront Park boat ramp is open and the parking area was recently renovated.
- Hammond Marina and Warrenton Marina and boat ramp are open.
- City of St Helens Courthouse docks are open. Water, power and pump out station are operating. Repairs to the docks and debris boom are nearing completion. Docks will remain open during construction with minimal disruption.
- The Donaldson Marina is now under Sundance. The pumpout is having intermittent issues but is working.
- M. James Gleason boating access is open. The pumpout and dump stations are open.
- Sandy Beach (Schwitter Landing) tie-up dock was damaged. 24 feet of dock have been removed, and State Parks is working to determine the best course of action for repair. For questions, please contact Guy Rodrigue at guy.rodrigue@OPRD.oregon.gov.
- Chinook Landing ramp, docks and restrooms are open. The pumpout and dump stations are operational.
- Rooster Rock day use is open year-round. The launch ramp is only usable during higher river flows due to heavy sedimentation.
- Port of Cascade Locks boat launch is open.
- Port of Hood River boat launch is open.
- Mayer State Park is open.
- Port of The Dalles boating access and short-term tie-up dock are open. The pumpout and dump station are operational. The marine fuel station is operated by the Yacht Club and offers both diesel and gasoline.
- The Port of Arlington boat launch, marine fuel station, nonmotorized launch and tie-up dock are open.
- Boardman Marina boat launch is open.
- Irrigon Marina and boating access are open. The pump/dump station is not operational at this time. For the latest information, call (541) 922-3225 or (541) 571-5725.
- Umatilla Marina boat ramp and docks are open.
- Hat Rock State Park is open.

Cooper Creek Reservoir (Douglas County)

- Cooper Creek East and West boating access sites are open.

Coos Bay

- NEW: Dredging of Point Adams is scheduled for July 10-25, 2025. Use caution when navigating around and yield right of way to the dredging equipment. Contact International Port of Coos Bay for questions.
- UPDATE: California Street boating access has all docks installed.
- North Spit docks are installed. Keep a look out for woody debris in the bay.
- Eastside and Empire Boat Ramps are open, and the docks are installed.
- Charleston Marina and Boat ramp are open, the pumpout and dump station are open.

- Myrtle Tree boat ramp is open.

Coquille River

- NEW: Sturdivant Park boat trailer parking will be limited the week of July 7-13 because the park has been rented to the Coos Kennel Club. The boat ramp and short-term tie-up dock are open.
- Bandon Marina and Boat Ramp are open.
- Bullard's Beach ramp is open, and the docks are installed.
- Riverton boat ramp is open.
- Coquille boat ramp is open for the season.
- The Arago boat ramp is open. Boarding docks are installed.

Cottage Grove Reservoir (Lane County)

- UPDATE: Wilson Creek boat ramp is closed for low water. Paddlecraft can carry down to launch.
- UPDATE: Lakeside Boat Ramp is open and there is more than 30 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.

Cougar Reservoir (Lane County)

- Slide Creek Campground and Echo Park are open for the season. However, the water is more than 75 feet below the end of the boat ramps.

Coyote Creek (Lane County)

- UPDATE : Coyote Creek (Cantrell Road) paddle access is open.

Crane Prairie Reservoir (Deschutes County)

- UPDATE: The Reservoir is approximately 89% full. [Hydromet Pacific Northwest Region | Bureau of Reclamation](#)
- Crane Prairie Day Use boating access site is open and has new, permanent boat docks.
- Crane Prairie Campground ramp is open.
- Browns Mountain boating access has a shallow slope with four-inch gaps between concrete planks. The location on the reservoir provides for calmer water and is a great place for paddlers to explore.
- Rock Creek boating access and campground is open for the season.
- Quinn River boat launch and campground are open for the season. The ramp has a shallow slope, and the asphalt approach is damaged and breaking apart.
- Crane Prairie Resort and Marina are open for the season.
- Cow Meadow Campground and boating access site is open for the season.

Crescent Lake (Klamath County)

- UPDATE: Spring Campground and boating access open for the season. Docks will not be installed this season. The lake is currently 35% full.
- Crescent Lake Campground low water ramp is open. The main ramp is out of the water.

Crystal Creek

- Malone Springs boat launch is open.
- Rocky Point ramp on Recreation Creek is open, about ten-minute drive south and trailered boats can use the boat ramp.

Cullaby Lake (Clatsop County)

- Carnahan County Park is open.
- Cullaby Lake Boating Access is open.

Cultus Lake (Deschutes County)

- Cultus Lake, Big Cove Boat-In, Little Cove Boat-In, and West Cultus Campgrounds are open for the season.
- Cultus Lake Day Use and boating site are open and the docks are installed.

- East Davis Lake campground and boat launch are open for the season.

Deadhorse Lake (Lake County)

- UPDATE: Deadhorse Lake Park and boating access area are open for the season.

Delintment Lake (Harney County)

- Delintment Lake Campground and boating access are open for the season.

Depoe Bay (Lincoln County)

- Depoe Bay boat ramp is open.

Depot Slough (Lincoln County)

- NEW: The Port of Toledo short-term tie-up docks, pumpout and dump station will be closed to boaters on July 12 from 8:00pm-11:00pm for Toledo Summer Festival's fireworks. The dock is located within the fallout zone for firework debris.

Deschutes River

- Heritage Landing is open. The scat machine is online.
- Mecca Flat Campground entrance road is extremely rough, requiring 4WD. The ramp has a two-foot drop off at the end, boating launch is very difficult.
- Miller's Landing Park accessible paddle launch is open.
- Lava Island Falls (Big Eddy), Aspen, Dillon Falls, Slough Camp, and Besson, Harpers Bridge, Big River, Tetherow, Pringle Falls and Wyeth Take Out are open for the season.
- LaPine State Park boat ramp is severely damaged and only carry down paddlecraft should use the boat ramp.
- Bull Bend and Tenino Boating Site are open.

Detroit Lake (Marion and Linn Counties)

- NEW: Piety Island Campground and boat-in access are open.
- UPDATE: The Forest Service will be removing the floating restrooms for repairs. They may be able to reinstall this season.

- UPDATE: Mongold ramps, courtesy dock, and two strings of boarding docks are open. There is approximately 14 feet of water over the bottom of the upper ramp.
- UPDATE: Southshore Campground is open for the season with water approximately 8 feet over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: State Park D loop boating access is open. The water is 6 feet below the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: State Park G loop boating access is open. The water elevation is approximately 19 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Cove Creek is open with water approximately 10 feet over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Hoover campground is open for the season with approximately 7 feet over the bottom of the ramp/
- Kane's Marina is open for the season.
- Detroit Lake Marina is open for the season.

Devil's Lake (Deschutes)

- UPDATE: Devil's Lake Campground is open for the season.

Devil's Lake (Lincoln)

- Devil's Lake State Recreation Area Day Use boating access site is open.
- The Devils Lake Campground and marina docks are open for the season.
- Regatta Park and Holmes Road Park are open.

Dexter Reservoir (Lane County)

- Lowell and Dexter State Park boat ramps are open, and the docks are floating. Water fluctuates between seven and ten feet over the bottom of the boat ramps. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting. Be cautious of an increase in woody debris in the water.

Diamond Lake (Douglas County)

- UPDATE: Diamond Lake Campground, South Shore, North End and Thielsen View boating access sites are open and the docks are installed for the season.

Dog Lake (Lake County)

- Dog Lake Campground and boat ramp are open for the season.

Dorena Reservoir (Lane County)

- UPDATE: Baker Bay Marina and boat ramp are open. There is more than 50 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Harms Park is a high-water boating access site. The water is approximately 2 feet below the bottom of the ramp. Paddlecraft can carry down.

Duncan Reservoir (Lake County)

- Duncan Reservoir Campground is open. Please report illegal fish introductions to 1-800-452-7888.

East Lake (Deschutes County)

- East Lake and Cinder Hill Campgrounds, and Hot Springs Boating Site are open for the season.
- East Lake Resort is open.

Eel Lake (Coos County)

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

Elk Lake (Deschutes County)

- UPDATE: Little Fawn Boating Site and Sunset View Day Use open for the season.
- UPDATE: Elk Lake Campground is temporarily closed for maintenance as of June 24, 2025. [Willamette National Forest | Elk Lake Campground | Forest Service](#)

Emigrant Lake (Jackson County)

- The Estacada Lake boating access in Milo McIver State Park is open.

Fall Creek Reservoir (Lane County)

- UPDATE: Winberry is open. Water is approximately 5 feet over the end of the ramp. The dock is floating. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- UPDATE: North Shore is open with approximately 70 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Cascara boating access is open for carry down paddlecraft access. The water is approximately 7 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

Faraday Lake (Clackamas County)

- Faraday Lake boating access site is open.

Fern Ridge Reservoir (Lane County)

- UPDATE: Richardson Park Marina is open. The water is more than 7 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting. The pumpout and dump station are offline for the season. Boaters can use the pumpout and dump station at Orchard Point Marina.
- UPDATE: Perkins Peninsula Park is open. The water is approximately 4 feet over the end of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- UPDATE: Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately 8 feet of water over the end of the ramps. The pumpout and dump station are open. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- The Floating Restroom at Bear Creek is installed for the season.

Fish Lake (Baker County)

- UPDATE: Fish Lake Campground and Boating access are open.

Fish Lake (Jackson County)

- UPDATE: The boating access is open and the reservoir is 75% full.

Fish Lake (Lane County)

- This seasonal lake fills up in the spring and is evaporated by mid-summer.

Floras Creek (Curry County)

- Boice Cope Campground and boat ramp are open.

Foster Reservoir (Linn County)

- UPDATE: Calkins Park is open. The water is approximately 4 feet over the bottom of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- A floating restroom has been installed east of Calkins boat ramp for the season
- Gedney Creek boat ramp is open. The water is approximately 16 feet over the bottom of the ramp.
- Sunnyside Park day use, and boating access is open year-round. Water levels are approximately 22 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Lewis Creek tie-up dock is open for the season.

Fourmile Lake (Klamath County)

- UPDATE: Fourmile Lake Campground and boating access are open for the season. The lake is approximately 49% full.

Frog Lake (Wasco County)

- Frog Lake Campground and Day Use primitive boating access is open. Now is a great time for paddlers to enjoy this small lake.

Galesville Reservoir (Douglas County)

- Chief Miwaleta County Park boating access site is open.

Garrison Lake (Port Orford)

- 12th Street boat ramp and Pinehurst gravel ramp are open. Pinehurst is a great access site for paddlecraft to explore the lake.

Gerber Reservoir (Klamath County)

- UPDATE: The reservoir is approximately 74% full.
- The North and South boating access sites are open, as well as Barnes Valley access.

Gold Lake (Lane County)

- UPDATE: Gold Lake Day Use and Campground boating access is open for the season.

Grand Ronde Lake (Union County)

- Grand Ronde Lake Campground is open. This is a great place to explore especially when Anthony Lakes is busy.

Green Peter Reservoir (Linn County)

- UPDATE: Whitcomb Creek boat ramp is closed due to low water. The water is approximately 15 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Thistle Creek lower ramp is open with more than 30 ft of water over the bottom of the ramp. Docks are unavailable.
- The floating restrooms are not installed this season

Haystack Reservoir (Jefferson County)

- ADVISORY: Haystack reservoir is a recirculating system, and the water elevation goes up and down during the irrigation season. When reservoir storage is below 3,600 acre-feet or approximately 64% the West boat ramp is closed. When it is above that level it is normally open. Check here for current levels. - UPDATE: The reservoir is 91% full.
- Haystack South is open for day use and camping.
- Haystack West Shore boat launch is open to trailered boat launching. See Advisory comment and check water level. Carry down access remains available. [Haystack Reservoir | CCPRD](#)
- Haystack East Campground and boat ramp are open.

Heart Lake (Lake County)

- Heart Lake boating access site is open for the season. The boat ramp and dock are in disrepair use caution when launching trailered boats or carrying down paddlecraft on the boat ramp.

Hells Canyon Reservoir (Wallowa County)

- Hells Canyon Creek boat ramp and Visitors Center is open.
- Copperfield boat launch open.

Henry Hagg Lake (Washington County)

- ADVISORY: Remember to check the boat operation waterway rules. [Boat Oregon Map](#). There is a 200 ft. slow -no wake zone around the entire perimeter of the lake. Boats operating east of the buoy line must move in a counterclockwise direction and not exceed 35mph. Protect your boating activities and follow the rules!
- EVENT: Hagg Lake Triathlon & Trail Festival is scheduled July 12 and 13, from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM. [Hagg Lake Triathlon & Trail Festival | Why Racing Events](#)

- UPDATE: Eagle Landing Boating Access (A Ramp) and C boating access have more than 50 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Hills Creek Reservoir (Lane County)

- UPDATE: Packard Creek Campground and Day Use area are open. There is approximately 50 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. As the water recedes, the ramp narrows from two lanes to one, and the docks do not float.
- UPDATE: CT Beach boating access is open. The water is 12 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Bingham boat launch is open. However, the water is more than 25 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

Holbrook Reservoir (Lake County)

- Holbrook Reservoir Campground and boating access is open for the season. No dock is available. Use caution when launching.

Horseshoe Lake (Jefferson County)

- NEW: Horseshoe Lake Campground and boating access will remain closed in 2025 because of Lionshead Fire damage.

Hosmer Lake (Deschutes County)

- Hosmer Lake Boating Site is open for the season. This is a very popular location for paddlecraft.

Howard Prairie Reservoir (Jackson County)

- UPDATE: Howard Prairie Resort boat ramp, marina, and gas pumps are open. If you haven't reserved your marina slip for a night, week or seasonal, contact Jackson County Parks Office (541) 774-8183. The reservoir is 90% full. [Hydromet Pacific Northwest Region | Bureau of Reclamation](#)
- Grizzly Park, Klum Landing, and Willow Point Campground boating access facilities are open for the season.

Hyatt Lake (Jackson County)

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 88% full. [Hydromet Pacific Northwest Region | Bureau of Reclamation](#)
- Cascade, Wildcat Campground and Mountain View Boating access sites are open for the season.

John Day River

- UPDATE: J.S. Burres and Cottonwood are open. Water flow is very low, check gages and scout ahead.
- The Starvation Boat Ramp is open for use.
- Priest Hole Recreation Site is open.

Jubilee Lake (Union County)

- UPDATE: U.S. Forest Service reports that Jubilee Lake Campground and boating access are inaccessible for snow. Anticipated opening mid-July. [Umatilla National Forest | Jubilee Lake Campground | Forest Service](#)

Juniper Lake (Harney County)

- This is a 170-acre lake east of Steens Mountain. Paddlecraft can carry down to the water when the lake is full.

Kilchis River

- Parks Landing, Mapes Creek and Kilchis County Park boat launches are open for use. Mapes Creek boat ramp has a significant drop off at the bottom of the ramp due to low flows. It should be fixed before the fall fisheries begin but until then boaters should use extreme caution and launch at their own risk.

- Peoria Park, McCartney Boat Ramp, and Harrisburg are open.
- Whitely Landing and Island Park are open.

Willamette River – Middle Fork

- Clearwater Park is open.
- Jasper Bridge boating access is closed. There are no plans to reopen the site. Paddlers can carry down at Jasper State Park
- Pengra Access has a single ramp open.
- The Middle Fork Boat Ramp near Dexter Dam is closed through the summer of 2026 for the Dexter Fish Facility Upgrade. The exact construction completion date is unknown.

Willamette River – North Fork of the Middle Fork

- The Westfir take-out, also known as Turtle Island Park, is open.

Williamson River

- Collier Memorial State Park campground is closed through October 1, 2025. The boat ramp is open.

Willow Creek Reservoir (Morrow County)

- UPDATE: Turner Day Use Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately 4 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.

Willow Lake (Jackson County)

- UPDATE: The ramp is open, and the lake is 95% full. [Hydromet Pacific Northwest Region | Bureau of Reclamation](#)

Willow Valley Reservoir (Klamath County)

- The boating access is open.

Wilson River

- ADVISORY: The river is very low for drift boat use. Kayaks and single person float craft can still navigate these reaches but may need to portage shallow areas.
- Sollie Smith boat ramp, Mills Bridge, Siskeyville, and Vanderzandan boat access are all open.

Woahink Lake (Lane County)

- East Woahink Lake boat ramp is open year-round.

Wolf Creek Reservoir (Union County)

- The County access is open and free of ice.

Yaquina Bay (Lincoln County)

- UPDATE: The Port of Newport boating sites are open. Check with Coast Guard Station Yaquina Bay for bar conditions prior to launching. [District Thirteen \(uscg.mil\)](#)

Yaquina River

- ADVISORY: The Toledo Community Boathouse Free Family Boating is on Thursday and Sunday afternoons. Please exercise extreme caution in shared water ways.
- The Port of Toledo paddle dock is open.

Yellowjacket Reservoir (Harney County)

- The lake is open; however the Forest Service campground and boat ramp are under administrative closure while the affected trees are tested for safety. The area was badly burned last year. Please be cautious in this area. [Malheur National Forest | Yellowjacket Campground | Forest Service](#)
 - Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife anticipates completing the installation of a new dock in the day use area located approximately 900 feet north of the Forest Service boat ramp by the end of July. The contractor is planning to be onsite beginning June 9. The new dock will have an area for anglers and an area for kayak launching.
