Agate Lake

- UPDATE: This small lake is a great place to practice your paddling skills and enjoy some fishing. The ramp is open, and the lake is 60% full.

Agency Lake

- NEW: Oregon Health Authority (OHA) issued a recreational use health advisory today for Agency Lake and extended a recreational use health advisory issued July 1st for the southern portion of Upper Klamath Lake. In addition to covering Howards Bay south to the Link River Dam, the expanded advisory now includes all of Upper Klamath Lake. - Henzel and Petric Park's boat ramps are open and boarding docks are installed.

Applegate Reservoir

- UPDATE: Hart-Tish ramp is open with approximately 30 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Copper ramp is open with approximately 38 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- French Gulch boating access site is open and has more than 100 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Ana Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open.

Antelope Reservoir (Malheur County)

- This boating access is open. The gravel ramp is great for small boats and paddlecraft to launch. This is also a nice place to fish.

Badger Lake

- ALERT: The Badger Lake campground and paddle access is closed due to the Boulder Fire. [Mt. Hood National Forest - Alerts & Notices \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/land-management/land-use/mt-hood-national-forest/alerts-notices)

Ben Irving Reservoir

- The boat ramp and dock are open.

Beulah Reservoir

- UPDATE: Beulah Reservoir is 65% full. Water is approximately 11 feet over the end of the ramp.

Big Lake

- Big Lake West, Big Lake campgrounds, and Big Lake Day Use are open.

Blue River Reservoir

- UPDATE: Water levels continue to lower. Saddle Dam boat ramp is open with approximately 41 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Lookout boat ramp is open with approximately 6 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Boulder Lake

- NEW: The hike in campground and paddle access is closed due to the Boulder Fire. [Mt. Hood National Forest - Alerts & Notices \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/land-management/land-use/mt-hood-national-forest/alerts-notices)

Bradley Lake

- Bradley Lake boat ramp is open.

Brownlee Reservoir

- UPDATE: Both boat ramps are open at the Spring Recreation Campground, and the docks are installed. The water is approximately 10 feet over the end of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: The Holcomb Park boat ramp is open. The water level is 18 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: The Hewitt Park boat ramp is open. The moorage and fishing docks are floating. The new vault toilet has been installed. There is approximately 27 feet of water at the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Farewell Bend State Park has some broken decking on the boarding docks and one lane of the boat launch is full of woody debris. The water level is approximately 28 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open. There is approximately 45 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.

Bully Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: The docks are installed and floating with 29 feet of water over the end of the ramp.

Campbell Lake

- Campbell lake campground and boat ramp are now open.

Carmen Smith Reservoir

- The closure has been extended to Spring of 2025.

Chetco River

- US Army Corps of Engineers are scheduled to begin dredging at the Port of Brookings Harbor in July. The work will be ongoing for 2-3 weeks and will intermittently impact access.

Chickahominy Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open.

Clackamas Lake

- Clackamas Lake Campground is open. This small, shallow lake is a great place to go paddling.

Clackamas River

- Moore Creek, Sandstone, and Hole-in-the-Wall Boat Access sites are open. Areas along the Clackamas River are still heavily impacted by wildfire. Visitors should exercise caution if pulling out from non-designated areas.

Clear Lake (Linn County)

- Boat access is open for paddlecraft.

Coast Fork-Willamette River

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025. Coffenbury Lake

- Fort Stevens State Park Boat Launch is open, and the lake is full. The Fort Stevens State Park cabins and yurts are unavailable Aug. 26-Sept. 16. They are reserved for participants and instructors of the Pacific Northwest Preservation School presented by the University of Oregon School of Architecture and Environment. The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is this year's host for the annual historic preservation program.

Columbia River

- NEW: There will be a bass tournament at Celilo Park on July 29th – 30th. Parking may be limited.
- Restrooms at Port of The Dalles are closed for repair until further notice. The boat ramp, short-term tie-up dock, and pumpout and dump station are open. The marine fuel station is operated by the Yacht Club offers both diesel and gasoline.
- Rooster Rock State Park water levels are dropping making launching difficult. Paddlecraft can be hand-launched.
- M. James Gleason restroom facility is currently closed. Portable toilets are available while repairs are underway.
- The floating restroom at Government Island near McGuire Island is installed.
- Hammond Marina in Warrenton is open. Moorage currently has a waiting list.
- Warrenton Marina is open Moorage currently has a waiting list.

- Chinook Landing pumpout and dump station are online.
- City of St. Helens Courthouse Docks are open and the pumpout and dump station are operational. There will be some construction in the park throughout the summer, however access will remain open. Bull rails on the docks are in poor condition – larger vessels should take caution.
- Sand Island North and South are open.

Cooper Creek Reservoir

- The City of Sutherlin has installed two “SolarBees” near the dam. They are to improve water quality by turning over the water. Boaters need to be cautious when operating near the area and avoid the equipment.
- Cooper Creek East and West boat ramps are open, and the docks are installed.

Coos Bay

- The Empire Boat Ramp has one set of docks installed.
- Repairs are occurring to the North Jetty. Construction is expected to last until December, 2025. <https://www.nwp.usace.army.mil/Media/News-Releases/Article/3327429/corps-of-engineers-to-begin-critical-repairs-to-coos-bay-north-jetty-closes-roa/>
- The California Street boat ramp and docks are open.

Coos River

- The Myrtle Tree boat ramp is open.

Coquille River

- The Riverton boat ramp is open.
- Sturdivant Park boat ramp is open, and docks are floating. Water levels are tidally influenced. Camping, restrooms, and fish-cleaning station are available at the park.
- Arago boat ramp is open. The boarding docks are installed.
- Coquille Boat Ramp is closed for launching, but paddle craft can carry down to the water.

Cottage Grove Reservoir

- UPDATE: Lakeside Boat Ramp is open, and the docks are floating. There is approximately 38 feet of water over the end of the ramp.

- UPDATE: Wilson Creek Boat Ramp is open. There is approximately 4 feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Cougar Reservoir

- UPDATE: Slide Creek Campground is open; however, the water is approximately 35 feet below the bottom of the ramp. Paddlers can carry down, but the terrain is difficult.
- Echo Park remains closed. The water is approximately 35 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.

Crane Prairie

- Browns Mountain ramp is open.
- Quinn River boat launch is open.
- UPDATE: Crane Prairie Day Use, Rock Creek boat ramps and the campgrounds are open, and the docks are installed. Crane Prairie Reservoir is 83% full.

Crescent Lake

- Spring boat launch is closed due to damage.
- UPDATE: Crescent Lake Campground is open, and the low water launch is available. The reservoir is 15% full.

Crystal Creek

- Malone Springs Day Use is located approximately 45 minutes northwest of Klamath Falls. This small paddle access is part of the Upper Klamath Canoe Trail that meanders through marshes and is part of the Upper Klamath National Wildlife Refuge. Cultus Lake

- West Cultus Boat-In Campground is by reservation only. Reservations can be made up to one day in advance of the arrival date.
- Cultus Lake campground and ramp are open.

Davis Lake

- North Davis Lake boating access and campground are closed for the 2023 season due to significant hazard tree mitigation needs.
- East Davis Lake boat launch is open.
- The lake level is still very low. Limited boat launching is available at North Lava Flow Campground and West Davis Day Use site.

Deadhorse Lake

- Deadhorse Lake Campground and ramp are open.

Depot Slough

- Port of Toledo's annual Wooden Boat Show is August 19th and 20th and located at the marina.
- Depot Slough is scheduled for dredging beginning on August 1st. Access to the marina and transient dock may be restricted for 2-3 weeks.
- The Port's docks and the short-term tie-up docks will be removed and will be unavailable from August 21st and September 15th.

Deschutes River

- Tenino boat launch is open.
- Heritage Landing is open, and the ramp is in the water.
- Bull Bend boating access site and campground are open.
- Wyeth boating access site is open.
- Aspen, Big River and Lava Island Day Use boating access sites are open. Aspen and Lava Island Day Use are also hiking trailheads for the Deschutes River Trail. Detroit Lake

- UPDATE: Kane's Marina has two feet of water over the end of the ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and off your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting. Kane's Marina pumpout and dump station are open.
- UPDATE: Hoover campground, Cove Creek campground and Southshore have more than six feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramps.
- UPDATE: State Park G Loop has 18 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Mongold upper boat ramp is open, and docks are floating with 98 feet of water at the end of the low water ramp.

Dexter Reservoir

- Lowell and Dexter State Park boat ramps are open, and water is approximately eight feet above the bottom of the ramps.

Diamond Lake

- South Shore and Thielson View are open.
- The North End boat ramp and restrooms are open.

Dorena Reservoir

- UPDATE: Baker Bay boat ramp is open and has approximately 57 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Harms Park boat ramp is open. There is approximately two feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.

Dog Lake

- Dog Lake Campground and boat launch are open.

Duncan Reservoir

- Located near Silver Lake off Highway 31 is open. This is a great location for paddling.

East Lake

- The water levels are low, making boat launching difficult.
- Cinder Hill low-water ramp is available.
- The Hot Springs boat ramp is open.

Eel Lake

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

Elk Lake (Deschutes County)

- The campground and small boat ramp are open. There is very limited parking at the boat ramp. Please be courteous when parking.

Emigrant Lake

- UPDATE: The West dock has been tied to the top of the ramp while repairs are underway. The lake is 47% full. The North ramp is open.

Estacada Lake

- At the Estacada Lake Launch (Milo McIver State Park), paddlers should not stage on the boarding docks. Stage your gear and craft in the parking area and do not park in the boat ramp maneuvering area. All boaters want a swift entry and exit to the water. Be courteous and recreate responsibly.

- Timber Park nonmotorized boat launch is open. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid for by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass available by calling or emailing: 503-464-8515, pgeparks@pqn.com.

Fall Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: North Shore low-water ramp is open. The water is 16 feet over the end of the ramp. All other ramps are out of the water and gated for now.

Faraday Lake

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2024. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

Fern Ridge Reservoir

- The Lane County Sheriff's Office is advising the public that fire-fighting aircraft will be scooping water from Fern Ridge Reservoir to aid in firefighting efforts for the Haight Creek Fire near Alma. [Emergency Alerts - Lane County](#)
- Perkins Peninsula Park is temporarily closed to support firefighting resources. Alternative launches are at Orchard Point and Richardson County Parks. [Perkins Peninsula Park - Lane County](#)
- Fern Ridge Shores has more than five feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Richardson Park Marina is open. There is approximately seven feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately eight feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The pumpout and dump station are currently closed while repairs are underway.

Foster Reservoir

- UPDATE: Calkins Park Boat Ramp is open with approximately 4 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. Please avoid power loading your boat on and from your trailer. Power loading and unloading can damage the lower portion of the boat ramp causing expensive repairs and permitting.
- UPDATE: Gedney Creek is open and there is 16 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Sunnyside Boat ramp is open. The water is approximately 22 feet over the end of the ramp.

Fourmile Lake

- Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are open.

- UPDATE: The reservoir is approximately 33% full.

Galesville Reservoir

- Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The County has repaired the docks.

Garrison Lake (Port Orford)

- 12th Street boat ramp and the docks are open.
- Pinehurst gravel ramp is open. This is a great access site for paddlecraft to access the lake.

Gold Lake

- The Gold Lake Campground is now open.

Grand Ronde River

- Mud Creek campground and boat ramp are open.

Green Peter Reservoir

- Reservoir levels continue to drop. Whitcomb Creek boat ramp is closed.
- UPDATE: Thistle Creek's low-water ramp is open, and no docks are available. There is approximately 51 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.

Green Point Reservoir/ Kinglsey Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open. As of July 1, no campfires are allowed in the campground.

Haystack Reservoir

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 74% full. The boat ramp is open, and the docks are floating.

Heart Lake

- Heart Lake Landing is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Hells Canyon Reservoir

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

Henry Hagg Lake

- UPDATE: Ramp A is open with 47 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Ramp C is open with 57 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- There will be a concert at Ramp C on August 5th. Boat ramps will be open, and boaters are encouraged to enjoy the music from the water.

Hills Creek Reservoir

- Bingham boat ramp is open; however, water is approximately 20 feet *below* the bottom of the ramp.
- CT Beach is open. The water level is seven feet below the bottom of the ramp. This is a nice location for paddlers to carry down.
- Packard Creek Boat Ramp is open and there is approximately 59 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Holbrook Reservoir

- The Fremont-Winema National Forest warns that toxic algae may be present, and the lake may be unsafe for people and pets. Follow caution sign instructions posted at the site.
- Holbrook Reservoir Campground is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Hosmer Lake

- Hosmer Lake ramp is open.

Howard Prairie Reservoir

- UPDATE: Howard Prairie Marina and boat ramp are open. The water level is approximately 44% full. Grizzly Park, Klum Landing, and Willow Point campgrounds are open. Hyatt Lake

- C Loop ramp is open.
- Wildcat Campground is open and has a small, undeveloped boat ramp. Mountain View boat ramp is open.
- UPDATE: The lake is approximately 49% full.

Illinois River

- NEW: USFS has closed the Illinois River from Miami Bar Boat Ramp to the river mouth at the confluence of the Rogue River at Agness. [Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest - Alerts & Notices \(usda.gov\)](#)

John Day River

- J.S. Burres boat ramp at Cottonwood Park is open

Kinglsey Reservoir/Green Point Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

Lake Billy Chinook

- Perry South Day Use, Cove Palisades Resort and Marina, Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps are all open.

Lake Harriet

- Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are open.

Lake Marie

- Umpqua Lighthouse State Park is open to paddlecraft. This is a beautiful coastal lake for paddlers to explore. Paddlers can carry down and launch from the shoreline.

Lake of the Woods

- Aspen Point, Sunset Campground, and Rainbow Bay boating access sites are open.

Lake Owyhee Reservoir

- UPDATE: Gordon Gulch is open, and docks are floating with approximately 39 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Indian Creek boat ramp is open, and docks are floating with approximately 55 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Leslie Gulch boat ramp is open with 10 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: McCormack boat ramp is closed due to low water levels.

Lake Simtustus

- Pelton Park Marina and the boat launch are open.

Lava Lake

- Lava Lake campground, boating access, and the docks are open.

Lofton Reservoir

- Lofton Reservoir is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Rd (Forest Road 3790). The small boat ramp and shore provide easy access for small boats and paddlecraft.

Lookout Point Reservoir

- UPDATE: Black Canyon water level is approximately 55 feet *below* the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Water is approximately 24 feet over the end of the Signal Point ramp.
- Hampton boat ramp is closed.

Loon Lake

- Loon Lake Recreation Site is open. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year-round. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

Lost Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: Joseph Stewart has approximately 27 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Takelma has 87 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Luckiamute River

- Luckiamute Landing is open.

McKenzie River

- Frisell, Paradise, McKenzie Bridge, Bruckart Landing, Hamlin, Forest Glen, Finn Rock, Helfrich Landing, Goodpasture, Greenwood Landing, Leaburg Landing, Deerhorn Landing, Hendricks Bridge, Bellinger Landing, Hayden Bridge, and Armitage are all open
- Silver Creek Boat Launch is open. Please be careful as the viewing platform has not yet been rebuilt since the Holiday Farm Fire.

- The Middle Fork boat ramp near the Dexter Dam will be closed beginning September 11, 2023, through the summer of 2026. The exact construction completion date is currently unknown. The closure is for the Dexter Fish Facility Upgrade.
- The Westfir take out also known as Turtle Island Park is on the North Fork of the Middle Fork is open for the season.

- Doris Place and Rooke-Higgins ramps are open.

Miller Lake

- Floating docks at Gideon Day Use have been installed.
- Digit Point campground and boat launch are open.

Morgan Lake

- Morgan Lake boating access is open.

Munsel Lake

- Munsel Lake boating access is open.

Neawana Creek

- Broadway Park boating access is open.

Necanicum River

- Quatat Marine Park and Cartwright Park boating access sites in Seaside are open.

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 53% full. The boat launch is open, and four docks are floating.

Odell Lake

- Princess Creek, Trapper Creek, and Sunset Cove boat launches are now open.

Olalla Reservoir

- Boat launch is open, and the reservoir is full.

- Southwest Shore Campground is open, and paddlers can carry down to launch on the shore. This site is near a marsh area with lots of birds.
- Social Security Point is open and paddlers can carry down. If you have a high-clearance vehicle, you can launch off the beach area.
- Black Mountain Road (aka Southwest Shore) is open. Paddlers or small boats can launch from the rustic gravel ramp.

Pilcher Creek Reservoir

- Pilcher Creek ramp is open, and the docks are floating.

Plat I Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open.

Prineville Reservoir

- UPDATE: Powderhouse Cove ramp is open, and dock installed with 15 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Prineville State Park Day Use is open with 34 feet of water over the end of the ramp. The boarding docks and moorage dock are damaged and being repaired. Due to drought conditions, water will not be turned on. Non-flush restrooms are available. Please plan ahead and bring your own water.
- UPDATE: Jasper Point is open with 22 feet of water over the end of the ramp.

Rogue River

- NEW: Indian Mary Park Boat Ramp will be closed to the public August 3rd from noon through August 6th at noon for a private event.

- Access at Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek boat launch is accessible via Lower Grave Creek Rd.

- Moonshine Boat Ramp is open.
- Old Mill Park is open, and the ramp is in the water.
- Hee Hee Ilahee is open, and the ramp is in the water.

Siltcoos Lake

- Westlake County Park is open.

Siuslaw River

- Bender Landing, Deadwood, Farnham, Mapleton, Schindler, Tiernan, Konnie Memorial, Tide County Parks and Linslaw are open.
- Port of Siuslaw boat ramp is open and boom logs have been removed for the season.
- The floating restroom is installed.

Skipanon River

- Warrenton Marina is open. Moorage currently has a waiting list.

Smith Reservoir

- The campground and launch will remain closed until 2026 as part of EWEB's work to retrofit, refurbish and upgrade equipment at our Carmen-Smith Hydroelectric facility. The McKenzie River Trail and associated trailheads will remain open throughout the reconstruction period.

Snake River

- Nyssa boat ramp and docks are open. There are large voids between the boat ramp concrete planks. Use caution when launching and retrieving.
- Hells Canyon Creek boat launch is open.
- Dug Bar and Pittsburg Landing Campground are all open.

South Santiam River

- Waterloo County Boat Ramp is open

South Twin Lake

- South Twin Lake campground and adjacent boat launch are open.

Spring Creek

- Collier Memorial Park and Spring Creek Day Use are open.

Sturgeon Lake

- NEW: Oregon Health Authority (OHA) issued a recreational use health advisory for Aaron's Lake, Pete's Slough and Sturgeon Lake due to the presence of a cyanobacteria bloom and cyanotoxins above recreational use values for human exposure. Tenmile Lake

- Tenmile County Ramp is open.

Thompson Reservoir

- Eastbay Campground and boat ramp are open.

Three Creeks Lake

- Access is closed including vehicles, pedestrians, biking, equestrian use. The Deschutes National Forest aims to reconstruct the non-paved portion of Forest Service Road 16 this summer.

Tillamook Bay

- Both floating restrooms are installed.

Timothy Lake

Trail Bridge Reservoir

Trask River

- The Nestucca, Trask, Wilson, and Nehalem are getting too low to drift. Lower drifts are still floatable, but drift boats should expect to drag in a few spots.

- Triangle Lake Park is open.

Trojan Pond

- Trojan Park is open year-round for paddling and day use.

Tualatin River

- The Stark (Rivergrove) Boat Launch is open. Please follow posted hours.
- The Rood Bridge Park boat launch and dock are open.

Turner Lake

- North Turner Lake is open.

Umpqua River

- Pickett Park parking area and vault toilet boating access improvements are completed.
- Scottsburg Park ramp is open, and docks are installed.

Upper Klamath Lake

- The floating restroom is installed near Bare Island.
- Odessa campground, Rocky Point Boat Launch and Wocus Bay ramp and docks are all open.

Unity Reservoir

- UPDATE: Reservoir is 70% full, the State Park boat ramp and docks are open with 19 feet of water over the end of the dock.

Vee Lake

- Vee Lake boat launch is now open. This is a great place for small boats and paddlecraft.

Waldo Lake

- Shadow Bay is open. Access is closed from the Cedar Creek Fire Emergency. North Waldo, Island and Blair Lake Campgrounds will remain closed. [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](#)

Wallowa Lake

- Wallowa County Park and Wallowa Lake State Park are open, and the docks are floating.
