Agate Lake

- UPDATE: This small lake is a great place to practice your paddling skills and enjoy some fishing. The ramp is open, and the lake is 37% full.

Agency Lake

- ADVISORY: Oregon Health Authority (OHA) expanded a recreational use health advisory for Agency Lake and Upper Klamath Lake originally issued on July 25. [Recreational use advisory issued for Agency Lake; previous advisory for southern portion of Upper Klamath Lake expanded \(govdelivery.com\)](#)
- Henzel and Petric Park's boat ramps are open and boarding docks are installed.

Applegate Reservoir

- UPDATE: Hart-Tish ramp is open with approximately 10 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Copper ramp is open with approximately 18 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.
- UPDATE: French Gulch boating access site is open and has more than 80 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Ana Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open.

Antelope Reservoir (Malheur County)

- This boating access is open. The gravel ramp is great for small boats and paddlecraft. This is a nice place to paddle and fish.

Badger Lake

- ALERT: The Badger Lake campground and paddle access is closed due to the Boulder Fire. [Mt. Hood National Forest - Alerts & Notices \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/land-management/land-use/forestry/alerts-notices)

Beaver Creek

- The north end of Beaver Creek is open and fallen tree debris has been cleared. This makes for an hour-long paddle up the creek from the North Beaver Creek boat launch south of Newport.

Beulah Reservoir

- UPDATE: There is approximately two feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Big Lake

- Big Lake West, Big Lake campgrounds, and Big Lake Day Use boating access sites are open.

Blair Lake

- ALERT: Blair Lake Campground and boating access is closed due to the Cedar Creek Fire. [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/land-management/land-use/forestry/alerts-notices)

Blue River Reservoir

- ALERT: Lookout boat ramp and campground, the Saddle Dam boat ramp and campground and Mona Campground are all closed due to the Lookout Fire. [fseprd1130130.pdf \(usda.gov\)](#)

Boulder Lake

- ALERT: The hike-in campground and paddle access are closed due to the Boulder Fire. [Mt. Hood National Forest - Alerts & Notices \(usda.gov\)](#)

Bradley Lake

- Bradley Lake boat ramp and docks are open. Once you get past the lilies around the launch and dock area, the lake opens. This is a nice place to explore on paddlecraft.

Brownlee Reservoir

- ALERT: Idaho Department of Health and Welfare issued recreational use health advisory for Brownlee Reservoir on August 3. [DHW News Release: Harmful algal blooms identified in Hells Canyon and Brownlee Reservoirs \(mailchi.mp\)](#)
- The Spring Recreation Campground and both boat ramps are open, and the docks are installed. The water is approximately one foot over the end of the boat ramp.
- The Holcomb Park boat ramp is open. The floating restroom was removed due to dropping water levels. Baker County Parks anticipates closing the boat launch soon due to low water. The water level is nine feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- The Hewitt Park main boat ramp is closed, and the moorage and fishing docks were removed. The Hewitt low-water ramp remains open. The new vault toilet was installed. There is approximately 18 feet of water at the end of the ramp.
- Farewell Bend State Park has some broken decking on the boarding docks and one lane of the boat launch is full of woody debris. The water level is approximately 19 feet over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Moonshine Mine boat ramp is open. There is approximately 36 feet of water at the bottom of the boat ramp.

Bully Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: The docks are installed and floating with 23 feet of water over the end of the ramp.

Campbell Lake

- Campbell lake campground and the boat ramp are open.

Carmen Smith Reservoir

- The closure has been extended to the spring of 2025.

Chetco River

- Port of Brookings has a number of activities planned for the summer.

Chickahominy Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open.

Clackamas Lake

- Clackamas Lake Campground is open. This small, shallow lake is a great place to go paddling.

Clackamas River

- Milo McIver's upper boat ramp is severely undermined and out of the water.
- Sandstone Boating Access Site is closed until further notice. [Clackamas River Access Sites \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)
- Moore Creek and Hole-in-the-Wall Boat Access sites are open. The areas along the Clackamas River are still heavily impacted by wildfire. Visitors are recommended to exercise caution if pulling out at non-designated areas.

Clear Lake (Linn County)

- The gravel launch and marina are open. The launch is easy to use for paddlecraft and drift boats.

Clear Lake (Wasco County)

- The boat ramp is out of the water. The boat ramp is in very poor condition with many broken planks and exposed rebar. Many boaters are launching near the ramp in the dirt. Paddlecraft can carry down.

Coast Fork-Willamette River

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025. Coffenbury Lake

- Fort Stevens State Park Boat Launch is open. The Fort Stevens State Park cabins and yurts are unavailable from August 26th through September 16th. They are reserved for participants and instructors of the Pacific Northwest Preservation School presented by the University of Oregon School of Architecture and Environment. The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is this year's host for the annual historic preservation program.

Columbia River

- The restrooms at Port of The Dalles are closed for repair until further notice. The boat ramp, short-term tie-up dock, and pumpout and dump station are open. The marine fuel station is operated by the Yacht Club and offers fuel, both diesel and gasoline.
- Rooster Rock State Park water levels are dropping, making launching difficult. Paddlecraft can be hand launched.
- M. James Gleason restroom facility is currently closed. Portable toilets are available while repairs are underway.
- The floating restroom at Government Island near McGuire Island was installed.
- Hammond Marina in Warrenton is open. The moorage currently has a waiting list.
- Warrenton Marina is open. The moorage currently has a waiting list.
- Chinook Landing's pumpout and dump station are online.
- The City of St. Helens Courthouse Docks are open and the pumpout and dump station are operational. There will be some construction in the park throughout the summer; however, access will remain open. The bull rails on the docks are in poor condition – larger vessels should take caution.
- Irrigon Marina is open and the pumpout station is operational.
- Sand Island North and South are open.

Cooper Creek Reservoir

- The City of Sutherlin has installed two "SolarBees" near the dam. They are to improve water quality by turning over the water. Boaters should be cautious when operating near that area and need to avoid this equipment.
- Cooper Creek East and West boat ramps are open, and the docks are installed.

Coos Bay

- NEW: Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife will be holding their annual salmon derby at the California Street boat ramp on September 8th and 9th.
- South Slough Kayak Skills Training classes are available for August 26th.

- The Empire Boat Ramp has one set of docks installed.
- Repairs to North Jetty. Construction is expected to last until December, 2025.

- The California Street boat ramp and docks are open.

Coos River

- Myrtle Tree boat ramp is open.

Coquille River

- Sturdivant Park's boat ramp is open, and the docks are floating. Water levels are tidally influenced. Camping, restrooms, and a fish-cleaning station are available at the park.
- Riverton boat ramp is open.
- Arago boat ramp is open. The boarding docks are installed.
- Coquille Boat Ramp is closed for launching, but paddle craft can carry down to the water.

Cottage Grove Reservoir

- Lakeside Boat Ramp is open, and the docks are floating. There is approximately 35 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- Wilson Creek Boat Ramp is closed due to low water levels. Paddlecraft can carry down to launch.

Cougar Reservoir

- UPDATE: Slide Creek Campground is open, but the ramp is out of the water. The water is approximately 40 feet below the bottom of the ramp. Paddlers can carry down, but the terrain is difficult.
- Echo Park remains closed. The water is approximately 40 feet below the bottom of the boat ramp.
- A portion of the road by NF-1993 along the crest of Cougar Dam will be closed in both directions until September 28th for work on the dam. [Road NF-1993 across Cougar Dam closed for construction > Portland District > Portland District News Releases \(army.mil\)](#)

Crane Prairie

- Crane Prairie Day Use boating access is open. Looking down the boat ramp, the launch lane on the left is the short boat ramp. The right lane extends much further into the water.
- Crane Prairie Resort and Marina are open.
- The Rock Creek boat ramp, docks and campground are open.
- Browns Mountain boating access has a shallow slope with four-inch gaps between concrete planks. The location on the reservoir provides for calmer water and is a great place for paddlers to explore.
- Quinn River boat launch is open. The ramp has a shallow slope, and the asphalt approach is damaged and breaking apart. Paddlers can launch from the side and paddle up to the head of Quinn River or into the Ghost Forest on the reservoir. This area is very popular with anglers.
- Cow Meadow is on the Deschutes River near the confluence of Crane Prairie Reservoir. The launch is primitive, and the access road has many potholes. Proceed with caution.

Crescent Lake

- UPDATE: Crescent Lake Campground is open, and the low-water launch is available. The reservoir is 10% full.

- The Spring Campground boat launch is closed due to damage.

Crystal Creek

- Malone Springs Day Use area is located approximately 45 minutes northwest of Klamath Falls. This small paddle access is part of the Upper Klamath Canoe Trail that meanders through marshes and is part of the Upper Klamath National Wildlife Refuge. Cullaby Lake

- UPDATE: Oregon Health Authority lifted it's recreational use health advisory this week.

Cultus Lake

- Cultus Lake Campground gravel paddle launch is open. There is no day-use parking in the campground.
- Cultus Lake Day Use boat ramp and docks are open.
- Cultus Lake Resort and Marina are open.
- Little Cove, Big Cove, and West Cultus Boat-In Campground is by reservation only. Reservations can be made up to one day in advance of the arrival date.

Davis Lake

- North Davis Lake boating access and campground are closed for the 2023 season due to significant hazard tree mitigation needs.
- East Davis Lake boat launch is open.
- The lake level is very low. Limited boat launching is available at North Lava Flow Campground and West Davis Day Use site.

Deadhorse Lake

- Deadhorse Lake Campground and the boat ramp are open.

Depot Slough

- The Port's docks and the short-term tie-up docks have been removed and are unavailable between August 21st and September 15th.

Deschutes River

- Dog Lake Campground and boat launch are open.

Duncan Reservoir

- Duncan Reservoir, located near Silver Lake off Highway 31, is open. This is a great location for paddling.

East Lake

- Water levels are low, making boat launching difficult.
- Cinder Hill low-water ramp is available.
- The Hot Springs boat ramp is open.

Eel Lake

- William M. Tugman State Park boat launch and kayak launch are open.

Elk Lake (Deschutes County)

- Elk Lake campground, day use and small boat ramp are open. The boat ramp is out of the water but has a gravel surface below the ramp into the water. There is very limited parking at the boat ramp. Please be courteous when parking.
- Point Campground boat ramp is open. There is a larger gravel parking area.
- Little Fawn boat ramp is open, there is limited parking and maneuvering area for a boat trailer. This is a great location for paddlecraft to launch.
- Elk Lake Resort and Marina is open. There are several swim docks around the marina. The lake is very popular for sailing.
- Beach Day use area has parking for single cars and the beach is a great location for paddlers and swimmers.

Emigrant Lake

- The West dock has been tied to the top of the ramp. The lake is 27% full. The North ramp is open.

Estacada Lake

- Estacada Lake Launch (Milo McIver State Park). The boarding docks are damaged adjacent to the kayak launch. Paddlers are asked to not stage on the boarding docks. Please do not park in the boat ramp maneuver area. Be courteous and patient with others when launching.

- Timber Park's nonmotorized boat launch is open. A new \$5.00 parking permit is required and can be paid for by credit card at the fee machines. A \$40 season pass is available by calling or emailing: [503-464-8515](tel:503-464-8515), pgeparks@pgn.com.

Fall Creek Reservoir

- ALERT: All public access sites are closed to help with mitigation efforts due to the Bedrock wildfire.

Faraday Lake

- The lake, park and surrounding areas are closed for construction. Parking near the bridge and access to all areas across the bridge (Southeast of the Clackamas River) are closed. The area is anticipated to be reopened in 2024. [Faraday Lake \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com)

Fern Ridge Reservoir

- Perkins Peninsula Park is open with three feet of water at the end of the ramp.
- Orchard Point Marina is open. There is approximately seven feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp. The pumpout and dump station are back online.
- Fern Ridge Shores has four feet of water at the bottom of the ramp.
- Richardson Park Marina is open. There is approximately six feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Foster Reservoir

- ALERT: The release of water from Green Peter Reservoir is bringing woody debris into Foster Reservoir. Please keep a sharp lookout.
- Calkins Park Boat Ramp is open with approximately four feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- Gedney Creek is open and there is 16 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp.
- Sunnyside Boat ramp is open. The water is approximately 26 feet over the end of the ramp.

Fourmile Lake

- UPDATE: The reservoir is approximately 15% full. Fourmile Lake Campground and boat ramp are open.

Galesville Reservoir

- Chief Miwaleta ramp is open. The county repaired the docks.

Garrison Lake (Port Orford)

- 12th Street boat ramp and docks are open. Pinehurst gravel ramp is open. This is a great access site for paddle craft to explore the lake.

Gold Lake

- The Gold Lake Campground is open.

Green Peter Reservoir

- UPDATE: Thistle Creek boat ramp reopened on August 15. There is approximately 21 feet of water over the bottom of the low-water ramp.

Green Point Reservoir/ Kingsley Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open.

Haystack Reservoir

- UPDATE: The West Shore and Crooked River Campground boating access sites are open. The reservoir is 81% full.

Heart Lake

- Heart Lake Landing is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Hells Canyon Reservoir

- ADVISORY: Idaho Department of Health and Welfare issued recreational use health advisory for Brownlee Reservoir on August 3. [DHW News Release: Harmful algal blooms identified in Hells Canyon and Brownlee Reservoirs \(mailchi.mp\)](mailto:mailchi.mp)

- Copperfield boat launch is open, and the dock is floating.

Henry Hagg Lake

- UPDATE: Ramp A is open with 45 feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Ramp C is open with 35 feet of water over the end of the ramp.

Hills Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: Bingham Boat Launch is a small, day-use-only launch at the south end of the Hills Creek Reservoir. The water is approximately 30 feet *below* the bottom of the ramp. Please note that this ramp requires higher water levels to be accessible by boats. The nearby Packard Boat Launch is usually accessible year-round.
- UPDATE: CT Beach is open. The water level is 17 feet *below* the bottom of the ramp. This is a nice location for paddlers to carry down.
- UPDATE: Packard Creek Boat Ramp is open and there is approximately 50 feet of water over the bottom of the ramp.

Holbrook Reservoir

- ALERT: The Fremont-Winema National Forest recommends caution. Toxic algae may be present, and the lake may be unsafe for people and pets. Follow caution sign instructions posted at the site.
- Holbrook Reservoir Campground is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790).

Hosmer Lake

- UPDATE: Hosmer Lake boat ramp is open. There is limited parking. Please be mindful of other boaters needing to use the parking area.

Howard Prairie Reservoir

- UPDATE: Howard Prairie Marina and boat ramp are open. Jackson County recommends only small, motorized boats and paddlecraft use the ramp. All other boats should use the gravel ramp by the dam. The water level is approximately 38% full.

Hyatt Lake

- UPDATE: The lake is approximately 43% full. Wildcat Campground is open and has a small undeveloped boat ramp. Mountain View Boat Ramp is open.
- All other camping facilities at the Hyatt Lake Recreation Area will be closed in 2023 for utility upgrades. [Hyatt Lake Recreation Area, Hyatt Reservoir - Recreation.gov](#)

Illinois River

- ALERT: USFS has closed the Illinois River from Miami Bar Boat Ramp to the river mouth with the Rogue River at Agness. [Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest - Alerts & Notices \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/land-management/land-use/forests/rookie-river-siskiyou-national-forest/alerts-notice)

Kilchis River

- The Nestucca, Trask, Wilson, Kilchis, Miami, Necanicum and Nehalem water levels are getting very low. Boat ramps on these rivers will be mostly out of the water. In addition, many floats have gotten too low to float for drift boats but are still navigable by single person craft such as kayaks.

Kinglsey Reservoir/Green Point Reservoir

- Kingsley Campground and boat ramp are open. Campfires are not allowed in the campground.

Lake Billy Chinook

- Perry South Day Use, Cove Palisades Resort and Marina, Crooked River Day Use and Upper Deschutes Day Use boat ramps are open.

Lake Harriet

- Lake Harriet Campground and Day Use area are open.

Lake of the Woods

- Aspen Point, Sunset Campground, and Rainbow Bay boating access sites are open.
- Lake of the Woods Resort is open.

Lake Owyhee Reservoir

- UPDATE: Gordon Gulch boat ramp and docks are open with approximately 32 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Indian Creek boat ramp is open, and docks are floating with approximately 48 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- UPDATE: Leslie Gulch boat ramp is open with three feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- McCormack boat ramp is closed for the season.

Lake Simtustus

- Pelton Park Marina and Boat Launch are open. The boat ramp has a shallow slope and may be difficult to use for larger boats.
- Reservations for Indian Park Campground are now available online through the Warm Springs Fisheries Department. [Indian Park Camping – Check Availability – Department of Fisheries \(warmsprings-nsn.gov\)](http://www.warmsprings-nsn.gov/IndianParkCamping)

Lake Wallula

- NEW: Hat Rock State Park is open, and the docks are floating.

Lava Lake

- Lava Lake campground, boating access, and docks are open. CAUTION, there is a large broken concrete area (roughly two feet *below* the water and halfway across the ramp) with a drop of a few inches before the concrete planks.
- Lava Lake Resort and Marina is open. There is a small primitive ramp through the reeds, where paddlecraft can launch.

Laurance Lake

- The East and West boat launches are open. This is a great place to go paddling and try kayak fishing. If Trillium and Lost Lake are busy, consider this as a great alternative.

Little Cultus Lake

- The boat ramp is open and there is a small parking area for boaters.

Little Lava Lake

- This gravel launch and small parking area are great for paddlecraft and small boats.

Lofton Reservoir

- Lofton Reservoir is open and accessible via Fishhole Creek Road (Forest Road 3790). The small boat ramp and shore provide easy access for small boats and paddlecraft.

Lookout Point Reservoir

- Signal Point boat ramp has approximately 10 feet of water over the end of the boat ramp. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers anticipates closing this ramp by the end of August due to the reservoir being drawn down.

- Black Canyon water level is more than 65 feet *below* the boat ramp. Meridian and Hampton boat ramps are closed.

Loon Lake

- Loon Lake Recreation Site is open through September 30th. The East Shore Day Use Area is open year-round. Paddlecraft can carry down from the Day Use Area.

Lost Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: Joseph Stewart has approximately eight feet of water over the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Takelma has approximately 68 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.
- Temporary Closure of Takelma Boat Ramp. Over the next few weeks, Jackson County will be working to remove the large concrete blocks that line the land side of the Takelma Boat Ramp. While crews are working in the area, the ramp will be closed to all traffic. The County is currently lining up equipment and manpower for this work and once there is a clear start date, it will be updated here. The bulk of this work is expected during weekday mornings to reduce impacts from the closure. The boat ramp at Joseph Stewart County Park will be the next best option for lake access during these periodic closures.

Lost Lake (Hood River)

- Lost Lake boat ramp in the day-use area is open. This popular paddling lake is fun to explore with great views.
- Lost Lake Resort is open.

Luckiamute River

- Luckiamute Landing and boat-in camping area are open.

McKenzie River

- ALERT: Frissell, Paradise Campground and boat ramp and the McKenzie Bridge boating access sites are closed due to the Lookout Fire. [fseprd1130130.pdf \(usda.gov\)](https://www.usda.gov/land-management/land-use/lookout-fire)
- Bruckart Landing, Hamlin, Forest Glen, Finn Rock, Helfrich Landing, Goodpasture, Greenwood Landing, Leaburg Landing, Deerhorn Landing, Hendricks Bridge, Bellinger Landing, Hayden Bridge, and Armitage are all open.

- Silver Creek Boat Launch is open. Please be careful as the viewing platform has not yet been rebuilt since the Holiday Farm Fire.
- Approximately ¼ mile below Ollalie Campground there is a full-spanning strainer. To find or report boating obstructions or hazards visit [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](https://arcgis.com).
- Ben and Kay Dorris State Park: The single boat ramp is open. The park only has a restroom, road, and limited parking, due to the Holiday Fire.

Mercer Lake

- Mercer Lake Landing is open.

Miami River

- The Nestucca, Trask, Wilson, Kilchis, Miami, Necanicum and Nehalem water levels are getting very low. Boat ramps on these rivers will be mostly out of the water. In addition, many floats have gotten too low to float for drift boats but are still navigable by single person craft such as pontoon boats and kayaks.

Middle Fork Willamette River

- The Middle Fork boat ramp near the Dexter Dam will be closed beginning September 11, 2023, through the summer of 2026. The exact construction completion date is currently unknown. The closure is for the Dexter Fish Facility Upgrade.
- The Westfir takeout, also known as Turtle Island Park, is on the North Fork of the Middle Fork Willamette River, and the takeout is open.
- Pengra Access ramp is open.

Millicoma River

- Doris Place and Rooke-Higgins ramps are open.

Miller Lake

- The floating docks at Gideon Day Use were installed.
- Digit Point campground and boat launch are open.

Morgan Lake

- Morgan Lake boating access is open.

Munsel Lake

- Munsel Lake boating access is open.

Neawana Creek

- Broadway Park boating access is open.

Necanicum River

- The Nestucca, Trask, Wilson, Kilchis, Miami, Necanicum and Nehalem water levels are getting very low. Boat ramps on these rivers will be mostly out of the water. In addition, many floats have gotten too low to float for drift boats but are still navigable by single person craft such as kayaks.
- Quatat Marine Park and Cartwright Park boating access sites in Seaside are open.

Nehalem River

- Wheeler boat ramp is open. Access to the docks is closed because of gangway damage. The city plans to remove and repair the gangway at the beginning of November.
- The Nestucca, Trask, Wilson, Kilchis, Miami, Necanicum and Nehalem water levels are getting very low. Boat ramps on these rivers will be mostly out of the water. In addition, many floats have gotten too low to float for drift boats but are still navigable by single person craft such as kayaks.

Nestucca River

- The Nestucca, Trask, Wilson, Kilchis, Miami, Necanicum and Nehalem water levels are getting very low. Boat ramps on these rivers will be mostly out of the water. In addition, many floats have gotten too low to float for drift boats but are still navigable by single person craft such as kayaks.

North Fork Reservoir

- North Fork Lower Launch and Promontory Park launches are currently open; however, launches may be temporarily closed for aerial firefighting efforts without notice. [Parks & Campgrounds \(portlandgeneral.com\)](http://portlandgeneral.com) Elodea, an aquatic weed, is growing at the launch area. Remember to Clean, Drain, and Dry your boat and throw away any visible weeds at the site before transit. Ensure the drain plug is also removed to allow water to drain.

North Santiam River

- Jefferson boat ramp is open; however, water levels are extremely low, making it difficult for motorized boats to launch. The ramp is gated, please contact the City of Jefferson City Hall for access. [Contact - The City of Jefferson Oregon Welcomes You](#)
- Greens Bridge access is closed for the summer. Anglers who wish to launch or retrieve from this site must apply for a key by calling the local ODFW office at [541-757-4186](tel:541-757-4186) and provide your fishing license number.
- Greens Bridge to Jefferson is dangerous. Jefferson Fire District recommends staying off this section of the river. There are strainers, strong currents, cold water, undercurrents/whirlpools, and low-head dams. Please plan ahead. [Boating Obstruction Reporting Tools \(arcgis.com\)](#)
- Buell Miller Boat Ramp is open.
- Fishermen's Bend Recreation Site will remain open; however, there will be no sanitation available.
- Lyons-Mehama and Stayton Bridge boat ramps are open.

North Twin Lake

- The campground and boating access are open. This rustic site is a great location for paddlers to explore. If you are looking for more amenities, travel a little farther to South Twin Lake.

North Umpqua River

- Bogus Creek raft launch is closed from the Archie Creek fire. The U.S. Forest Service is working on plans to rebuild the boating access.
- The Winchester Dam repairs are underway and expected to be completed by August 28. We recommend boaters check the water levels to determine if there is enough water flow for their boating activities.

Ochoco Lake

- UPDATE: The reservoir is 42% full. The boat launch is open.

Odell Lake

- Princess Creek, Trapper Creek, and Sunset Cove boat launches are open.

Olalla Reservoir

- The boat launch is open.

Pacific Ocean

- Cape Kiwanda construction will create limited access from October 2023 until the spring of 2024. [Parks Department | Tillamook County OR](#)

Paulina Lake

- Little Crater campground and day use are open. Little Crater Campground will close on September 24, 2023.
- Paulina Lake campground and day use are open.

Phillips Reservoir

- Union Creek boat ramp and Mason boat ramp are open.
- Social Security Point is open, and paddlers can carry down. If you have high clearance vehicle, you can launch off the beach area.
- Black Mountain Road (aka Southwest Shore) is open. Paddlers or small boats can launch from the rustic gravel ramp.

Pilcher Creek Reservoir

- NEW: Pilcher Creek ramp is open, but the docks have been removed and launching is unavailable due to low water.

Plat I Reservoir

- The boat ramp is open.

Prineville Reservoir

- UPDATE: The floating restroom is in the water and the reservoir is 73% full.
- UPDATE: Powderhouse Cove ramp is open, and the dock is installed, water is fluctuating at the end of the ramp.
- UPDATE: Prineville State Park Day Use is open with 28 feet of water over the end of the ramp. The moorage dock is available. Due to drought conditions, water will not be turned on. Vault or portable restrooms are available. Please plan ahead and bring your own water.
- UPDATE: Jasper Point is open with 16 feet of water over the end of the ramp.

Port of Bandon

- NEW: Bandon Marina Boat Ramp will be closed on September 18th for construction and will likely remain closed through the end of 2023.

Rogue River

- Access at Argo Recreation Site is closed until further notice due to the Rum Creek Fire. The road is closed just past Alameda Campground to the Grave Creek Bridge.
- Access to Grave Creek boat launch is accessible via Lower Grave Creek Rd.
- Casey, Shady Cove, Rogue Elk, Dodge Bridge, TouVelle State Park, Valley of the Rogue State Park, Dees Landing (Coyote Evans Wayside), Pierce Riffle, Chinook Park, Baker Park, Schroeder, Lathrop Landing, Matson, Griffin Park, Ferry Hole, Robertson Bridge, Hog Creek, Indian Mary, Ennis Riffle, Galice, Rand and Alameda boating access are all open.

Saunders Lake

- Saunders Lake ramp is open.

Scout Lake

- This small lake is a great location to enjoy paddling. Located approximately 15 miles northwest of Sisters.

Siletz River

- Moonshine Boat Ramp is open.
- Old Mill Park is open, and the ramp is in the water.
- Hee Hee Ilahee is open, and the ramp is in the water.

Siltcoos Lake

- Westlake County Park is open.

Siuslaw River

- Bender Landing, Deadwood, Farnham, Mapleton, Schindler, Tiernan, Konnie Memorial, Tide County Parks and Linslaw are open.
- Port of Siuslaw boat ramp is open.
- The floating restroom is installed.

Suttle Lake

- Blue Bay, Link Creek, South Shore and Suttle Lake Boating access sites are open, and docks are installed.

Tahkenitch Lake

- Tahkenitch Day Use and Campground are open. The boat ramp is damaged and is partially closed. The left side of the ramp is open and available.

Tenmile Lake

- NEW: Labor Day Sailing Regatta is scheduled September 2nd, from 11:00 am through September 4th, at 5:00 pm.
- Tenmile County Ramp is open.

Thief Valley Reservoir

- UPDATE: Thief Valley Reservoir is 22% full, and the boat ramp is open, but the docks are out of the water and launching is inadvisable due to low water.

Thompson Reservoir

- Eastbay Campground and Thompson Reservoir Campground boat ramps are open.

Three Creeks Lake

- There is a small gravel launch before the Creeks Store and a limited amount of camping, but lots of carry-down access. This is a great place for paddlers to explore.

Tillamook Bay

- All Port of Garibaldi facilities are open, and both of the floating restrooms are installed.

Timothy Lake

- Stone Creek campground paddlecraft launching is currently from the shoreline. PGE plans to install a nonmotorized kayak launch in 2024.
- North Arm, Oak Fork, Pine Point, Stone Creek, and West Shore Day Use areas are open; however, check the following link to see if launches are closed temporarily for aerial firefighting without notice. [Parks & Campgrounds \(portlandgeneral.com\)](https://portlandgeneral.com)

Todd Lake

- The road out to Todd Lake paddle access is rough. High clearance vehicles are recommended.

Trail Bridge Reservoir

- The campground and launch will remain closed until 2026 as part of EWEB's work to retrofit, refurbish and upgrade equipment at our Carmen-Smith Hydroelectric facility. The McKenzie River Trail and associated trailheads will remain open throughout the reconstruction period.

Trask River

- The Nestucca, Trask, Wilson, Kilchis, Miami, Necanicum and Nehalem water levels are getting very low. Boat ramps on these rivers will be mostly out of the water. In addition, many floats have gotten too low to float for drift boats but are still navigable by single person craft such as kayaks.

Triangle Lake

- Triangle Lake Park is open.

Trojan Pond

- Trojan Park is open year-round for paddling and day use.

Turner Lake

- North Turner Lake boat ramp and boarding docks are open.

Umpqua River

- The Federal channels of the East and West Basin, and the Commercial Docks of Salmon Harbor Marina are scheduled for dredging around August 21st and should take 3-4 weeks to complete.
- Pickett Park parking area and vault toilet boating access improvements are completed.
- Scottsburg Park ramp is open, and docks are installed.

Upper Klamath Lake

- ADVISORY: Oregon Health Authority (OHA) issued a recreational use health advisory July 25, 2023 [Recreational use advisory issued for Agency Lake; previous advisory for southern portion of Upper Klamath Lake expanded \(govdelivery.com\)](https://www.govdelivery.com)

- The floating restroom is installed near Bare Island.
- Odessa campground, Rocky Point Boat Launch and Wocus Bay ramp and docks are open.

Unity Reservoir

- UPDATE: The State Park boat ramp and docks are open with 11 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Vee Lake

- Vee Lake boat launch is open. This is a great place for small boats and paddlecraft.

Waldo Lake

- Shadow Bay boating access is open. North Waldo and Islet Campgrounds are closed and Blair Lake Campgrounds will remain closed. [fseprd1049655.pdf \(usda.gov\)](#)

Wallowa Lake

- Wallowa County Park and Wallowa Lake State Park are open, and docks are floating.

Warm Springs Reservoir

- UPDATE: The boat ramp is open with approximately 10 feet of water over the bottom of the boat ramp.

Wickiup Reservoir

- UPDATE: North Wickiup dock is not installed because the transition plate was stolen. The reservoir is 25% full.
- Gull Point and Reservoir Campground Boating access is closed for 2023 for U.S. Forest Service to address 679 hazardous trees. [Deschutes National Forest - News & Events \(usda.gov\)](#)

Lower Willamette (Columbia River to Willamette Falls)

- NEW: Jon Storm Park's pumpout and dump station is back in service. The dock and restrooms are open, but the parking lot will be closed until completion of the I-205 bridge widening project.
- Sportcraft Landing, the boat ramp, boarding docks and lower parking area are open. The ODOT bridge contractor is working, so watch for barges and work boats in the area.

Middle Willamette (Willamette Falls to Salem)

- Rogers Landing short-term tie-up dock fire damage repairs are completed.
- Champoeg State Park paddle launch dock is bent. The dock is still open for use.

Upper Willamette (Salem to Eugene)

- The Highway 58 bridge at Dilley Lane is part of the larger Lower Salt Creek Bridge project for seismic retrofits and scour protection. The boating access will be closed during construction. The Federal Highway Administration is working with the contractor for an anticipated schedule. The work may happen as early as June 2023 or sometime in 2024 or 2025. Withers Lake

- Withers Lake trailhead and hand-carry down boat launch are open and accessible.

Woahink Lake

- Both lanes of East Woahink Lake boat ramp are open.

Wolf Creek Reservoir

- UPDATE: Wolf Creek boating access is open, but the docks are out of the water. Launching is possible but, water levels are very low.

Wood River

- Wood River Day Use area is open. There is carry-down paddle access.

Yaquina Bay
