

RE: Post-seizure notice for boat registered as WN 9098 SA

Dear Mr. Barclay,

A 15' Bayliner open motorboat with registration number WN 9098 SA has been seized by the Oregon State Marine Board Oregon from the bank of the Columbia River in Multnomah County. Pursuant to state law ORS 830.908, this boat is declared an abandoned vessel due to being left without authorization on public property. According to records provided by the State of Washington, you are the titled owner of this vessel.





You may immediately reclaim this vessel by presenting proof of identification and moving the vessel to a place where it can be lawfully kept. No direct costs related to this vessel have been accrued so far, but the costs of salvaging, towing, and disposing of the vessel are anticipated to be approximately \$4,000. The final total could be higher or lower than this and will be determined by the final invoice from the selected contractor.

Failure to reclaim the boat by **January 8, 2021** will cause the title to the boat and all personal property found in the boat to be vested with the enforcement agency and will then be disposed of. You, as the owner, will remain liable for all salvage, towing, and disposal costs. You may request a hearing by submitting a written request no later than **December 23, 2021** to the Oregon State Marine Board at the address listed. The request for a hearing must include a statement of the specific grounds on which the seizure is challenged and whether you challenge the reasonableness of any salvage, towing or storage costs incurred by the Oregon State Marine Board.
