Re: PRE-SEIZURE NOTICE OF VESSEL: Ken & Al

Dear Mr. Graves,

A 75' blue and white fishing vessel named the Ken & Al, currently owned by you, is unlawfully beached, derelict, and abandoned on the shore of Lois Island, in Clatsop County, in the State of Oregon. Your fishing vessel has been anchored in the area unlawfully for numerous months. You have been asked and told to move it to a safe and legal spot several times.



The Clatsop County Sheriff's Office proposes to seize the above-mentioned vessel by reason of it meeting the statutory definition of an "Abandoned Vessel" under ORS: 830.911. The above-mentioned vessel will be seized due to it being abandoned without authorization on waters of this state, if it is not moved to a place where the vessel can be lawfully kept, within the time specified in this notice.

As the owner, you are responsible for moving the vessel to a location where it can be lawfully kept. If you fail to move the vessel prior to the date specified in this notice, the Clatsop County Sheriff's Office will be authorized to seize the vessel.

Furthermore, you may be cited for failure to remove an abandoned vessel and failure to register and title the vessel. If the vessel is seized, you will be liable for the costs of salvage, towing, and storage of the vessel. If the costs of salvage, towing, and storage are not paid, the vessel may be destroyed or sold, and you will remain liable for unpaid costs.

To prevent the seizure of your vessel and possible citations for failure to remove an abandoned vessel, you must move the vessel to a location where it can be lawfully kept prior to the following date and time: **April 2, 2026 @ 5:00 pm**

You have the right to request a hearing to challenge the seizure of the vessel. If you wish to request a hearing, you must submit your request in writing to the Clatsop County Sheriff's Office prior to the deadline given above. You must indicate the specific grounds on which the seizure of the vessel is challenged.
