AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES PREVENTION PERMIT

Beginning January 1, 2010, Oregon motorboat and sailboat operators will see a \$5 surcharge added to their boat registration fee.

Current registration decal acts as proof of payment.

Decals are valid for two calendar years.

Operators of out-of-state motorboats and sailboats should clean their boats before entering Oregon and must purchase an annual \$22 (\$20 permit plus \$2 agent fee) AIS prevention permit, available at ODFW license agents or online at:

CLEAN all aquatic plants, animals and mud from your boat, motor or trailer and discard in the trash. Rinse, scrub or pressure wash, as appropriate away from storm drains, ditches or waterways. Lawns, gravel pads, or self-serve car washes are best.

DRAIN livewell, bilge and internal compartments.

DRY your boat between uses if possible. Leave compartments open and sponge out standing water. Find a place that will allow the anchor line to dry.

Clean, Drain, Dry.
