

Title Situation	Documents Required
Brand new boat	MSO (manufacturers statement of origin) or MCO (manufacturers certificate of origin) with application completed and signed with fees.
Never been titled or registered anywhere	Bill of Sale, Boat History Form, application completed and signed with fees. (May require inspection by county marine patrol)
Oregon Title Transfer	Original Oregon Certificate of Title for a Boat with releases of all owner(s) and/or lienholder(s) listed on the title. Application on the back completed and signed with fees.
Homebuilt boat	Homebuilt Boat Builder Certificate, application completed and signed with fees. (May require inspection by county marine patrol)
Oregon Lost Title transfer	Oregon Lost Boat Title Application with signature verification of all owners of record in section 2. Section 3 completed and signed by all new owners with fees.
Oregon title transfer where owner(s) deceased	The original boat title or properly signed lost title form. Copy of proof of death for each deceased owner. Ex: death certificate, obituary, or funeral service announcement. Either Letters of Testamentary appointing a personal representative or executor. Or a copy of the will, (first page, page indicating who can sign for the deceased and the last page signed) If the estate was not probated, or a spouse was not listed as an owner or co-owner, a completed Inheritance Affidavit. Application completed and signed with fees.
Removal of Lienholder from Oregon boat title	Oregon Certificate of Title for a Boat released by all lender(s) or if not released on title, include a lien release letter or form. Application on back of title completed and signed with fees.
Titled in another state or country	Other state original boat title or other country legal ownership documentation with proper releases. If paperless WA title, Affidavit in Lieu of Title from WA DOL. If other country, US Customs documentation. Application completed and signed with fees.
Registered in a Non-Titling State	Original registration document with release signature or printout of current ownership on state letterhead, Bill of Sale, application completed and signed with fees.
Owner(s) deceased on out of state title or registered in non-titling state	The original boat title or properly signed lost title form with a copy of the out of state boat record showing proper owners signed. Copy of proof of death for each deceased owner. Ex: death certificate, obituary, or funeral service announcement. Either Letters of Testamentary appointing a personal representative or executor. Or a copy of the will, (first page, page indicating who can sign for the deceased and the last page signed) If the estate was not probated, or a spouse was not listed as an owner or co-owner, a completed Inheritance Affidavit. Application completed and signed with fees.
Oregon title transfer with Power of Attorney (POA) authorized transaction	Original Oregon boat title, Power of Attorney document authorizing the transaction on behalf of the owner(s) properly exercised. Application on the back of the title completed and signed with fees.
Name change because of marriage of an owner on Oregon title	Original Oregon boat title or properly signed lost title form, copy of Marriage Certificate, current Driver License (front and back) or other legal or court document, completed, signed application with fees.
Name change because of divorce	Copy of Divorce Decree, first page, signature page and page(s) awarding the boat. Original Oregon boat title or properly signed Lost Title form with fees.
Transfer into or out of a Trust	Copy of Trust (first page, page designating trustee(s) or successor trustee(s), signature page) or Certification of Trust with the original Oregon Certificate of Title for a Boat or properly signed Lost Title Application form with fees.
Repossession purchase	Original Repossession Certificate, Bill of Sale, original Oregon Certificate of Title for a Boat or properly signed Lost Title Application form with fees.

Possessory Lien purchase	Original properly completed Certification of Foreclosure of Possessory Lien form, proof of notification to all owner(s) and lienholder(s) of record, Bill of Sale, completed and signed application with fees. (may require inspection by county marine patrol)
Lapsed or purged Oregon boat record not in system, same owner(s), only renewing registration	Contact the Marine Board for assistance at (503) 378-8587 or marine.board@boat.oregon.gov or take a copy of proof of ownership to a local Boat Registration Agent
US Coast Guard Documented Vessel, registering only	Copy of current Certificate of Documentation plus Bill of Sale if Change of Ownership or USCG issued temporary Certificate of Documentation
US Coast Guard Documented Vessel now titling in Oregon?	Letter of Deletion from the USCG National Documentation Center plus Bill of Sale if Change of Ownership.
