

OG Fee Restructure Legislation

Timeline

July 2024: Marine Board approved LC0344

August 2024: GAC reviewed LC03444

Oct 24' – Feb 25': Public Engagement

Feb 19: Public Hearing

Mar 03: Work Session

May 07: Work Session

May 16: Work Session

June 20: Governor signed.

Public engagement and feedback from Outfitter Guide community shaped -1 amendment including removal of per employee registration fee and establishing additional Charter Guide registration fee.

"Charter Guide" means an outfitter and guide who:

- (a) Possesses a valid United States Coast Guard operator license; and
- (b) Carries no more than six passengers for hire for outdoor recreational activities on federally navigable waterways

"Crew member" means an employee who:

- (a) Assists with angling activities, or in the operation of watercraft used for angling, while aboard a boat;
- (b) Works under the direct supervision of a charter guide, or of an outfitter and guide, who is physically present and in direct communication with the crew member; and
- (c) Is registered with the State Marine Board as a crew member

Passed Legislation

HB 2558 Overview

- Restructured fees so that an annual OG registration is the same for an Oregon resident and non-resident
 - The annual registration fee is \$350
- Established an additional fee for Charter Guides
 - The annual additional fee is \$150
 - Modify (simplify) "Charter Guide" definition
- Establish registration and fee for Crew Member
 - The annual registration fee is \$50
 - Establish "Crew Member" definition
- Increase OG civil penalties for first and subsequent violations (civil penalty not to exceed amount is \$1,000)





Charter Guide = Outfitter Guide with USCG Merchant Mariner Credential (6-pk license)
All oval decals will have max 6 passengers – overloading laws apply
