Re: Collection of Multnomah County Vehicle Fees

MULTNOMAH COUNTY TO IMPLEMENT COUNTY REGISTRATION FEES• Effective with vehicle registrations expiring September 1, 2010, DMV will begin collecting county vehicle registration fees for Multnomah County subject vehicles. HB 2001, passed by the 2009 Oregon Legislature, allows counties with a population of over 350,000 to charge their residents county vehicle registration fees. The fees must be used to fund the replacement of the Sellwood Bridge in Portland.

Vehicles subject to county registration fees: Passenger, motorcycles, mopeds, low-speed and medium-speed, trucks (under 26,001 lbs.), light trailers, for-rent trailers, heavy trailers, buses, tow trucks (under 26,001 lbs.), charitable non-profit (passenger, truck or bus), special use trailers, permanent fleet and manufactured structure totters (under 26,001 lbs.).

Exempt vehicles: Snowmobiles, class I all-terrain, fixed load, vehicles registered to disabled veterans, antique, special interest, government-owned or operated, school buses or school activity vehicles, law enforcement or undercover vehicles, vehicles registered proportionally for interstate operation, vehicles with a registration of 26,001 or more, farm, travel trailers, campers and motor homes.

County registration fees will be collected by DMV when state registration fees are collected. Multnomah County will charge their residents/customers \$19 per year for county vehicle registration. The appearance of the registration card will not change. Only one registration card will be issued to the customer, i.e., customers will not be required to carry two registration cards. Therefore, Multnomah County residents/customers in possession of a current valid registration card or, as indicated by DMV record, displays current valid registration, have also satisfied the requirement for county registration fees.
