[Chapter 18, Protection Order File / Brady Indicator](#)

The following areas have been updated to clarify the language for entry of the Brady Code and Brady Code Indicator, Sections 18.5.7 & 18.18.4.

Section 18.8 Validations has been modified so it matches instructions for LEDs Representatives in LEDs Representative, Section 7, Validations.

Section: 18.18.39 - a new NCIC—NIC Number letter has been added. Letter "Z" which refers to a Gang Record.

[Chapter 18, Protection Order File / Restraining Orders](#)

It has been brought to our attention that many counties are not faxing Restraining Orders to be served to the sheriff's office, instead they are sending hard copies only which can delay the service significantly.

Please be aware that you are permitted to fax the restraining order to the sheriff's office. ORS 107.723 specifically address this issue:

107.723 Service of restraining order; facsimile by sheriff.(1) A sheriff may serve a restraining order under ORS 107.718 in the county in which the sheriff was elected and in any other county that is adjacent to the county in which the sheriff was elected.

(2) A sheriff may serve and enter into the Law Enforcement Data System a facsimile of a certified true copy of a restraining order under ORS 107.718 that was transmitted to the sheriff by a trial court administrator or another sheriff using a telephonic facsimile communication device. A copy of the facsimile must be attached to the sheriff's return of service. Before transmitting a restraining order to a sheriff under this subsection, the person sending the facsimile must receive confirmation by telephone from the sheriff's office that a telephonic facsimile communication device is available and operating. DMV Bulletin—Issuing New 90 Day Temporary Permits

On July 1, 2009, Oregon began issuing a new 90-day temporary permit to applicants who meet all requirements for a driver license or permit except that they need additional time to acquire documents to prove lawful presence or SSN. DMV has received several complaints from citizens who were informed by law enforcement that their temporary permits were not valid. There may be some confusion as to how to verify that a 90-day temporary permit is valid.

Status inquiries on DMV's computer systems may show that a customer carrying a valid temporary permit has "No Oregon License." However these permits give full driving privileges for the class of license as stated on the permit. Information to verify the permit will appear in the body of the holder's driving record as shown below.

PERMIT 05/07/09 EXP: 07/07/09 LPSS LP578989

In the example, PERMIT means that a temporary permit was issued; 05/07/09 is the issue date; 07/07/09 is the expiration date; LPSS is the permit type, Legal Presence/ Social Security Number; and LP followed by six digits is the permit number.

The temporary permit itself will indicate if the permit is for a driver license, identification card or instruction permit. If the temporary permit is for a driver license or driver permit, the type of license or permit will be included along with any endorsements or restrictions. You will not find this information on the driver's record.

An applicant temporary driver permit or ID becomes invalid if the applicant's driver license, permit of ID is issued or refused for "good cause." If, and when the applicant's driver license, permit or ID is issued or refused for good cause, the applicant must surrender his/her applicant temporary permit.

RESTRICTIONS

INSTRUCTION PERMIT: You must be accompanied by a person who has a license from the same class as, or higher than, your instruction permit. This person must be at least 21 years old and be seated beside you.

CDL INSTRUCTION PERMIT: The person accompanying you must be licensed to drive the same class of vehicle you operate. You may not operate a vehicle transporting hazardous materials.

MOTORCYCLE INSTRUCTION PERMIT:
YOU MUST:

- ★ Ride only during daylight hours.
- ★ Wear an approved helmet.
- ★ Be observed by someone (on another motorcycle) who has a license endorsed for motorcycle operation and who is at least 21 years old.
- ★ Not carry passengers.
