03/23/2020 Information Bulletin 2020-05 Logistics -PPE Distribution Process

The Office of State Fire Marshal is the state lead for ESF-4 representing the fire service during the COVID-19 response in Oregon. As limited PPE is available the OFSCRT has taken the approach to ensure distribution to the fire service is determined by input from the fire service with a methodology that represents population, call data, transport and rural areas of the state.

PPE supply is limited and this process should <u>NOT</u> be your primary plan for orders, please continue to work with vendors to supply your department's needs. The PPE that are available to order from the stockpile currently are: **N-95's, Gowns and Face Shields.**

- 1. County Emergency Manager's will submit orders of PPE on behalf of the fire service. Orders are placed into the "Ops Center" software.
- 2. OSFM will review OPS Center daily and will review orders to determine if inventory is available to fill.
- 3. The OSFM will communicate with the agency or county any issues with ability to fill or further clarification.
- 4. Orders will be shipped on Tuesdays and Thursdays, unless there is a critical need.
- 5. Many orders will not be able to be filled entirely, we are only able to fill based on availability of resources from the stock pile.
