Connecting your agency to LEDS 20/20

OSP's LEDS 20/20 is a web-based application to access LEDS. For security reasons, it is not open to the general internet, so there are a few things that need to be done in order to establish a connection.

We will need to identify the IP address used at the agency to connect to the state network. Please use the form below to provide information to assist in connecting your agency.

Additional considerations for the agency:

- 1) Does your agency use a Web proxy? If so, you may need to set an exception for the LEDS 20/20 application.
- 2) The LEDS 20/20 website is secured using SSL, users must use the fully qualified domain name of the site <https://leds2020.leds.oregon.gov/eagent>. The DNS record for this site should resolve to 159.121.180.96. If your users do not have access to public DNS a forward lookup zone can be used on the agencies' own DNS servers.
