The purpose of this message is to keep you informed of high level activities for the LEDS 20/20 project being conducted by the Oregon State Police (OSP) with assistance from the software solution vendor Diverse Computing, Inc. (DCI) and the professional services firm, Online Business Systems (OBS).

Phase 3.2 of the project has been closed. This phase was designed to transition from OSP's internal legacy criminal history user interface to the new CCH interface within the LEDS20/20 environment. This has been accomplished and Phase 3.2 is closed as of this message.

Phase 3.2 Accomplishments

- Phase Initiation commenced on August 20, 2018.
- User Acceptance Testing (UAT) conducted and completed on March 31, 2020
- Go-Live activities initiated and completed on April 15, 2020.
- External reports of minor issues were received, researched and all resolved during the post go-live period and included:
 - Arrest and disposition information displayed on the CCH in a different order than was submitted to OSP.
 - Some Hot File entries/modifications resulted in an error message.
- Official closure of Phase 3.2 completed on May 18, 2020.
