



Sex Offender Reporting In-Person Reporting Requirement

Reporting Requirements

As of June 1, 2022, phone-in registrations will not be accepted by the Sex Offender Registration Section.

In-person sex offender reporting is required under ORS Chapter 163A:

- 163A.010(3)(a)
- 163A.015(4)(a)
- 163A.020(1)(a)
- 163A.025(2)

Failure to report in person can be grounds for *Failure to Register* charges under ORS 163A.040.

Oregon law requires sex offenders to report in person at a law enforcement agency in the county where they reside. *Non-Resident Students* and *Non-Resident Workers* are required to report in person at a law enforcement agency in the county where they work or attend school.
