

Copy of Your Own Oregon Record

To obtain a copy of your own Oregon criminal history report or a clearance letter indicating that you have no Oregon criminal history, you will need to complete the following steps:

1. Obtain properly rolled set of your fingerprints using the blue applicant fingerprint card (FD258). An example of this fingerprint card can be seen at:

Please contact local police agency or fingerprinting service for information. Fingerprints may also be obtained at our office during these designated days/times:

2. Submit a \$33.00 check or money order payable to Oregon State Police, along with the completed "Copy of Own Record Request Form." For notarized requests, add an additional \$5.

The results and the fingerprint card submitted will be returned to you. Please allow 7-10 business days for us to process your request and send the results out for delivery.
