Through diverse stakeholder engagement the program is developing recommendations and supporting community-based strategies that build the resilience of our public health system.

Drawing from her studies in public health and sustainability, she takes a collaborative and systems approach. She is especially interested in solutions that advance health equity and that take an 'all-hazards' community-based approach.
