Welcome and Introductions:

Introductions were made.

Mariana reminded the committee that we are working on a short time frame; the Fire Defense Board Chief meeting will again take place in March, so the draft should be available to them by February 1st. That gives the committee about three solid months to do work on the plan.

Charter Review:

The group reviewed and approved the charter with the following objectives and tasks:

1. Examine rates for overhead volunteers and engine types 4, 5, and 7
 - Mariah will send out the charts she created for the 2013 Plan outlining personnel and apparatus rates in nearby states.
2. Establish water rescue rates
3. Ensure tender typing is consistent with federal standards
 - Alan will look into tender typing.
4. Better define unprotected lands as related to structural protection
 - Chiefs Morrow, Johnson, and Tyson will work on a definition.
5. Look into DPSST and NIMS certifications
 - Mariah will keep in touch with DPSST and distribute the recommendation when it becomes available for public comment.
6. Establish travel rates and timelines
 - Mariah will work on getting a copy of ODF's Engine & Crew Contract

7. Discuss whether the Mob Plan should be reviewed biannually
8. Clarify equipment required (SCBAs)
 - Chief Morrow will look into which apparatus types should be carrying which structural equipment.
9. Examine the addition of language to address mutual aid typing
 - Mariah will draft language.
10. Look into the use of 'Task Force' and 'Strike Team' terminology
11. Consider the addition of language addressing work/rest ratios prior to mobilization
 - Chiefs Koellermeier and Hallman will draft language.
12. Look into reimbursement of FEP-purchased vehicles
13. Discuss true typing and ways to ensure apparatus are being typed appropriately
14. Include mutual aid and Delegation of Authority scenarios at Fire Defense Board Training in March

The group agreed to discuss ways to address the use of social media, but chose to remove that conversation from the charter.
