Welcome and Approval of Minutes:

Minutes from October 30 were approved.

Task Review:

1. Examine rates for overhead volunteers; engine types 4, 5, and 7; tenders; command vehicles
 - The group agreed not to examine the overhead volunteer rate for the 2015 plan. The group approved the rates for the other apparatus as presented.
2. Better define unprotected lands as related to structural protection
 - The group tabled this issue until the next meeting. The desire is to have a document to distribute to the Fire Defense Board Chiefs outlining the issue.
3. Establish travel rates and timelines
 - The group agreed to utilize the formula ODF provided to determine appropriate travel times.
4. Clarify equipment required (SCBAs)
 - The group agreed that only type 1 & 2 engines should carry SCBAs and structural PPE for all personnel.
5. Look into reimbursement of FEP-purchased vehicles
 - It doesn't appear that purchasing apparatus through grants will have any effect on the Mob Plan.

Review of Unassigned Tasks:

1. Establish water rescue rates
 - The group agreed not to examine water rescue rates for the 2015 plan.

2. Discuss true typing and ways to ensure apparatus are being typed appropriately
 - The group agreed not to change anything in the Mob Plan and that the idea of tactical/supply tenders needs to be communicated to the ICs. If a tender is being requested to go off-road, that should be communicated by the AOC during the call to the Fire Defense Board Chief.

Fire Defense Board Training:

The group would like to see an educational piece about the types of lands, (including BLM, protected, unprotected, private, Walker Range Association, etc.), and what effect the status of land might have on a conflagration request.

Before the Next Meeting:

Mariah will create a rough draft of all the approved changes and distribute to the committee.
