2010 fire defense board chief meeting & chaplains' roundtable, April 13

Eagle Crest Resort in Redmond is the site of both the 2010 state fire defense board chief meeting and the public safety chaplains' roundtable. The public safety chaplains' roundtable is scheduled from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. with lunch provided. The fire defense board chief meeting is scheduled to begin at 1:00 p.m. Both events happen Tuesday, April 13. The purpose of the chaplains' roundtable is to share information and training and develop a list of trained chaplains available to conduct call-outs when needed. The agenda for the fire defense board chief meeting includes discussion and voting on updates to the Oregon Fire Service Mobilization Plan. All fire defense board chiefs are encouraged to attend to provide input on the proposed changes.
