### **Oregon Response Reporting System**

The OSFM has chosen ImageTrend to develop the new Oregon Response Reporting System (ORRS). Software development is underway with a planned release date of January 1, 2010. The new ORRS will replace the current Oregon All Incident Reporting System. The ORRS will be a web-based program and platform independent. Departments and districts need only internet access and a web browser to use the program. The ORRS will be compliant with the National Fire Incident Reporting System, with specific requirements added for Oregon reporting. The OSFM will provide the technical code for Oregon specific requirements to all Oregon departments and districts that use third party software for incident reporting. The OSFM will work with departments to ensure they have the necessary information to work with their vendors to update their software and include the Oregon specific reporting requirements.
