## Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue Partnerships Distribute “Report School Fires” Materials to Local Schools

The Youth Fire Intervention Program at Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue (TVF&R), along with the members of the Washington County Interagency Coordination Group (WCICG) Youth Fire Prevention and Intervention Service, is assisting the Oregon Office of State Fire Marshal’s Youth Fire Prevention & Intervention Program in distributing the new “Report School Fires” campaign materials.

Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue personnel are visiting every school in their jurisdiction to provide each principal with information promoting the campaign. The kit includes a DVD for use at school staff meetings, which encourages the reporting of every fire, every time.

The WCIC Group labels each kit with instructions on how to contact a duty investigator when response is needed for an extinguished fire found after the incident occurred. The group also produced convenient business cards with the same instructions, including the number for non-emergency dispatch.
