

You are invited to join the Bonneville Environmental Foundation and the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board for a **Strategic Action Planning Orientation**.

A Strategic Action Plan (SAP) serves as the road map for a partnership's work. It describes the long-term ecological conservation and restoration aspirations and actions with thoughtful consideration of local social and ecological context.

Many public and private funders encourage, or even require, an SAP to be eligible for funding. SAPs provide funders with a comprehensive understanding of the partnership's vision and the confidence that the partnership has done the deep work necessary to select strategies and actions with the greatest likelihood of achieving their desired ecological outcomes.

This orientation is intended for any organization or partnership wishing to develop or refine an SAP to advance restoration or conservation in Oregon, regardless of the funding program(s) they intend to pursue.

Purpose

This 2-hour session will **explore the key components of SAP development** for conservation and restoration initiatives, including:

- Benefits of preparing a SAP
- Defining a partnership's vision and goals
- Geographic and temporal scope
- Social and ecological context
- Conservation strategies
- Theory of change
- Framework for tracking progress
