_____ ("Subgrantee") acquired the _____ property (the "Property"), described and depicted on Exhibits A and B attached hereto, with grant funds (the "Grant Funds") provided by the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board ("OWEB") under OWEB Grant No. _____ (the "OWEB Grant"). The Grant Funds are composed of Oregon Lottery funds administered by OWEB (the "Oregon Lottery Funds"), and funds from National Coastal Wetlands Conservation Grant No. _____ (the "Coastal Wetlands Grant" and the "Coastal Wetlands Funds"), administered by the U.S. Department of the Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service (the "Service"), Wildlife and Sport Fish Restoration Program. A copy of the Coastal Wetlands Grant is kept on file at the office of the Service, 911 NE 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97232-4181 and at the office of OWEB (the "OWEB Office"), 775 Summer Street NE, Suite 360, Salem, Oregon 97301-1290. A copy of the OWEB Grant is kept on file at the OWEB Office.

The Property is subject to all terms and conditions of the Coastal Wetlands Grant and the OWEB Grant.

Said conveyance has been approved by the Service as part of the Coastal Wetlands Grant in accordance with 50 CFR 84.48, under the condition that OWEB designate _____ a grant subrecipient as that term is used in 2 CFR 200.331 and defined in 2 CFR 200.1.]

The Property was acquired for \$_____ using: i) \$_____ in funds from the Coastal Wetlands Grant (____% of the Property purchase price); ii) \$_____ in Oregon Lottery Funds as non-federal match funds for the Coastal Wetlands Grant (____% of the Property purchase price); and iii) \$_____ from Subgrantee as an additional non-federal contribution (____% of the Property purchase price).

The purpose of the Coastal Wetlands Grant is to protect the Property in perpetuity through fee simple acquisition and to enable restoration of the Property's ecological systems, which include tidal wetlands. Upon restoration, the Property's ecological systems will support a wide variety of fish and wildlife species, including fish stocks listed as threatened and endangered under the federal Endangered Species Act, and wetland-associated birds, amphibians, mammals, and invertebrates.

Subgrantee, or its successor in title to the Property, shall administer the Property for the conservation of said lands and waters and the hydrology and natural heritage resources dependent thereon, and will continue to use the Property for the approved purpose for which it was acquired under the Coastal Wetlands Grant.

Subgrantee, or its successor in title to the Property, shall not dispose of, transfer, or encumber any interest in the Property without the prior written approval of OWEB and the Service in accordance with disposition instructions under 2 CFR 200. Requests for said approval shall be made in writing to OWEB. The approval of the Service, if granted, will be provided in the form of written instructions as to the terms and conditions of the disposal approval, including Coastal Wetlands Funds reimbursement instructions, if required.

OWEB and Subgrantee shall not discriminate against any person during the useful life of the project in compliance with 43 CFR 17.204(c)(2) and the Assurances for Construction that OWEB signed at the time of application to the National Coastal Wetlands Conservation Grant Program.

Subgrantee's acquisition of the Property is a permanent interest in real property and therefore, OWEB and Subgrantee's responsibilities, and the Federal interest in the Property, shall last in perpetuity and will pass to any successors in title.
