Environmental cleanup, brownfields, tanks, materials management, and emergency response

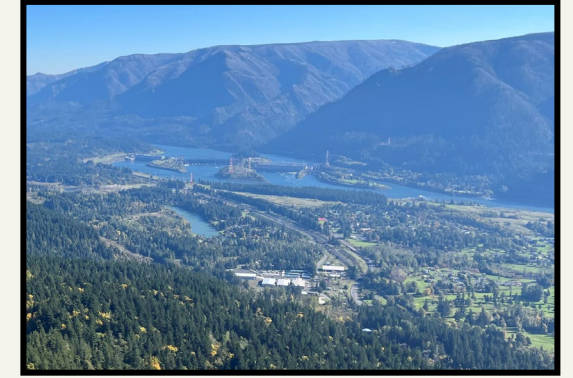
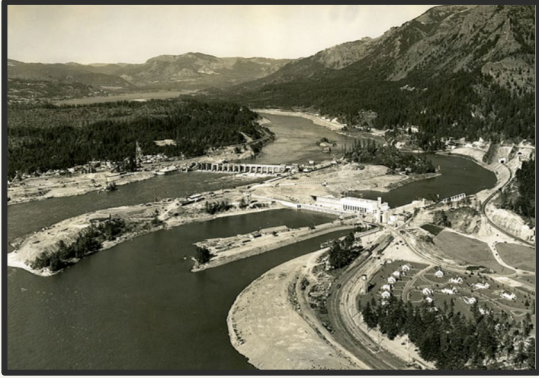

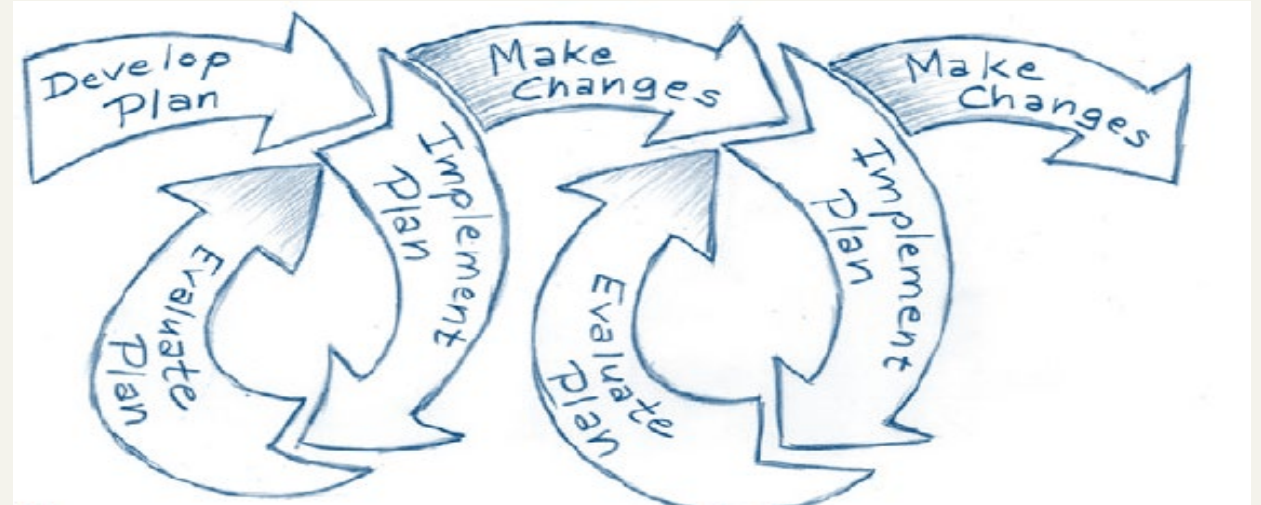
