## Permanent District Transfer Guidelines (aka 385 transfers)

## Eligibility/Criteria (OAR 690-385-4000 AND ORS 540.580(1)(a-d)

- Lands are subject to transfer [690-385-0100(17)]
- Lands are not subject to forfeiture under 540.610 [OAR 690-385-2000(m)]
- TO and FROM lands are within boundaries of the district.
- No change in character of use
- No enlargement
- No injury
- District submits a permanent district transfer application (fees per Fees ORS 536.050(1) for change in POU) [OAR 690-385-4000(5)]
  - O Before change is allowed, or [OAR 690-385-4000(5)(a)]
  - By Dec 31 of the year in which the change occurred
    - Requires a notification of the change in accordance with 690-385-4100 OAR 690-385-4000(5)(b)
- From lands are dried up

## **Process**

- (1) District obtains Landowner Authorization
  - District has on file written authorization from each landowner affected [540.580(2)(c) and OAR 690-385-2000(1)(n)]
  - District notifies each affected user that the change is subject to OWRD approval [540.580(3)(a)]
    - OWRD may direct district to cease delivery, or ORS 540.580(5)
    - Require mitigation to avoid injury to other rights ORS 540.580(5)
- (2) District Notifies OWRD [540.580(3)(b) and 690-385-4100] (on OWRD forms)
  - Send to Watermaster (notice and map meeting standard requirements) [OAR 690-385-4100(3)]; Send to Salem office (notice only)
  - Upon receipt OWRD places notice on PN for 30-day comment period [ORS 540.580(4) and OAR 690-385-4100(4)]
  - District must submit notice to OWRD prior to using water as proposed, but can use water as provided in the notice prior to approval [OAR 690-385-4100(1)(a)]
- (3) District submits a petition (Application) by Dec 31 of year in which change occurs (retrospective with District Notice[OAR 690-385-4100(1)(b)], or prospective without District Notice) [540.580(2)]
  - Include map (standard requirements) certified by the district (CWRE not required) [540.580(2)(b) and OAR 690-385-2200 and 4300]
  - Include statement that each landowner authorized the transfer in writing (on file with District) [540.580(2)(c) and OAR 690-385-2000(1)(n)]
  - Include fee for POU change [540.580(2)(e) and OAR 690-385-2000(1)(q)]

- (4) OWRD processes petition/Application
  - Publicly Noticed within 15 days of receipt [ORS 540.580(6) and OAR 690-385-4400(3)(b)]
    - o **30-day comment period** –OAR 690-385-4400(4)
    - 30-day protest period for filing a protest against approval filed by any potentially affected holder of an existing water right—ORS 540.580(6) and OAR 690-385-4600 NOTE: Protests filed by user within the district are resolved between the District and Patron ORS 540.580(8) and OAR 690-385-4600(5)(a)
  - Original right is terminated by order (can no longer legally apply water on "from" lands) [OAR 690-385-4580]
  - Final Order issued approving (or denying) transfer application within <u>90 days</u> of petition filed if there is no hearing. [ORS 540.580(9)]
    - o Subject to judicial review w/in 60 days ORS 536.075 and OAR 137.003-0675
    - District or protestant can file exception with the commission w/in 20 days -ORS 540.580(10)
- **(5) Time for Completion** [OAR 690-385-7000]
  - 1 year + time to next Oct 1, or request an extension.
  - Proof of use
    - o District submits Final Proof map certified by the district.
    - o District submits CBU certified by the district.
    - OWRD makes a determination of satisfactory proof (DSP)
      - OWRD issues an updated cert (when it is "time")
