Non-Use District Transfer Process POU Changes Only

The vision of the Water Resources
Department is to assure sufficient and sustainable water supplies are available to meet current and future needs.

Purpose

 Enables a district to apply to OWRD for transferring lands that have been confiscated from a water user because of non-use for a period of five successive irrigation seasons

Eligibility Requirements

- District must have a full-time manager
- District must be implementing a Water Management and Conservation Plan (WMCP) approved by OWRD

District Sends 4th-year Notice to Water User

•A notice meeting specific criteria is sent to water user by certified mail when district determines lack of beneficial use made (non-use) for four consecutive seasons

District Sends 5th-year Notice to Water User

• A notice meeting specific criteria is sent to water user by certified mail after the fifth year of non-use occurs

Water User has
Opportunity for District
Hearing

• District informs water user that district intends to apply to OWRD to transfer non-use lands to other lands

Hearing

District Sonds "Notice of

- Water user is given 30 days to object to proposed action
 If issues are not resolved, a hearing must be held before
- the district's board of directors
 Upon submission of a permanent transfer application by the district that includes non-use lands, the district sends

a notice meeting specific criteria to all affected parties

- District Sends "Notice of Transfer Application" to Water User
- Water user is informed of an opportunity to protest

60-day Protest Period for Water User

- •The protest period available to the water user begins on the mailing date of the Notice of Transfer Application
- Protests are submitted to OWRD

District Submits
Permanent Transfer
Application

- •Includes copies of all required notices
- Application must be submitted before Dec 31 of year in which the 5th year of non-use occured

Public Notice

- OWRD Weekly Notice
- 30-day comment period

- **Application Reviewed**
- •All noticing requirements met by district
- Subject to Watermaster review
- •No injury or enlargement

Land Use Information Form



NOTE TO APPLICANTS

In order for your application to be processed by the Water Resources Department (WRD), this Land Use Information Form must be completed by a local government planning official in the jurisdiction(s) where your water right will be used and developed. The planning official may choose to complete the form while you wait, or return the receipt stub to you. Applications received by WRD without the Land Use Form or the receipt stub will be returned to you. Please be aware that your application will not be approved without land use approval.

This form is NOT required if:

- 1) Water is to be diverted, conveyed, and/or used only on federal lands; OR
- 2) The application is for a water right transfer, allocation of conserved water, exchange, permit amendment, or ground water registration modification, and <u>all</u> of the following apply:

 a) The existing and proposed water use is located entirely within lands zoned for exclusive farm-use or within an
 - irrigation district;
 - b) The application involves a change in place of use only
 - c) The change does not involve the placement or modification of structures, including but not limited to water diversion impoundment, distribution facilities, water wells and well houses; and

 - d) The application involves irrigation water uses only

Application must also include copies of all required notices sent to water users
