Eligibility Restricted

- •District must have a manager
- •Lands that have not/will not be irrigated in the same irrigation season as the temporary transfer are eligible
- Changes are authorized for one irrigation season, not to exceed 1 year per application

- •District keeps authorization on file for all affected users
- District notifies water user change is subject to OWRD approval

In order for your application to be processed by the Water Resources Department (WRD), this Land Use Information Form must be completed by a local government planning official in the jurisdiction(s) where your water right will be used and developed. The planning official may choose to complete the form while you wait, or return the receipt sub to you. Applications received by WED without the Land Use Form or the receipt stub will be returned to you. Please be aware that your application will not be approved without land use approval.

This form is NOT required if:

- 1) Water is to be diverted, conveyed, and/or used only on federal lands; OR
- 2) The application is for a water right transfer, allocation of conserved water, exchange, permit amendment, or ground water registration modification, and <u>all</u> of the following apply:
 a) The existing and proposed water use is located entirely within lands zoned for exclusive farm-use or within an
- arrigation district.

 b) The application involves a change in place of use only;
