<b>690-325 General</b> <b>12/5</b>	RACM - One RAC member noted that there are rules that allow splitting Points of Use (POU) and that some users would like to do something similar with Points of Diversion (POD)/ Points of Appropriation (POA).	Points of Diversion/Appropriation (PODs/POAs) are tied to land, as specified in the water right permit. The statutory language used in ORS 537.225(5) prohibits the Department from, among other things, making any change to the existing PODs/POAs associated with the authorized place of use or adding PODs/POAs.	Complete. No change made.
<b>690-0020(3)</b> <b>12/5</b>	RACM - RAC members noted that there was no language denoting what happens if there is time left before the expiration of the completion date, but not enough time to complete the split permit process, RAC members asked if the new language limits the option. Another RAC member suggested clarifying language in the last sentence such as, "time specified in permit," "has expired," or "expired at time of application."	The Department added language in OAR 690-382-0020(1), removed OAR 690-382-0020(3) in its entirety, and modified language in OAR 690-382-0010(1) to address this comment.	Complete. Changes made. v3 draft rules.
