## About the Youth Biopsychosocial Summary

---

In the year 2000, the Oregon Youth Authority began conducting a biennial survey of youth characteristics. Data are collected about all youth in OYA custody on a single day during the survey year. The survey response rate is very high. In 2016, 100% of eligible youth had a completed survey on file.

The YBS enables the agency to make a comprehensive assessment of the mental health and other treatment services needed by youth in OYA custody. Survey results are analyzed to identify youth service gaps and to advocate for funding for important services during the budget process.

Typically, Juvenile Parole and Probation Officers complete the survey on OYA youth in the community and mental health professionals complete surveys on youth in OYA correctional facilities. Information for the survey comes from youth assessments such as mental health or substance use, and psychological, psychiatric, and other evaluations in the youth's case file.

In 2014, the name of the survey was changed from Mental Health Gap Assessment to Youth Biopsychosocial Summary (YBS) to better reflect the scope of the survey, which has expanded to include demographic and other characteristics about OYA youth.

In general, the survey items change little from year to year, which has made it possible to look for trends in the results for many of the survey questions. However, a significant revision to the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM) in 2013 prompted changes in the mental health section of the YBS. The diagnoses reflected in the YBS are the current standard for classification of mental disorders in the DSM. This has affected some of the classifications in a manner that restricts comparative analysis from previous surveys.



## 1.0 GENERAL HISTORY


### Suicide Attempt History in Past 3 Years (1.1)

OYA females were more likely to have a history of attempted suicide than males. Thirty-six percent of females in OYA facilities and 31% of females under community supervision had at least one attempted suicide in the past three years.




### Currently Taking Psychotropic Medications (1.2)

In OYA facilities, the vast majority of females were taking psychotropic medications.




### Biological Parents have a Psychiatric History (1.4)

Females were more likely than males to have a parent with a psychiatric history.




### History with Child Welfare (1.5)

Overall, 40% of OYA youth had a history with child welfare, but the rate among females was especially high.




### Documented History of Sexual Abuse (1.7.1)

Overall, 45% of OYA females had a history of sexual abuse victimization.




### Documented History of Physical Abuse (1.7.2)

Nearly two-thirds of females in OYA facilities had a history of physical abuse victimization.



### Documented History of Emotional Abuse (1.7.3)

Females in OYA facilities were the most likely to have a documented history of emotional abuse victimization.




### Documented History of Neglect (1.7.4)

A documented history of neglect was more common among OYA female than males.




### Documented History of a Head Injury (1.8)

Childhood head injuries may trigger persistent behavioral, emotional, or cognitive problems.



### IQ - Intelligence Quotient (1.10)

Only youth with a documented IQ are included in the chart below. Because a high percentage (76%) of youth did not have IQ documentation available, the results below may not be representative of the overall OYA population. In addition, only 24 females in OYA facilities and 21 females under community supervision had a documented IQ, so they are excluded from the chart.




## 2.0 MENTAL HEALTH

Charts in this section use green to show youth whose mental health diagnosis was within the past 12 months and gold for those diagnosed longer ago. The label at the end of each bar is the sum of both, i.e., the percentage ever receiving the indicated diagnosis.


### Conduct Disorder (2.1)

Conduct Disorder was a common diagnosis among OYA youth.




### Learning Disorder - any type (2.2)

A Learning Disorder has been diagnosed in 19% of OYA youth.




### Depressive Disorder (2.3)

A diagnosis of a Depressive Disorder was common among all OYA youth, particularly females. This category includes Major Depression and Persistent Depressive Disorder (Dysthymia).



### Bipolar and Related Disorders (2.4)


Overall, about 8% of OYA youth have received a Bipolar or Related Disorder diagnosis. The diagnosis was more common among females than males.


Anxiety Disorders (2.5)

This diagnostic category includes Panic or Anxiety Disorders and Phobias.




Disruptive, Impulse Control Disorders (2.6)

Diagnoses include Intermittent-Explosive Disorder, Kleptomania, Pyromania, and Oppositional Defiant Disorder (ODD).




Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (2.7)

Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD/ADD) was the second most common diagnosis (behind Conduct Disorder) among all OYA youth.




Sleep-Wake Disorders (2.11)

Included in this category are Insomnia, Narcolepsy, and Non-Rapid Eye Movement Sleep Arousal disorders (sleep terror and sleep walking types).




Trauma- and Stressor-Related Disorders (2.14)

These were very common diagnoses among OYA females. The category includes Post Traumatic Stress (PTSD), Reactive Attachment, and Disinhibited Social Engagement disorders.




Cluster B Personality Traits/Disorders (2.19)

Most common among females in OYA facilities, Cluster B Personality Traits/Disorders include Antisocial, Borderline, Histrionic, and Narcissistic personality disorders.




Any mental health diagnosis (except Conduct Disorder)

The vast majority of OYA youth have received a mental health diagnosis (other than Conduct Disorder) during their lives.



Any mental health diagnosis and taking psychotropics


Overall 35% of youth have had a mental health diagnosis other than Conduct Disorder and also take psychotropic medications.



### 3.0 SUBSTANCE USE

#### Level of Drug and/or Alcohol Use (3.2)

The majority of youth under OYA supervision had a history of substance use, and females were somewhat more likely to have a history than males. Overall, 65% of OYA youth had a serious substance history—drug or alcohol abuse/dependence.




#### Drugs of Choice

Overall, the most common drugs of choice were marijuana (67%), alcohol (48%), methamphetamine (26%), heroin and other opiates (8%), cocaine (7%), and prescription drugs (6%). More than one choice was allowed.


#### Drug of Choice: Alcohol (3.3.1)

Overall, alcohol was the second most popular drug of choice.




#### Drug of Choice: Cocaine (3.3.3)

Cocaine was a drug of choice for 19% of females in OYA facilities.




#### Drug of Choice: Heroin or other opiate derivatives (3.3.5)

Females were more likely to include heroin as a drug of choice than males.




#### Drug of Choice: Methamphetamine (3.3.8)

Methamphetamine was a drug of choice for the majority of females in facilities and 45% of those in the community.




#### Drug of Choice: Marijuana (3.3.9)

#### Drug of Choice: Prescription drugs (3.3.10)


Females were more likely to use prescription drugs.


#### Parents have History of Substance Abuse (3.6)

The majority of OYA-supervised youth had biological parents with a documented history of drug and/or alcohol abuse.



#### Mental Health and Substance Abuse/Dependence


The majority of OYA females had a co-occurring disorder: mental health diagnosis and a serious alcohol or drug (AOD) problem.



### 4.0 EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EMPLOYMENT

#### School Attendance Status (4.1)

The majority of youth under OYA supervision were attending school full time. The rates of school attendance were somewhat higher in the facilities than in the community population.






#### Working to Achieve a High School Diploma (4.2.1)

The majority of youth under OYA supervision were working toward their high school diploma.




#### Working to Achieve a GED (4.2.2)

Working toward a GED was less common than working toward a diploma (compare to graph on left).




#### Had an Individualized Education Program (4.4)

#### Engaged in Vocational Training (4.5)


Half of the males in the OYA facility population were engaged in vocational training.


#### Completed High School Diploma (4.7.1)

Completing a high school diploma was more common among OYA facility youth than OYA youth in the community.




#### Completed GED (4.7.2)

#### Employment Status (4.10)


The majority of youth under OYA supervision were not employed. Males in the OYA facilities were most likely to have jobs.



### 5.0 OTHER


#### Youth Identifies as Heterosexual (5.4)

Females in close custody were least likely to identify as heterosexual. Overall, 89% of youth under OYA supervision identified as heterosexual.




#### Biological Parent of a Child (5.5)

Nine percent of OYA youth were documented as the biological parent of a child.




#### Youth's Primary Language is English (5.6)

#### Youth's Primary Language is Spanish (5.6)


Spanish was the second most common primary language among youth in OYA custody.



## DEMOGRAPHICS


### Race/Ethnicity

Youth of color were over-represented in OYA's facility and community populations. For comparison, in 2014, the race/ethnicity breakout of Oregon's population age 10-17 was African American (3%), Asian (5%), White (69%), Hispanic (21%), and Native American (2%).



### Age Group


The majority of OYA youth in the community are age 17 and younger. In OYA facilities, the majority of youth are age 18 and older.



DEMOGRAPHICS (continued)

Crime Type

Approximately one third of male and female youth under OYA supervision were committed for a property offense. Sex offenses were the most serious crime for 32% of males under community supervision and 36% of males in OYA facilities. Females were most likely to be committed for non-sexual person crimes, regardless of whether they were supervised in OYA facilities or in the community.
