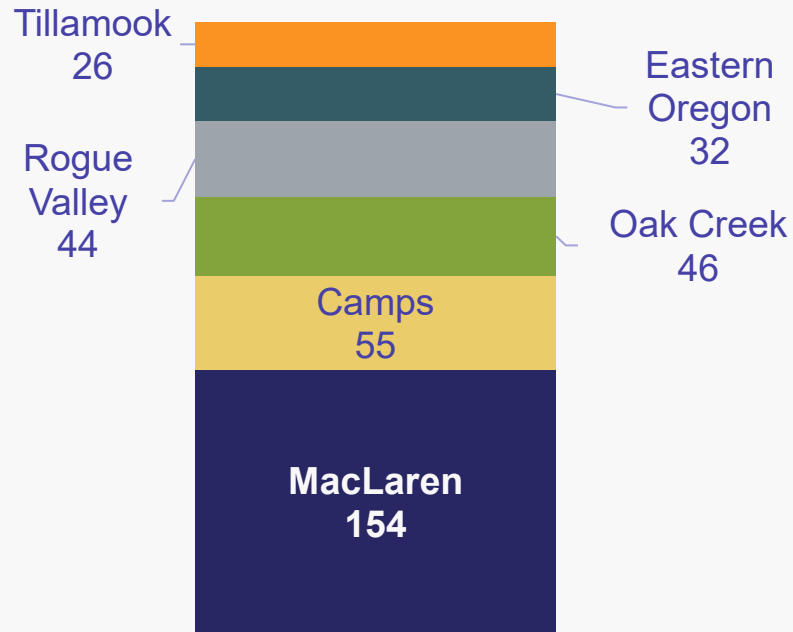

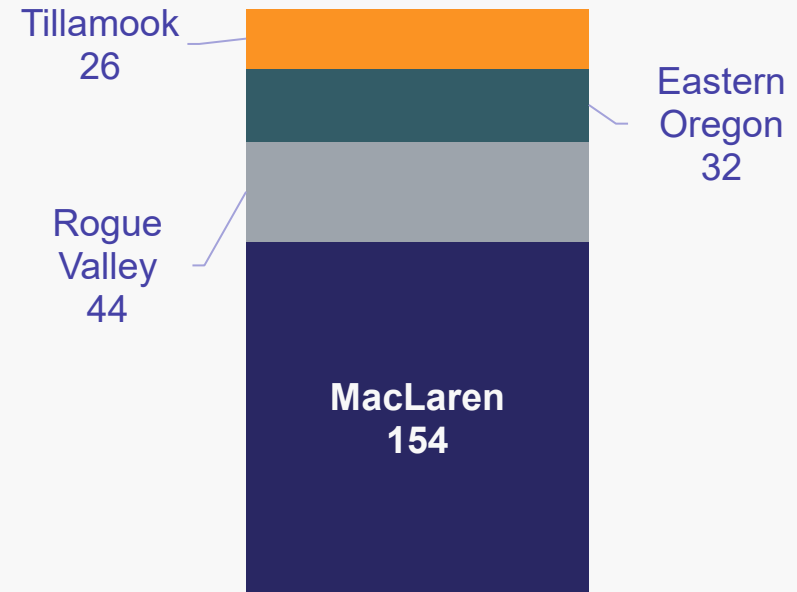


MacLaren is OYA's largest facility*

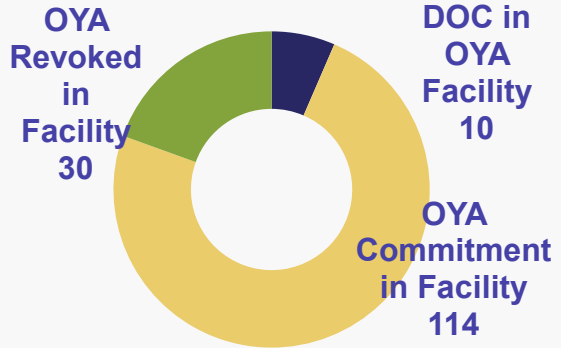

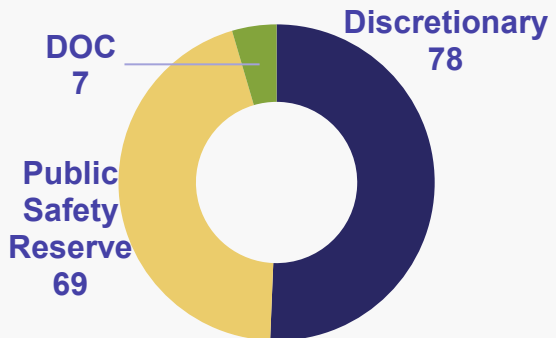

Definitions

Term	Definition
Youth Incident Report (YIR)	Formal documentation of behavioral problems, injuries, and/or illnesses. Documentation includes date/time, location, youth involved, staff involved, and any behavior problems, restraints, or resolutions associated with the event.
Violent Behaviors	Youth behaviors logged in YIRs that (a) have a problem type of <i>Assault</i> or (b) have a problem type of <i>Peer Fight</i> that also required <i>Physical Intervention</i> and/or <i>Isolation</i>
Assaults on Workers	Count of YIRs where one or more staff members were listed as the victim of an <i>Assault</i> problem type.
Youth Injuries	Count of unique youth injuries logged in YIRs.
Staff Injuries	Count of unique staff injuries logged in YIRs. Staff workplace injuries that are not associated with a YIR are not counted.
Isolation	A crisis intervention where a youth is temporarily placed alone in a room with a locked door due to the youth’s crisis behavior.
Positive Youth Engagement (PYE)	PYE includes all activities for which attendance hours are tracked in JJIS (Education, Vocation, Work Experience, Treatment, Large Muscle Activity, OIIR Activities, and Other Enrichment Activities). OIIR = Office of Inclusion and Intercultural Relations
Average PYE Hours	Total number of attendance hours divided by the facility population
Safe Community Skills Group	Core treatment group designed to strengthen prosocial skills such as problem solving, emotion regulation, and conflict resolution
Group Life Coordinator (GLC)	Frontline direct service staff who supervise and program youth in close-custody and make up a majority of the OYA workforce.

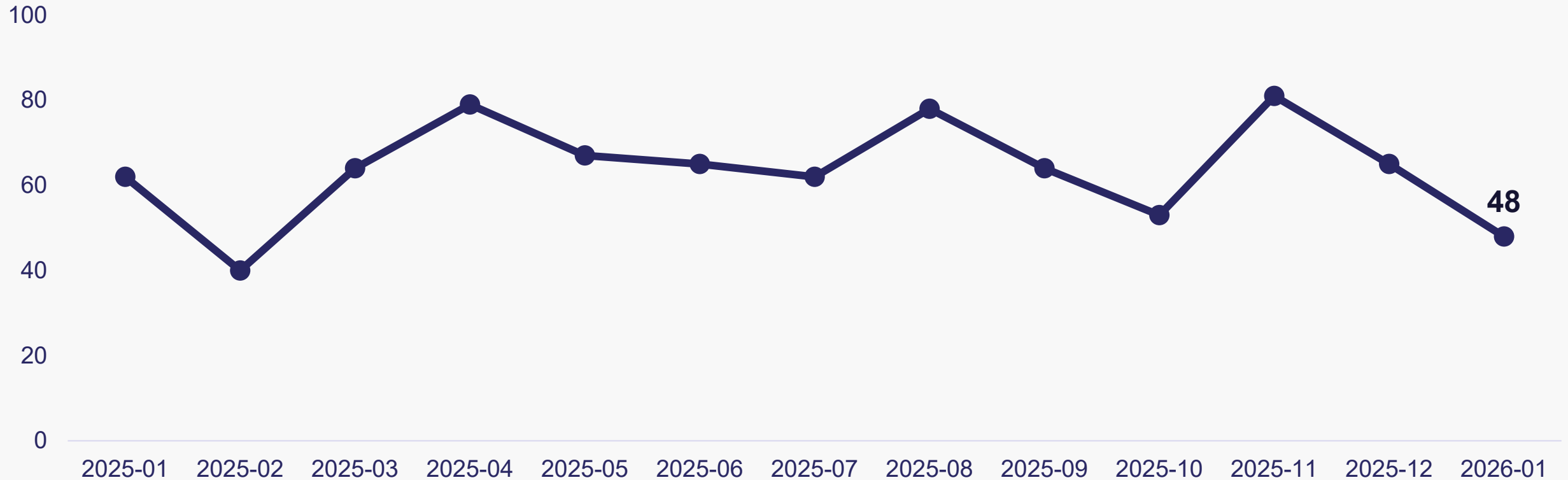


Performance Metrics



Youth Assaults/Fights

Last month had the fewest assaults/fights since February 2025





Last month's 48 assaults/fights involved 33 distinct youth

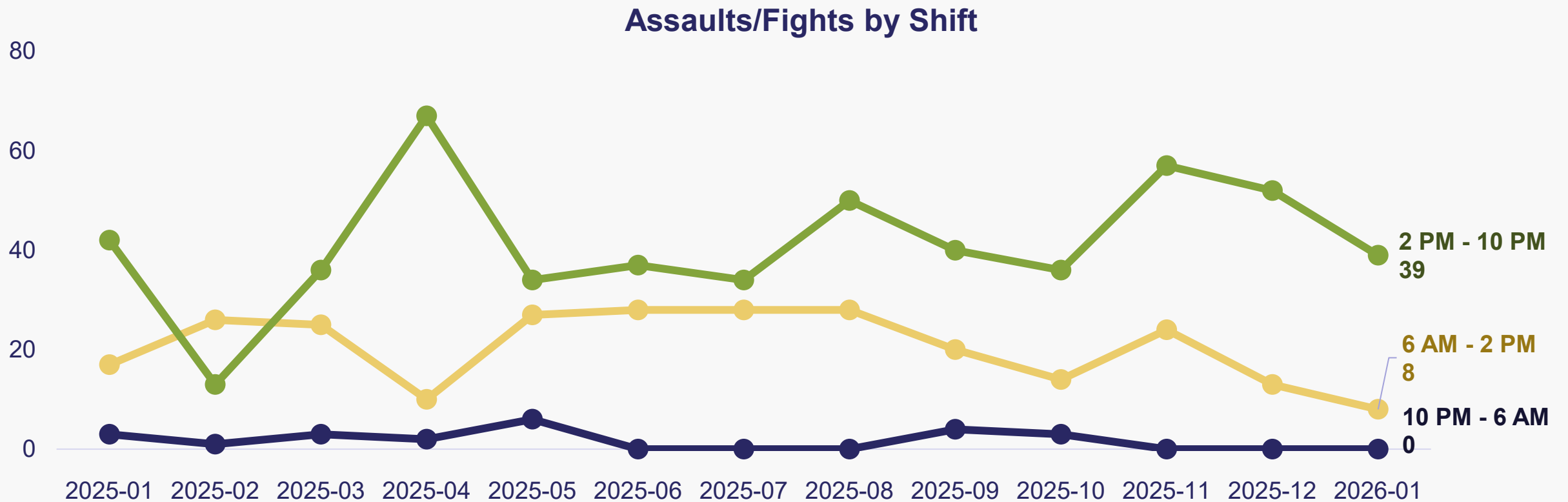
11 youth were responsible for 50% of assaults/fights

Assaults/Fights are most common on Second Shift (2 PM – 10 PM)

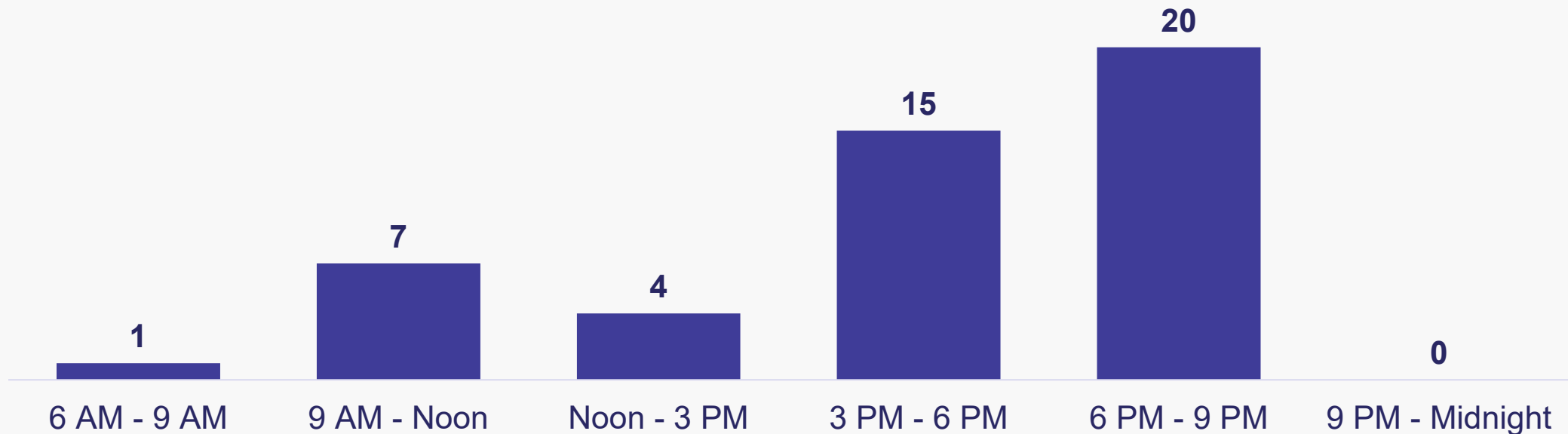




Supplemental – Time of Day

Assaults/Fights by Time of Day

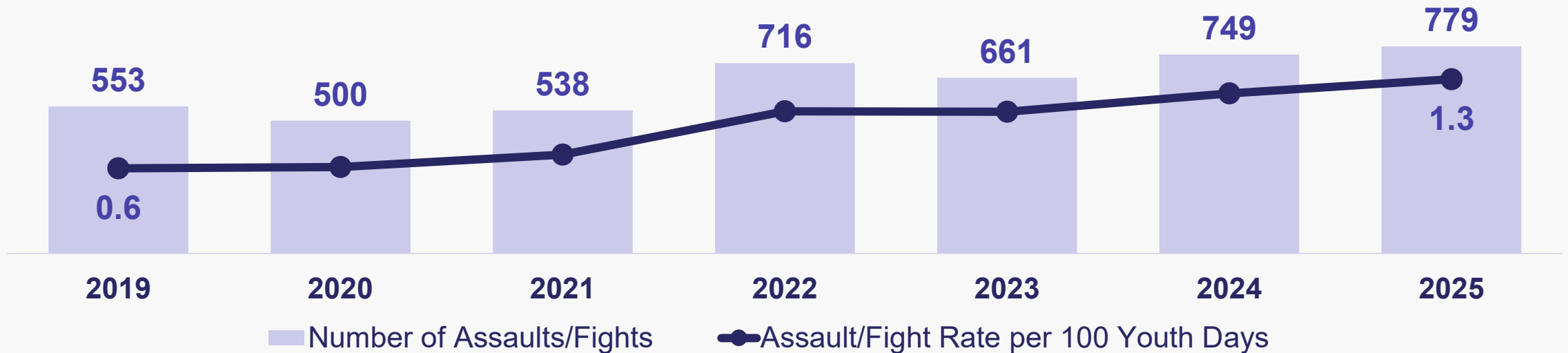




Supplemental: Assaults/Fights over time

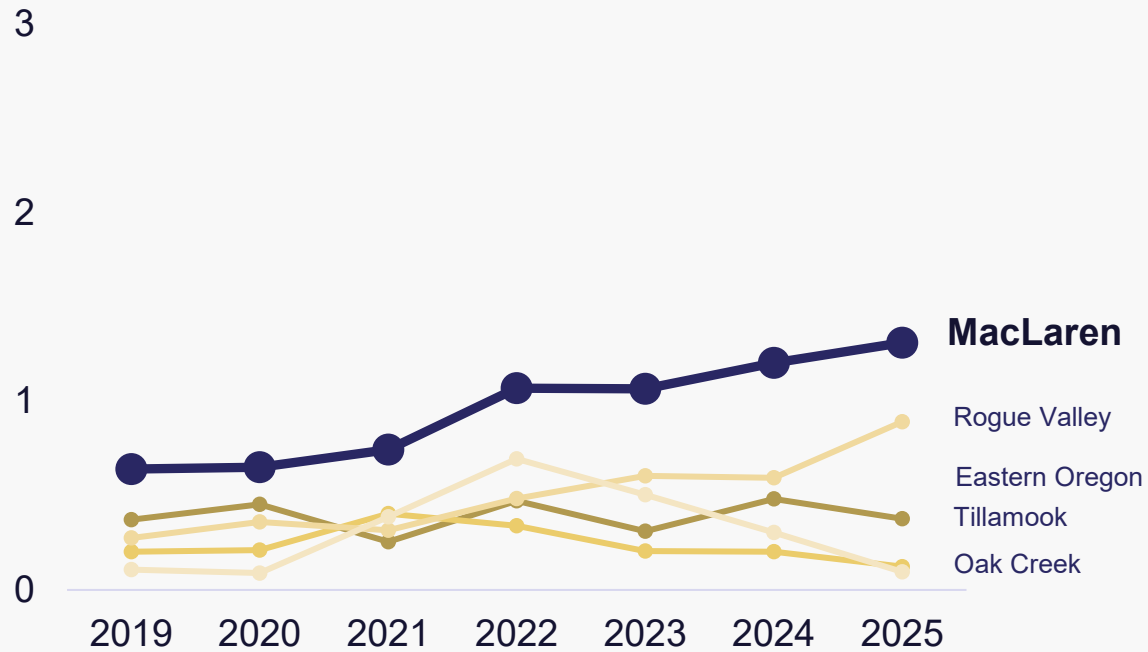

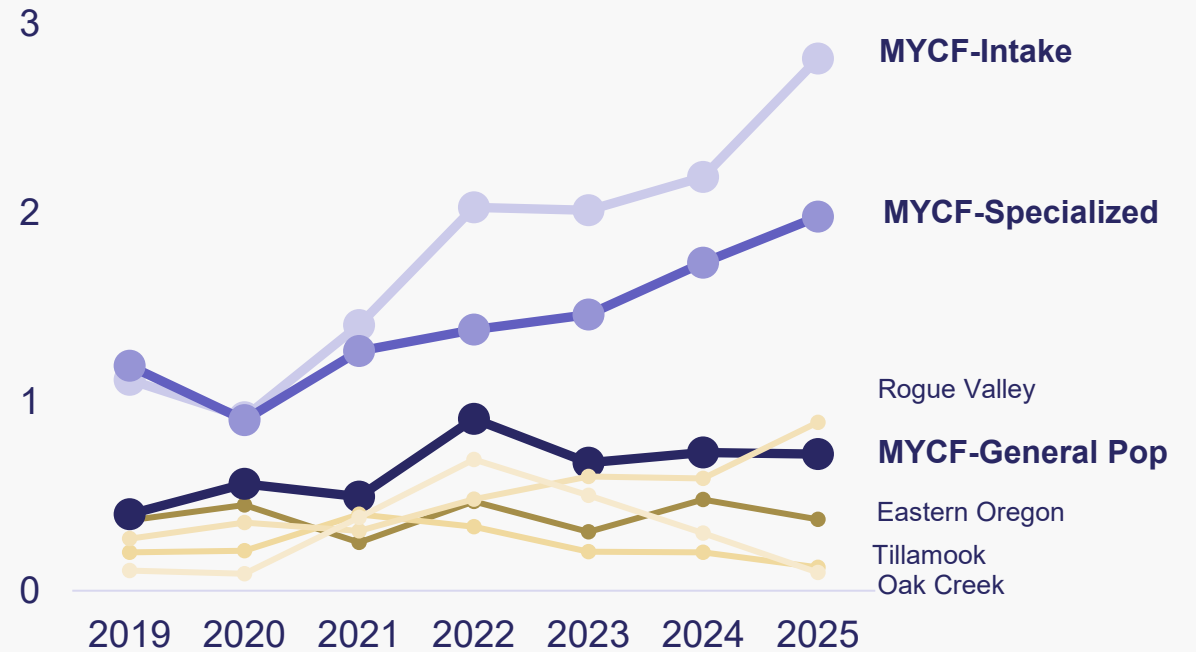
The rate of Assaults/Fights is higher at MYCF than other YCFs

Assault/Fight Rate per 100 Youth Days

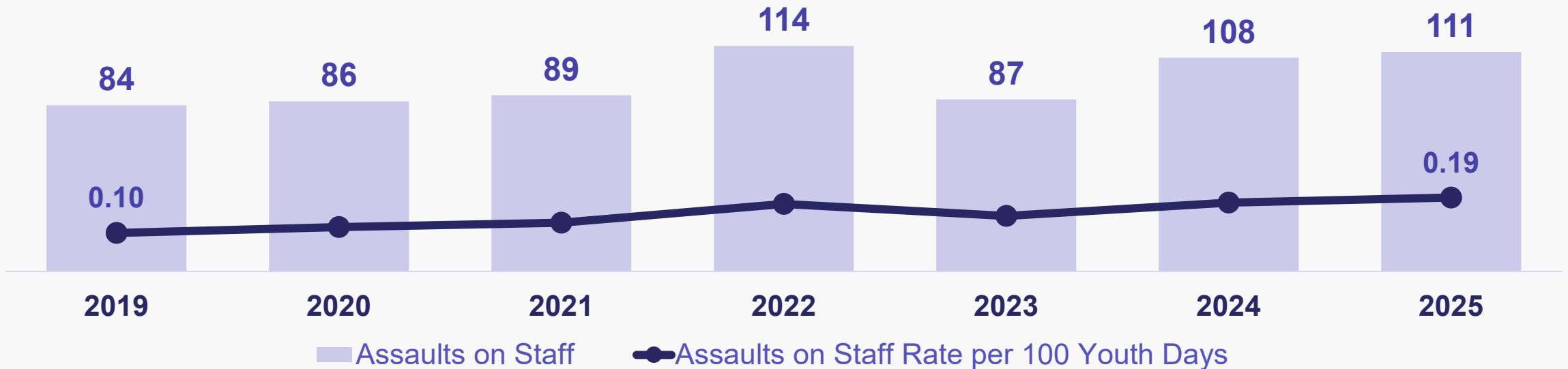




Supplemental: Assaults on staff over time

Assaults on staff have increased in recent years

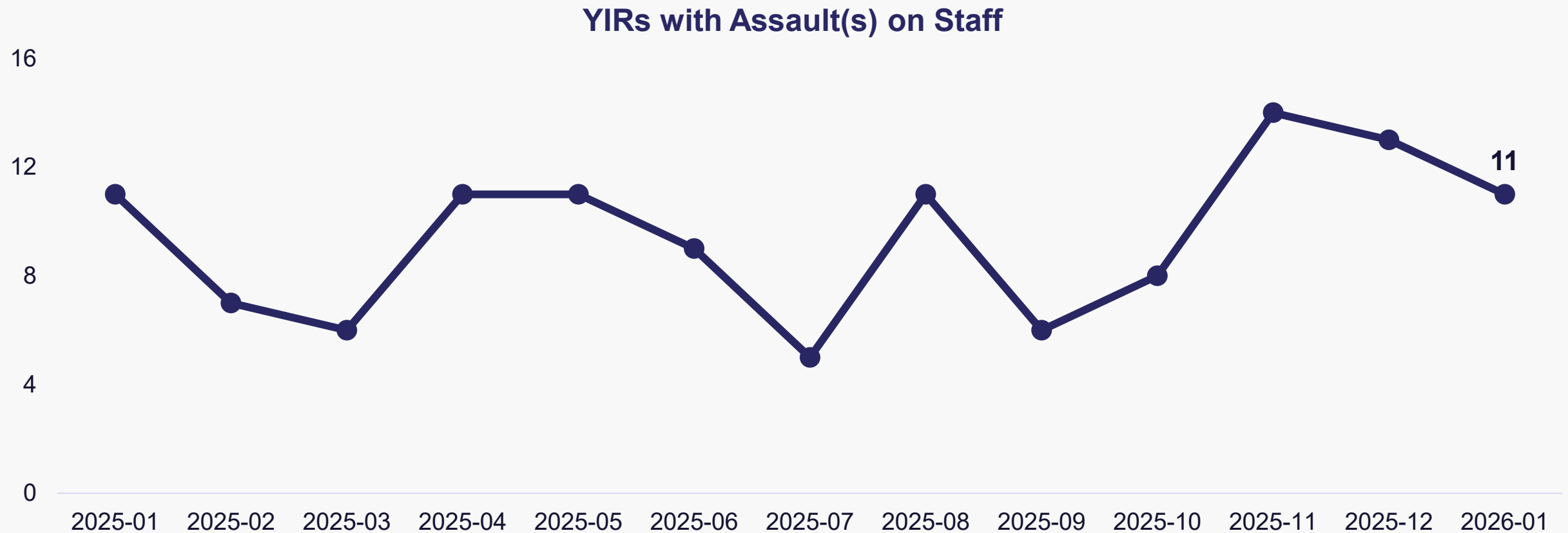

Last month, 11 YIRs involved an assault on staff

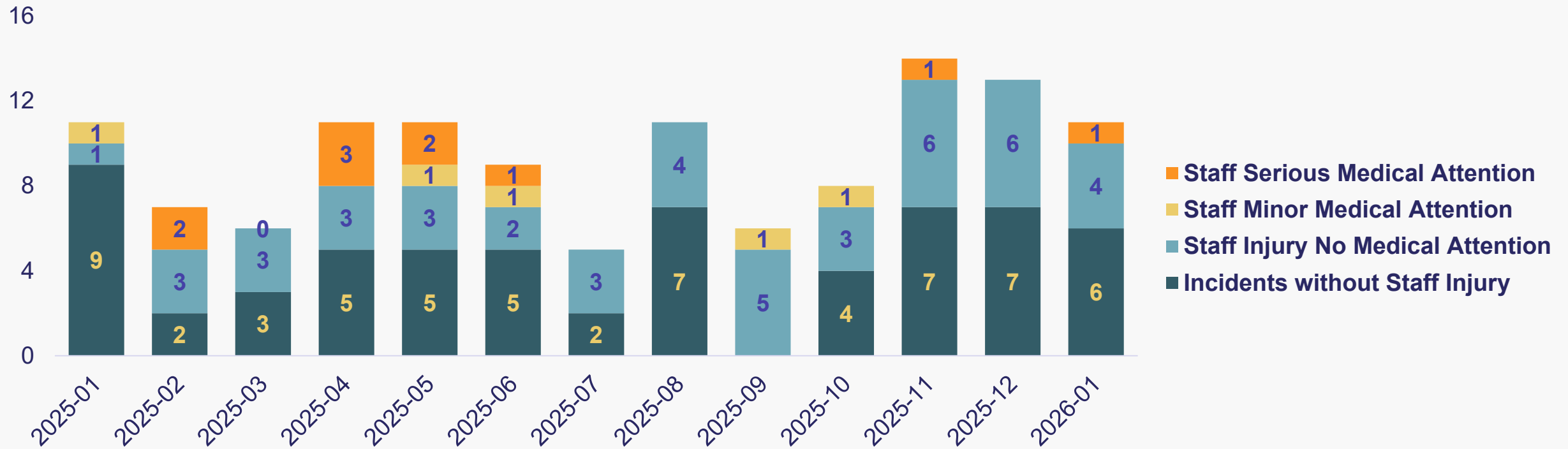




Supplemental – Assaults on Staff

5 of the 11 YIRs (45%) resulted in staff injury from any cause. One YIR resulted in a serious staff injury.

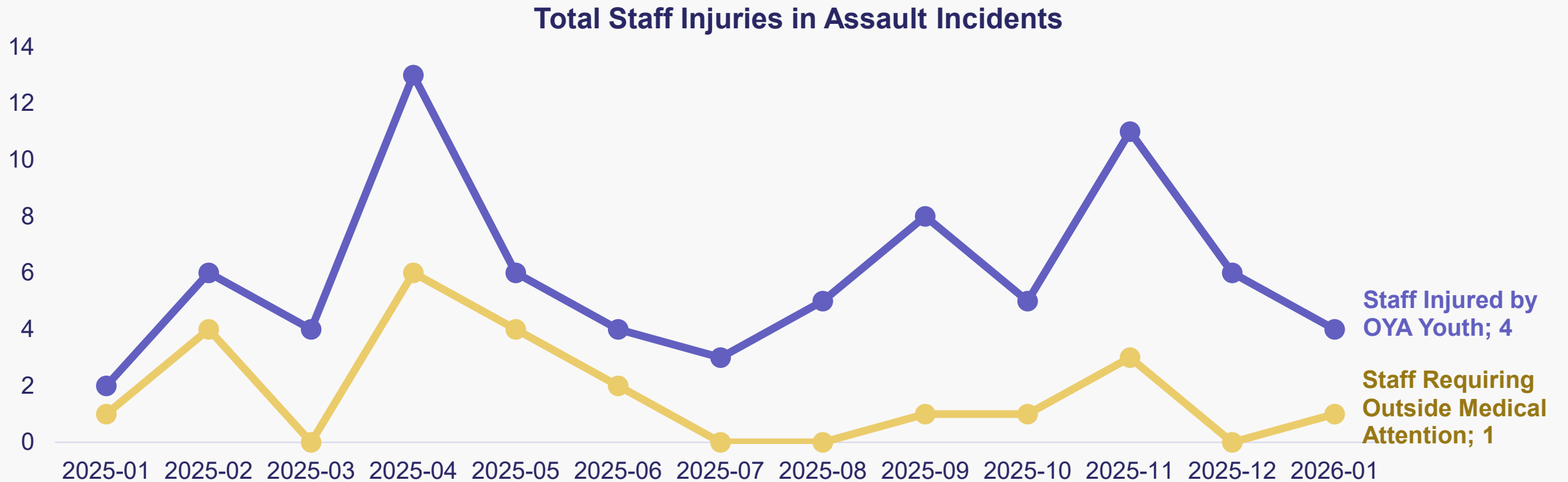
Staff Assault YIR Count

The 11 YIRs resulted in 4 staff injured by youth and 1 staff member requiring outside medical attention

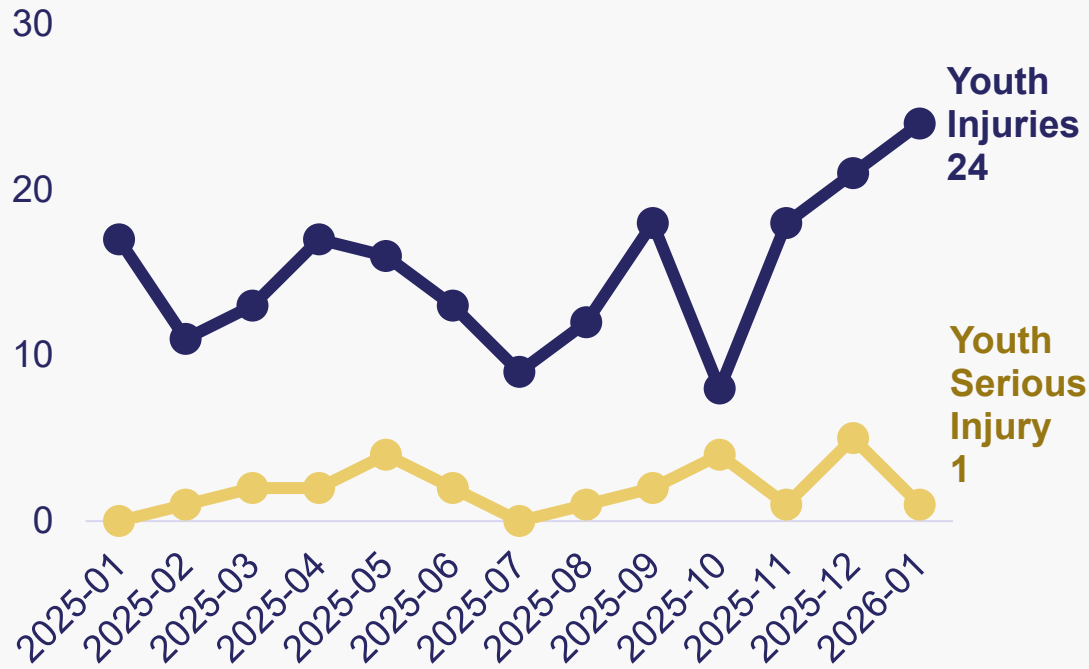




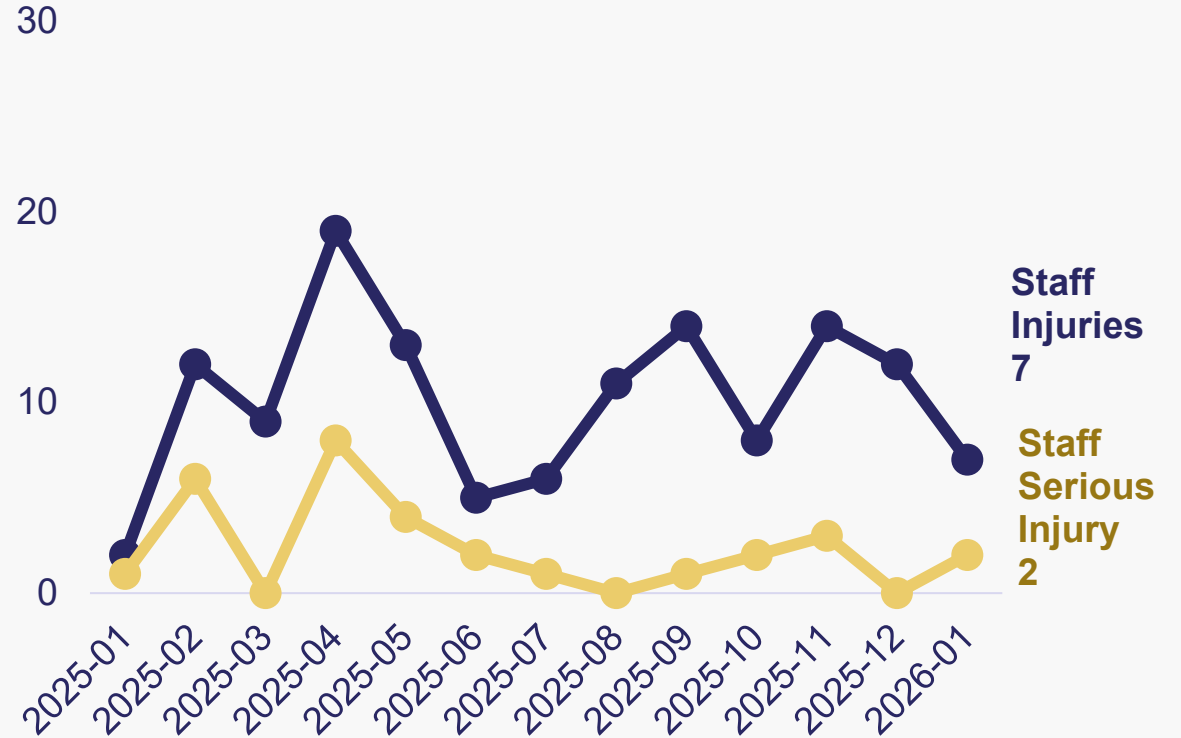
Youth and Staff Injuries

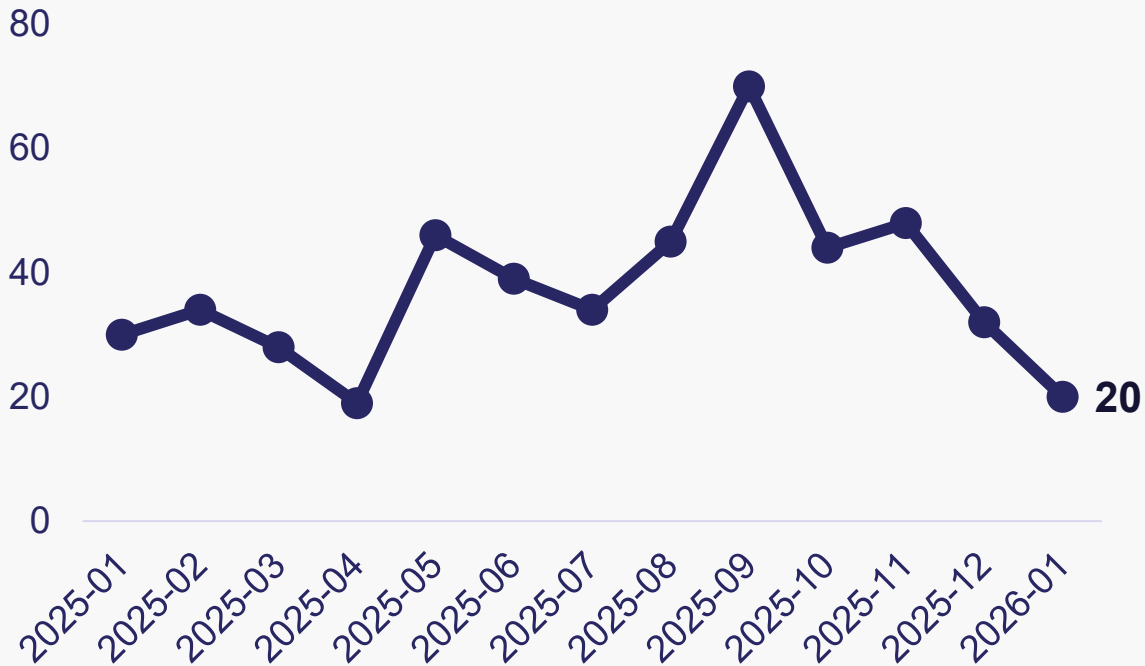




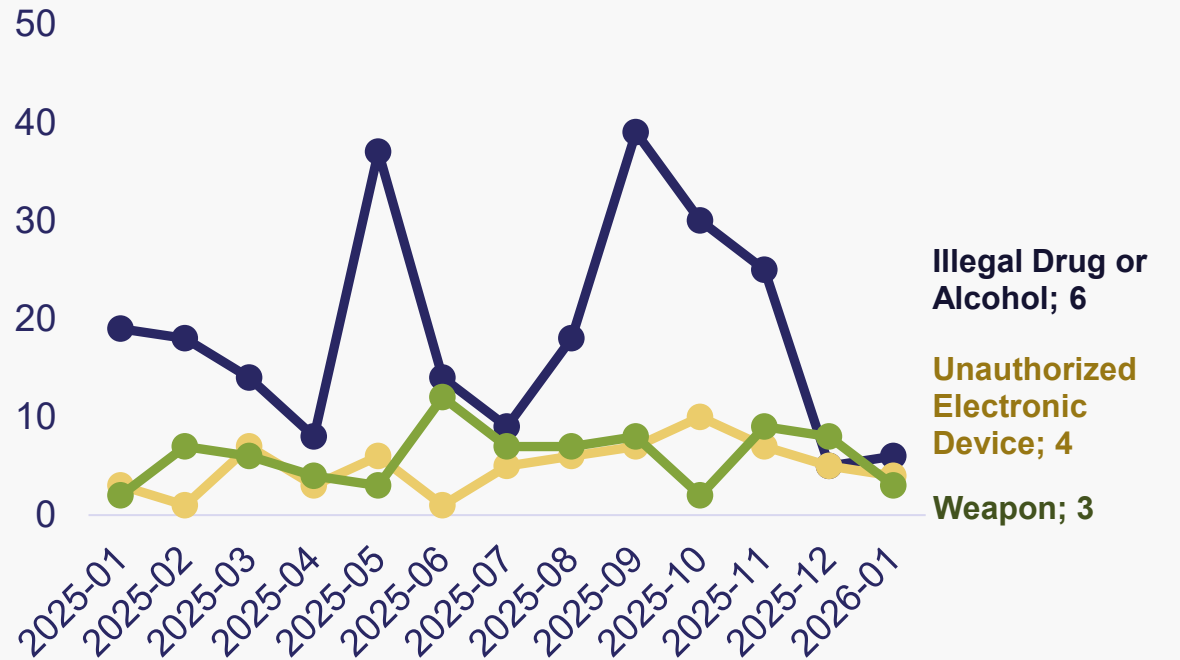
Contraband from YIRs

Drugs/Alcohol, Electronics, Weapons

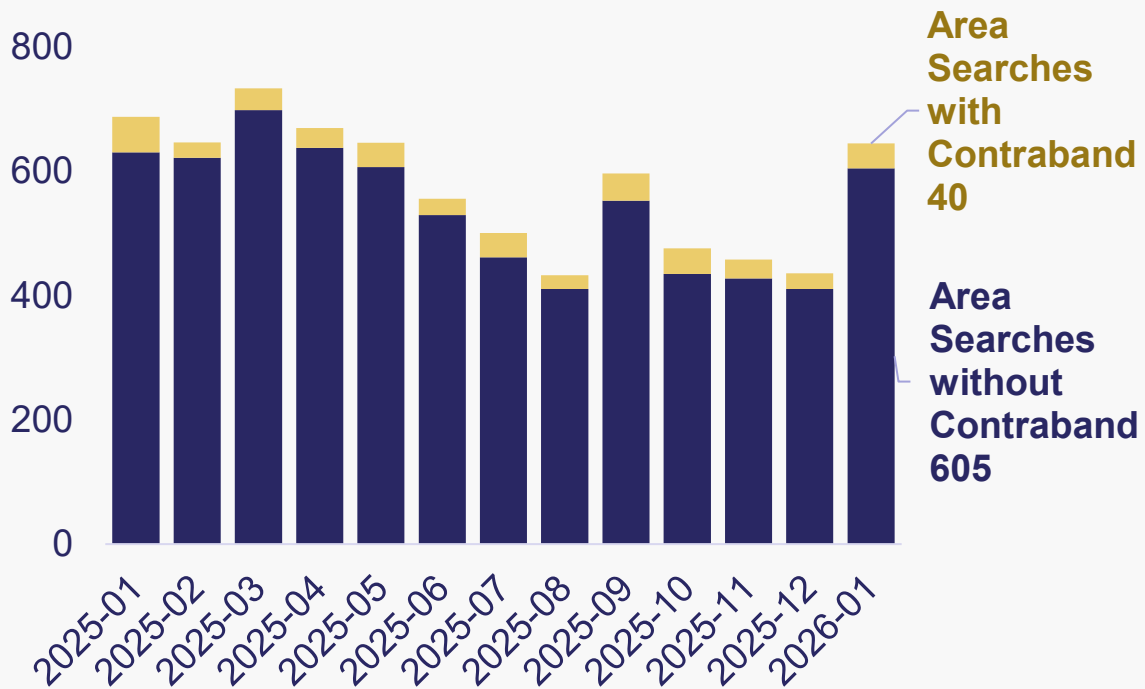




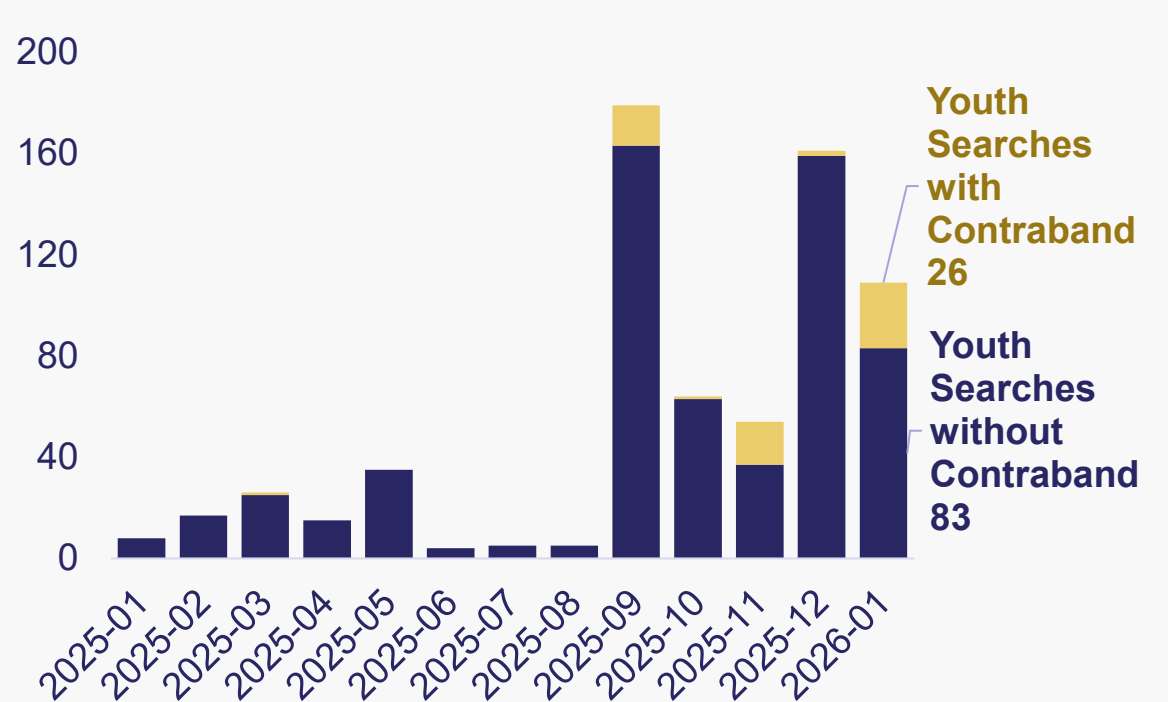
Contraband from Searches

6% of Area Searches discovered Contraband



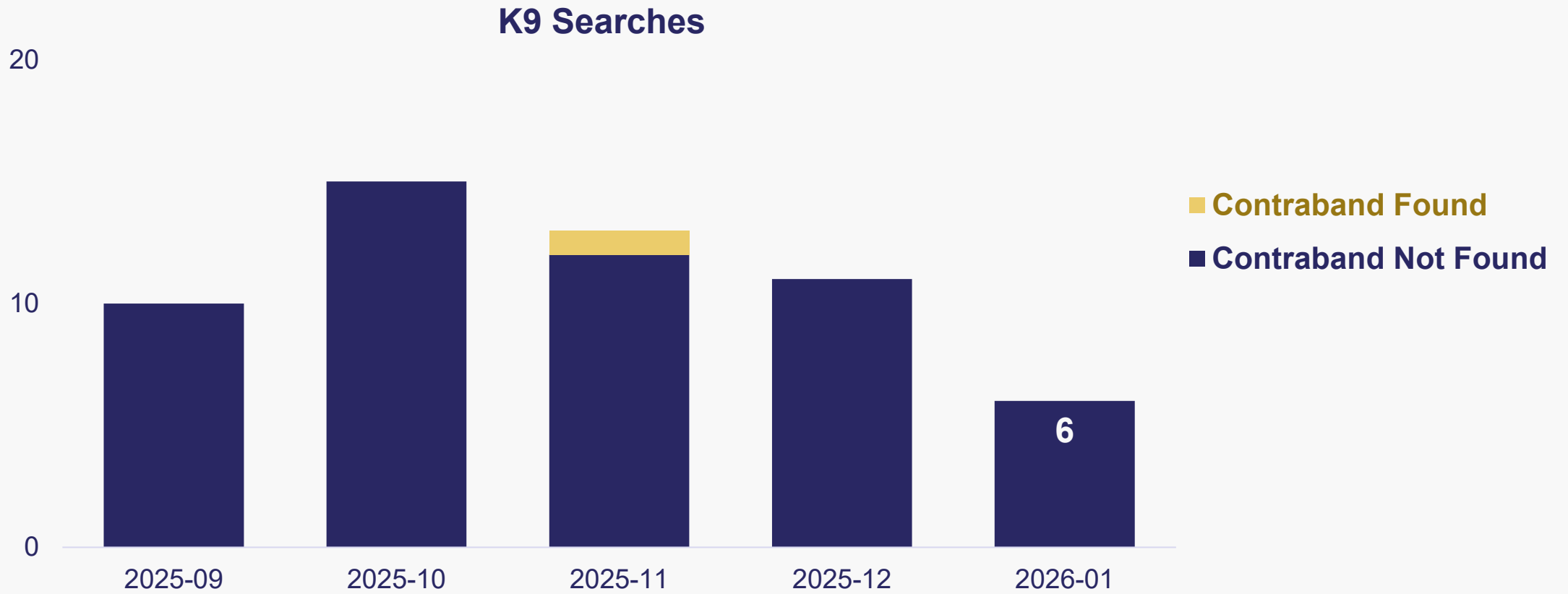

K9 Searches

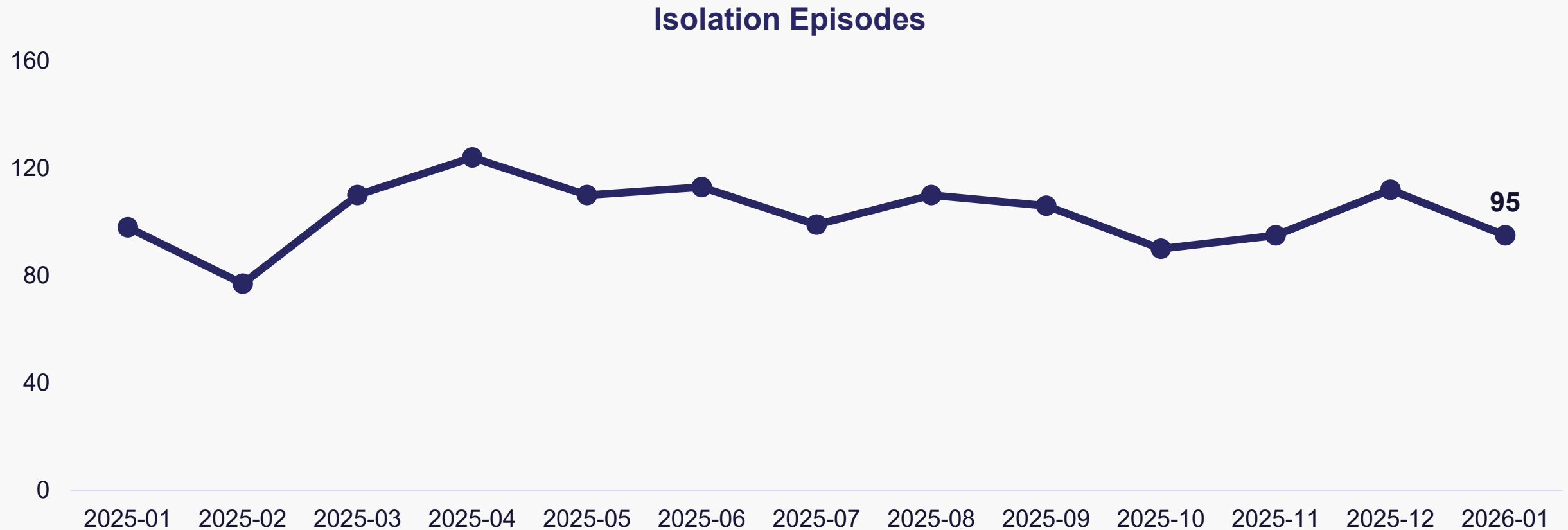
No contraband was found during K9 searches last month





Number of Isolation Episodes

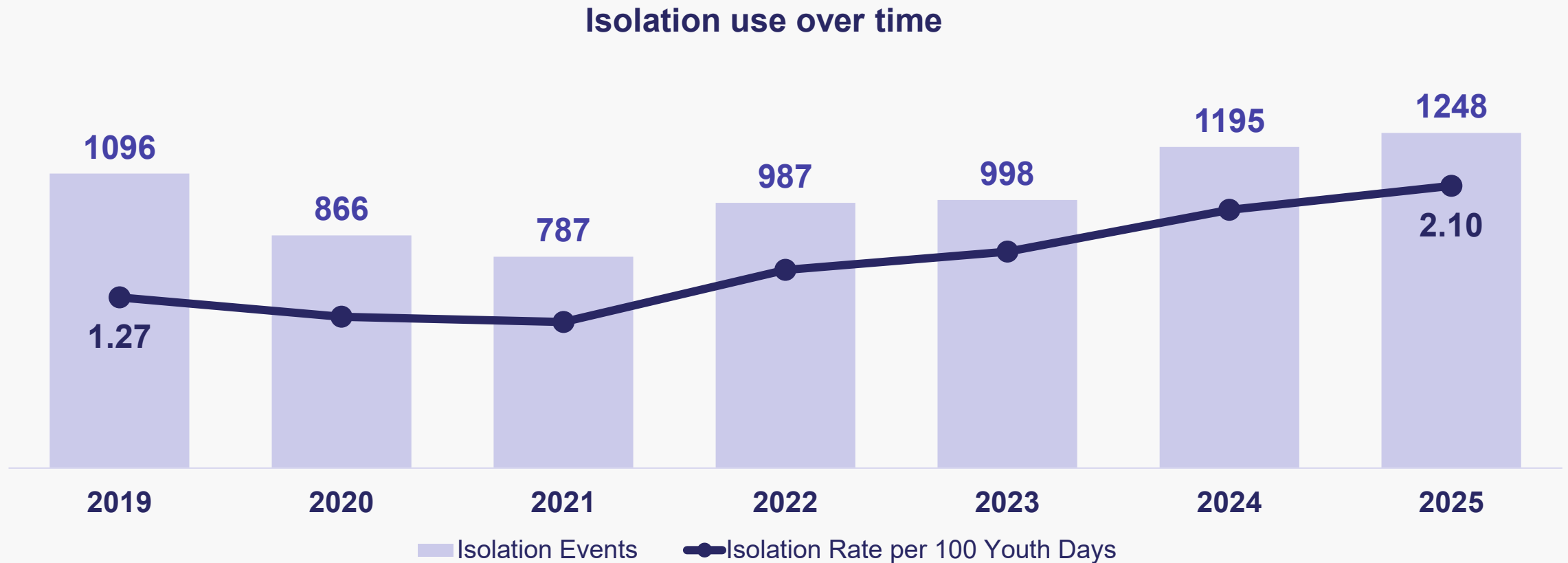
There were an average of 3 isolation episodes per day last month

Isolation use has increased in recent years

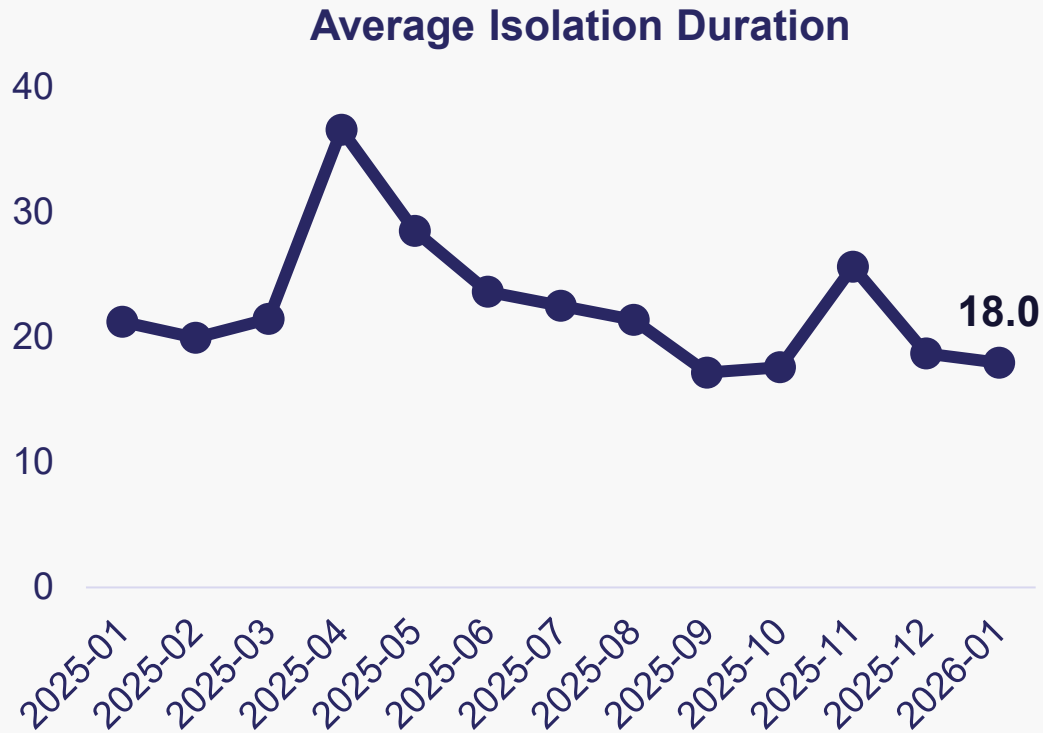




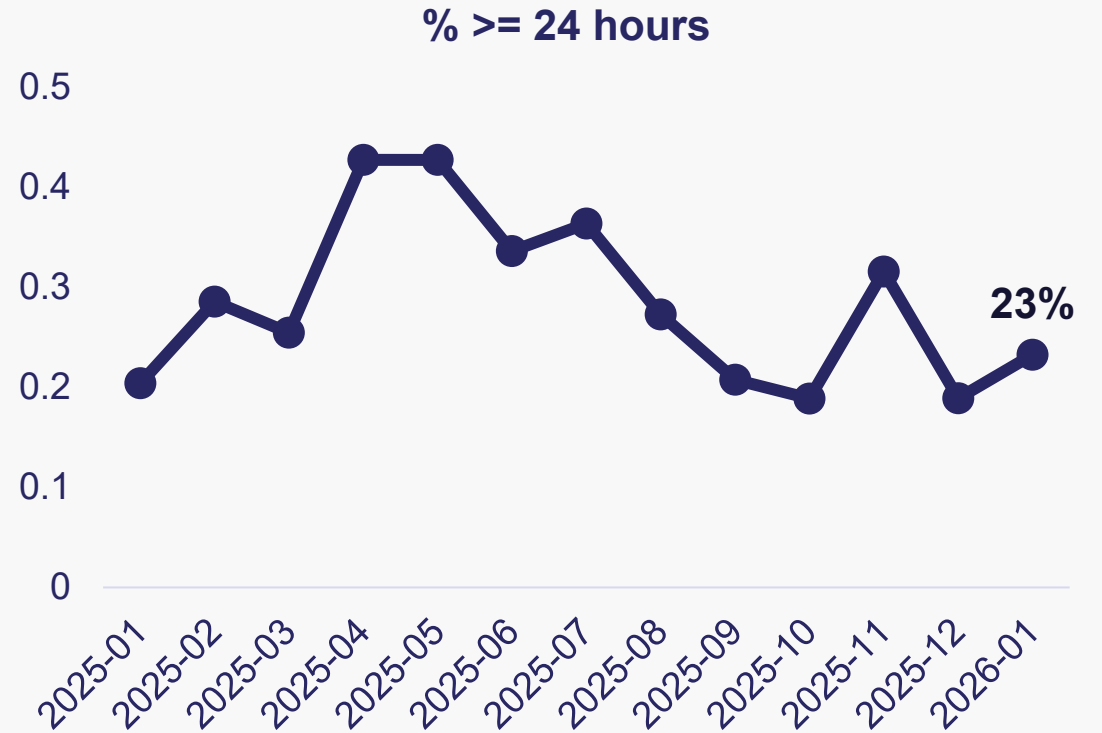
Isolation Duration

23% of Episodes Lasted 24 Hours or More



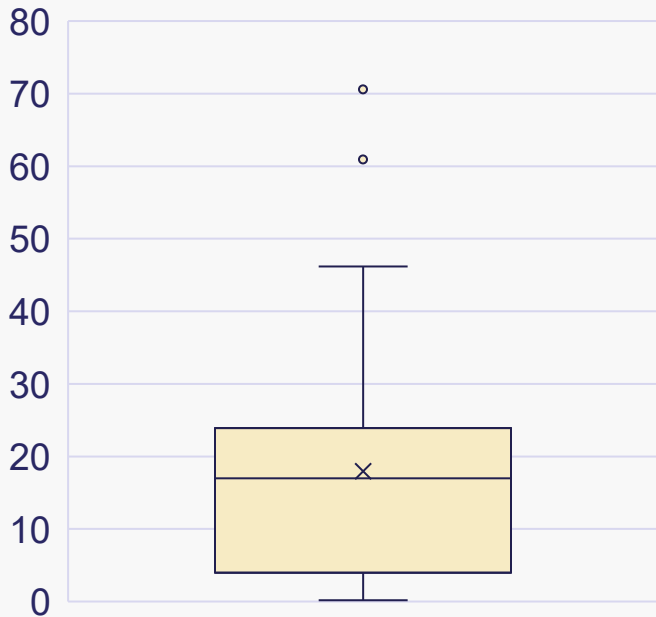


Prior Month Isolation Detail

No youth were isolated for more than 72 hours

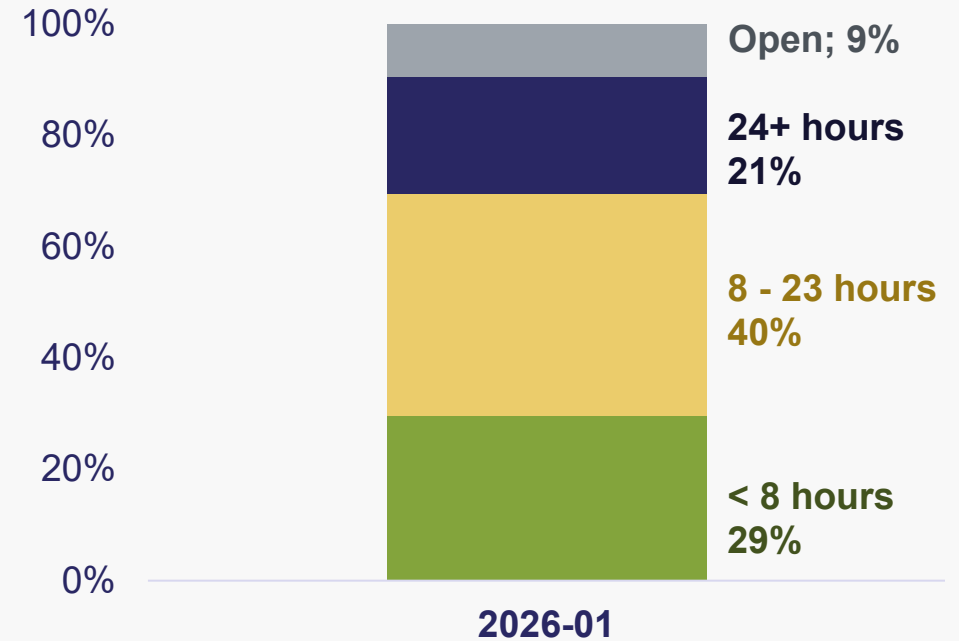

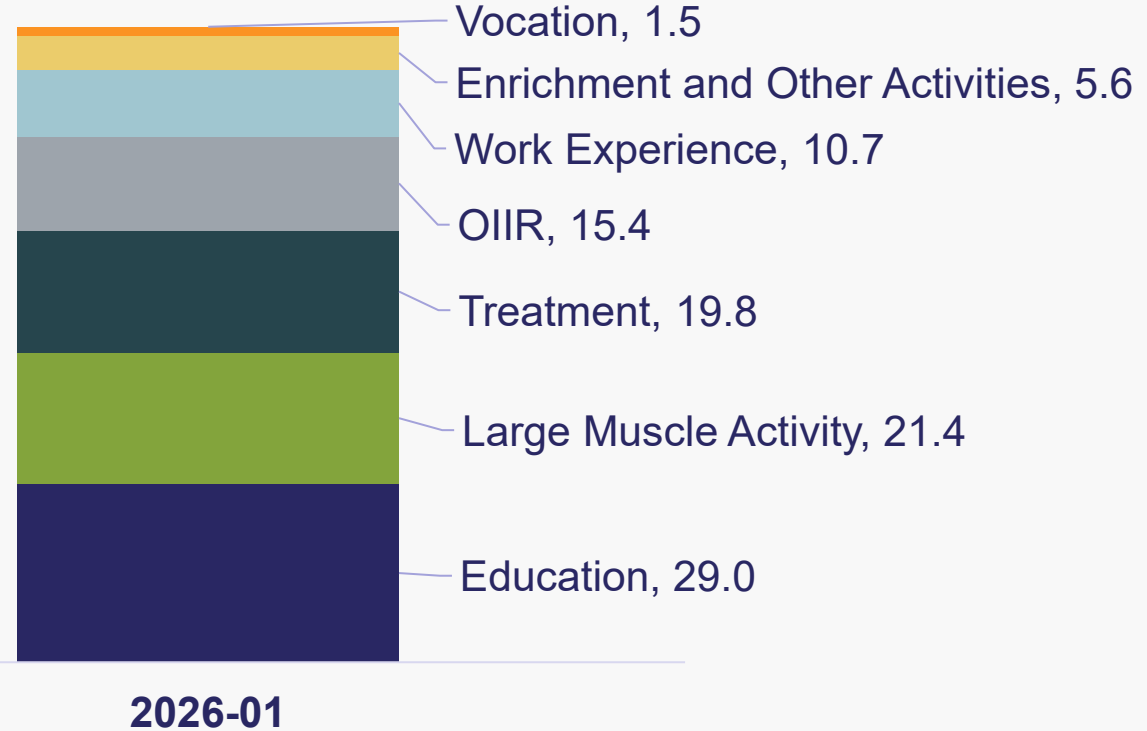

Youth at MYCF averaged 103 Hours of PYE last month

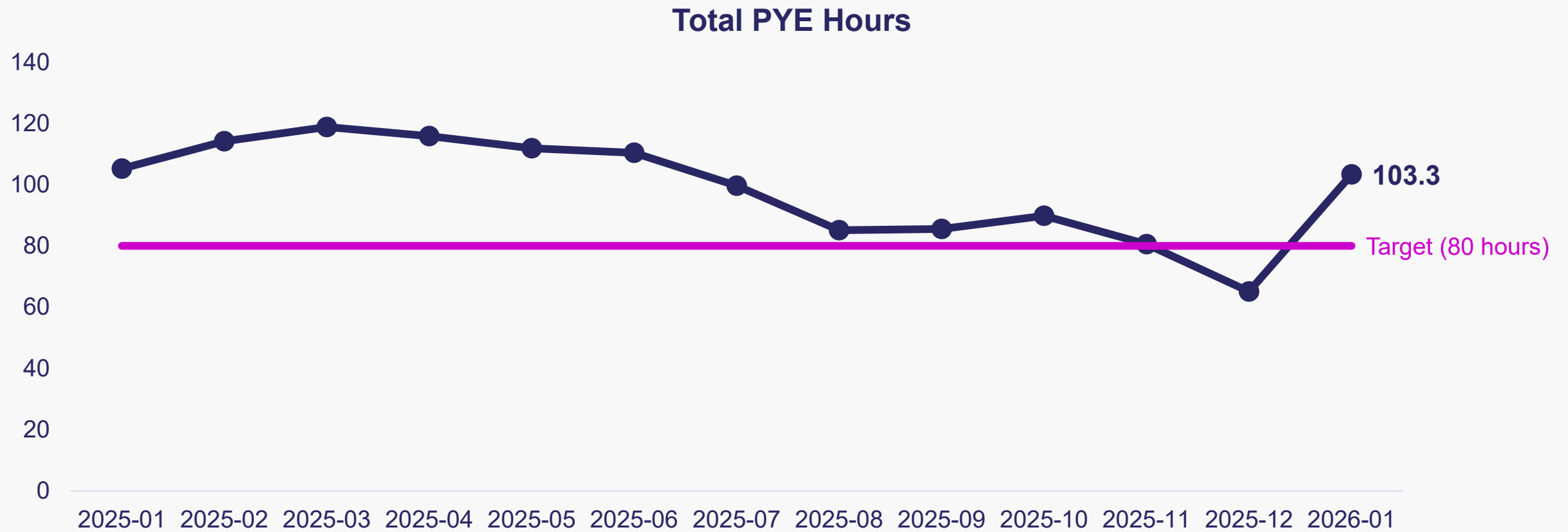

Total PYE hours increased last month

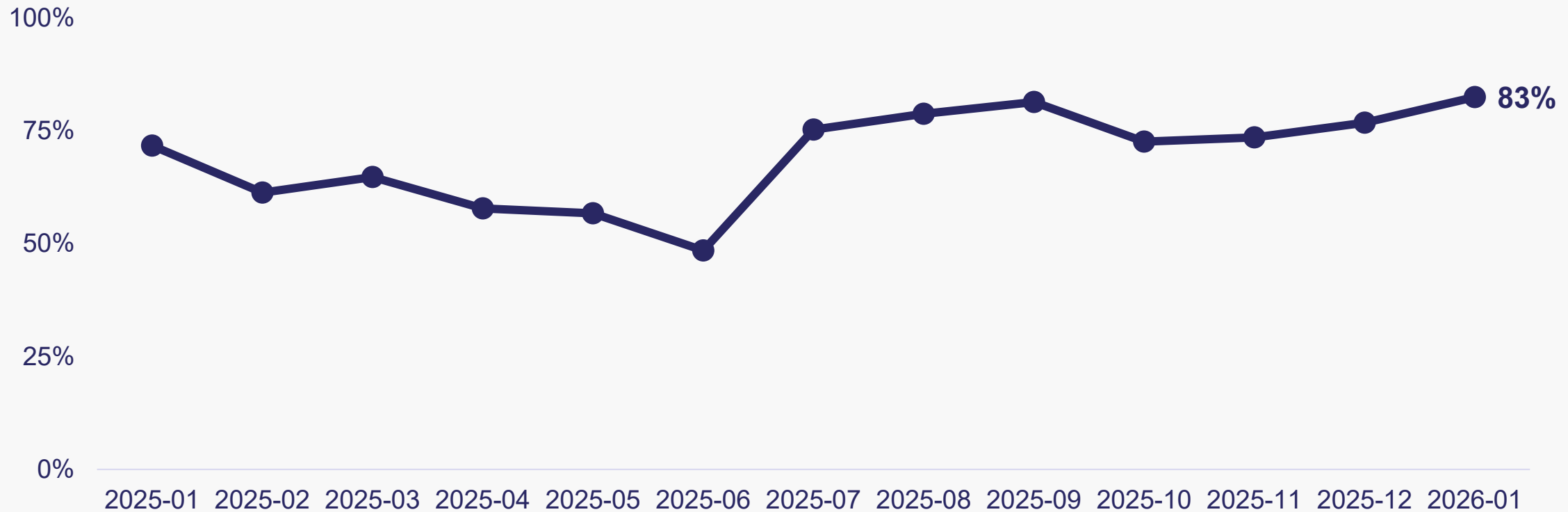

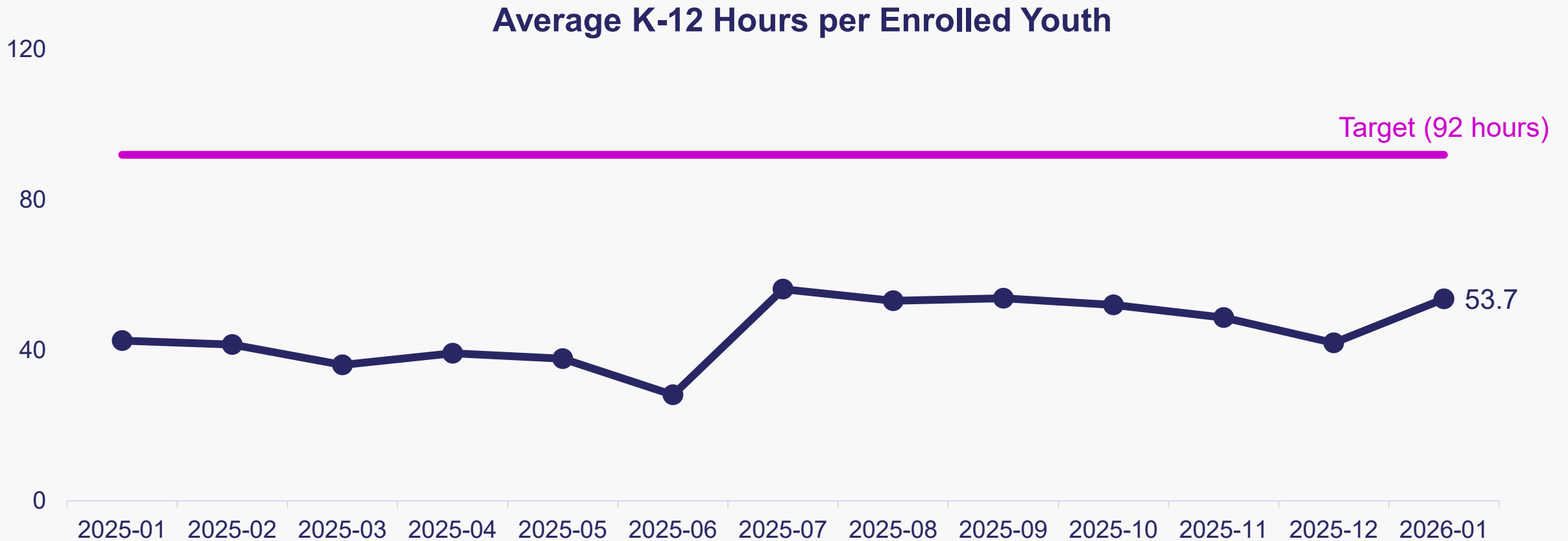
83% of youth enrolled in K-12 had documented attendance hours last month

% of Enrolled Youth who had K-12 Hours





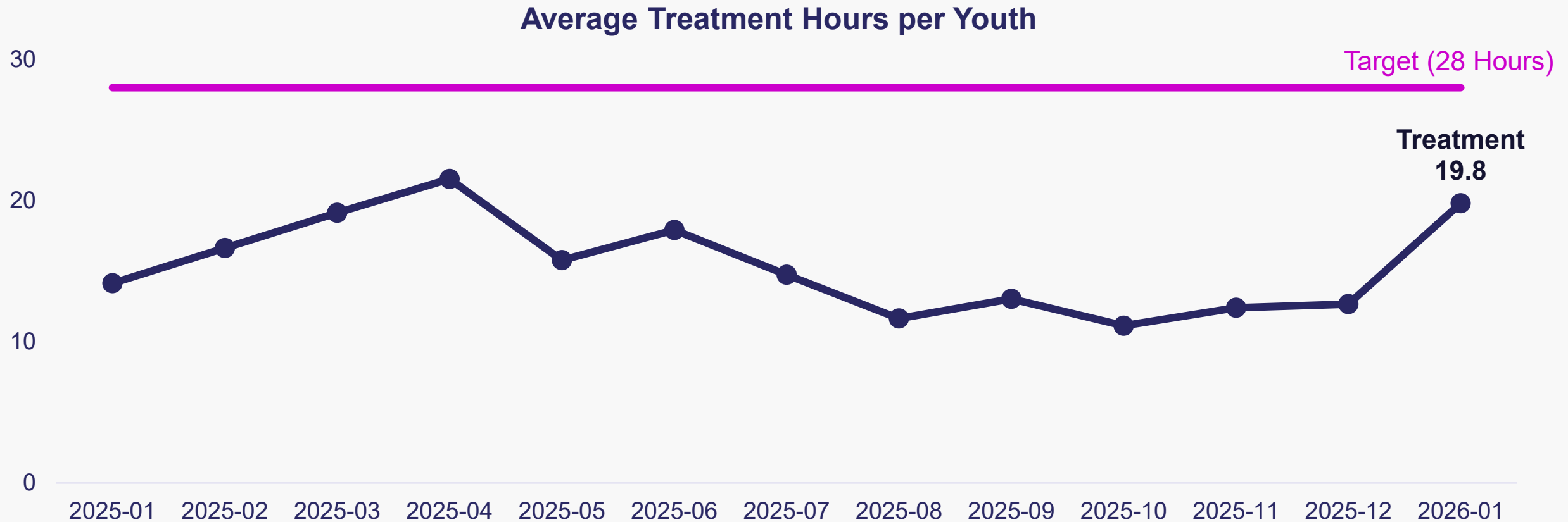
Enrolled youth averaged 53.7 hours of K-12 attendance last month

Treatment increased to 19.8 hours per youth last month





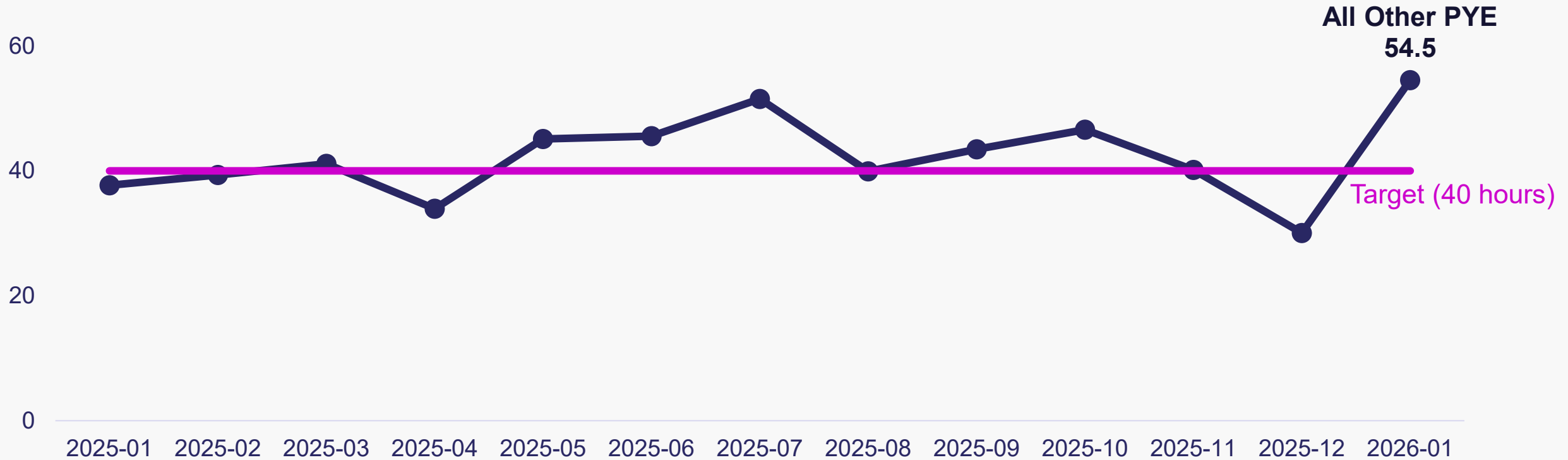
Safe Community Skill Development increased to 4.7 hours per youth





Other PYE hours increased to 54.5 hours per youth

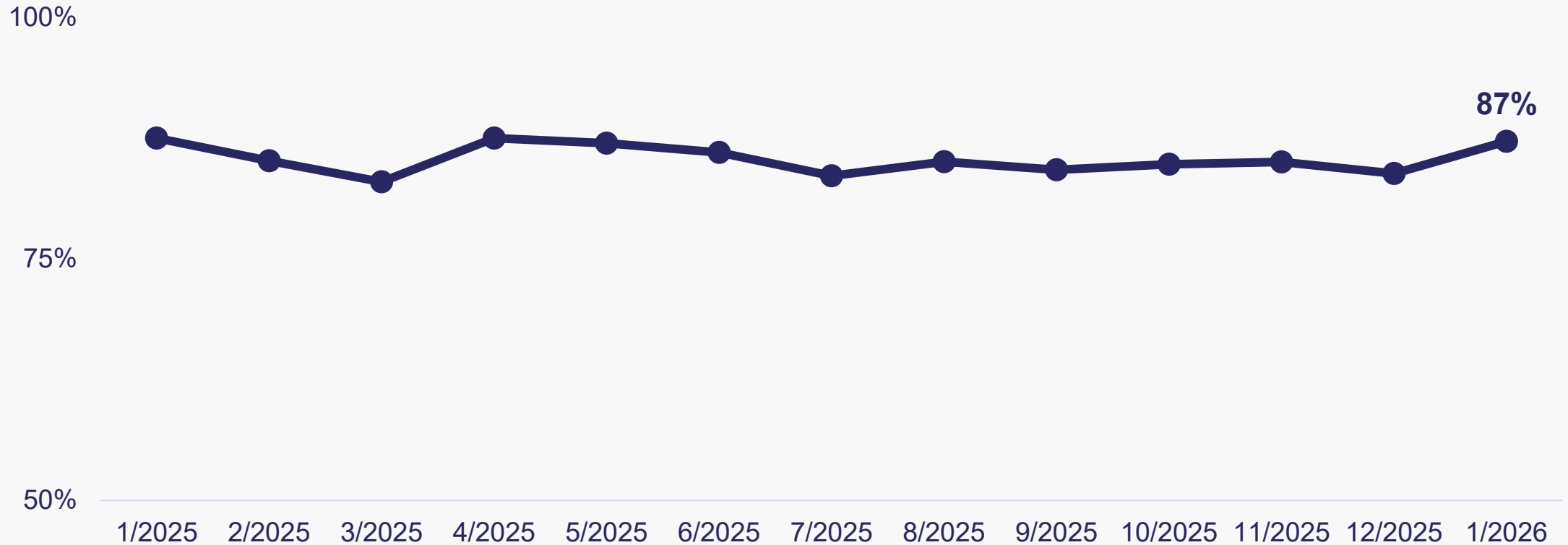

On-Time Documentation as % of Ordered Medication Doses

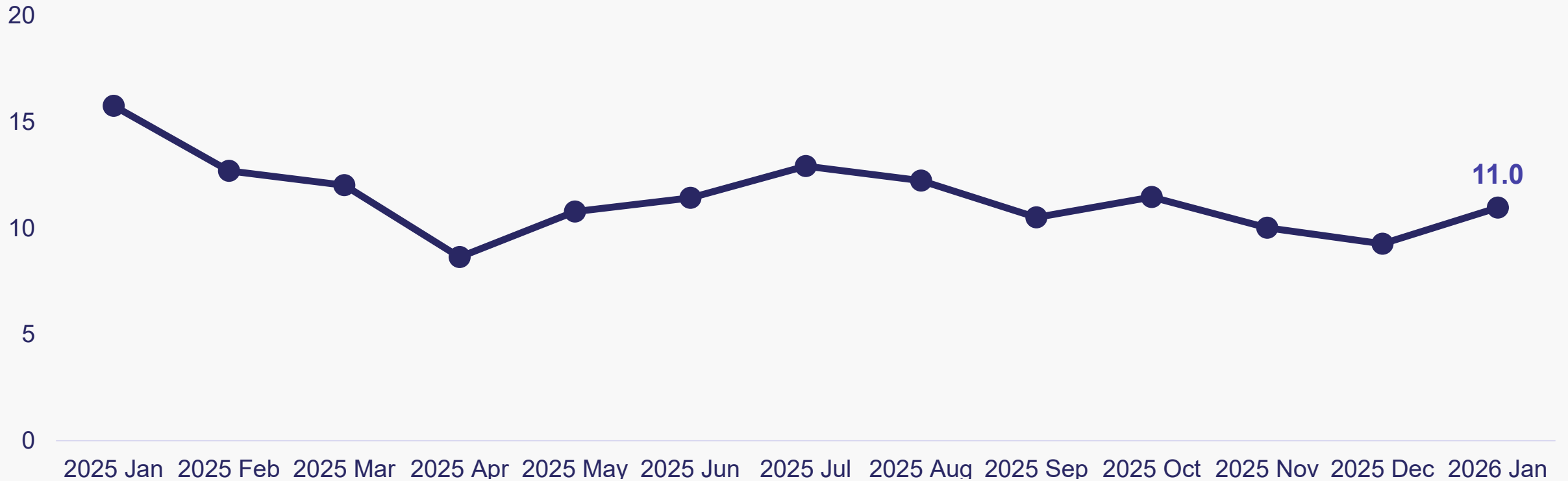




Sick Leave Hours per GLC

GLCs averaged 11 hours of sick leave last month

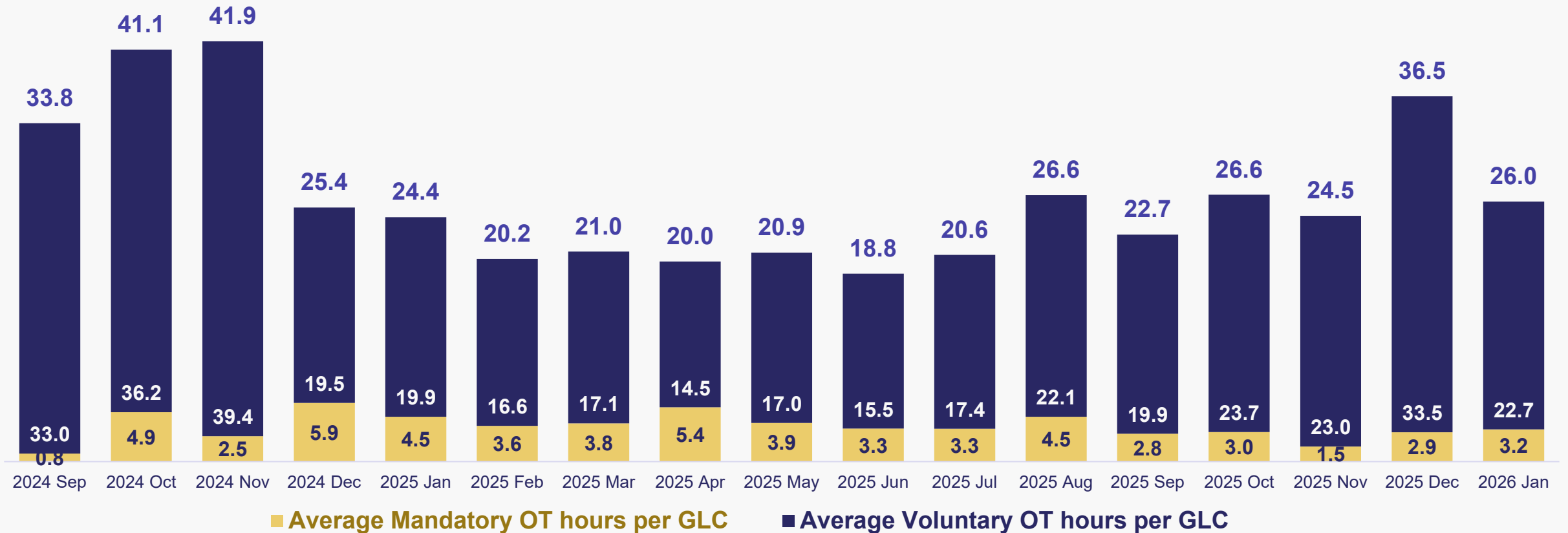
Average Sick Leave Hours per GLC





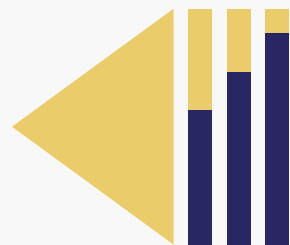
Average Overtime Hours per GLC
