Lord High School is a fully accredited high school within the state of Oregon. We offer a full schedule of classes taught in person by highly skilled teachers, aligned to state standards, and programmed to prepare youth for post-secondary success.

An **Oregon Modified Diploma also requires 24 credits, but the requirements in each content area are different. Youth must be served by Special Education in order to qualify for a Modified Diploma, you can find more information about these services under Special Education Services.*

Any youth who has not completed a HS Diploma or Equivalency is required to enroll in an educational program. Youth must be enrolled in a full day schedule (5 periods per day) and attend every day. Lord high school runs a year-round school schedule, with 4 quarters per year.
