Lane juvenile probation/parole office moving to downtown Eugene

The Oregon Youth Authority's probation and parole office will move Friday to downtown Eugene.

The office's new location will be Suite 180 at 115 W. Eighth Ave.

"This will increase accessibility for youth and families by putting the office in Eugene's downtown core, two blocks from the Lane Transit District bus station," said Debbi Martin, supervisor in OYA's Lane office. For the past 10 years the office has been housed with the county's Department of Youth Services at 2727 Martin Luther King Blvd., near Autzen Stadium.

The new phone number at OYA's Lane County office will be 541-684-2613.

OYA's Lane County office has a staff of seven juvenile probation and parole officers, one probation and parole assistant, a foster care certifier and support staff.

Effective community supervision of youth on probation and parole helps OYA fulfill its mission to protect public safety, reduce crime, hold youth offenders accountable and offer opportunities for reformation in safe environments. OYA juvenile probation and parole officers supervise approximately 1,050 youth in communities across Oregon. They also oversee approximately 750 youth offenders ages 12 to 24 in correctional and transitional facilities in Albany, Burns, Florence, Grants Pass, La Grande, Salem, Tillamook, Warrenton and Woodburn.
