PURPOSE/GOAL Provide the group with an update on GovDelivery email communication

Touching base on employer communication emails that have switched to GovDelivery. GovDelivery originally launched in 2017; in December 2018, we took all employer contacts from EDX system & uploaded them into GovDelivery. We took the job function we had on file. In time we will be able to better target communications to meet your needs. We can email communications relevant to a specific category rather than sending one email to everyone-i.e. school district, city, or local government. We'll be able to better streamline communication to applicable parties. Now that it is separate from EDX, please go into GovDelivery and make sure your staff is up to date. The tab that says "questions" is where you need to input your preferences. When you log in the questions appear to be optional, answer the questions to help us serve you better. GovDelivery is available by individual email or text messages. When we send communication, it will be according to what each individual has selected. We will add new staff in on a regular basis. We may be able to explore doing semi-regular reports to list people signed up and have their roles updated correctly, but GovDelivery doesn't contain employer information so this may be difficult. There is an opt-out option, so if someone's role has changed, they can individually change their own role; PERS will not be handling removing a role/contact. In the sign up process, you choose what and how often you want notifications. Subscriber preferences page- "Questions" tab is where to make changes- might not be obvious that this is where they need to make updates; something to consider communicating for the future. In the next months we can add a screen shot of the page in the Employer Newsletter and other resources so

employers know where to find it. Moving Employer Satisfaction Surveys from August to May to better reach our school employees. We have been trying to get better, more actionable feedback from our non-retirees, and this should help that effort.
