DEVICES AND SUPPLIES

PRESCRIPTIVE AUTHORITY - OREGON PHARMACIST

AUTHORITY and PURPOSE: Per ORS 689.645, a pharmacist may prescribe and dispense an FDA-approved drug or device, pursuant to a diagnosis by a health care practitioner who has prescriptive authority and who is qualified to make the diagnosis

- Following all elements outlined in <u>OAR 855-020-0110</u>, a pharmacist licensed and located in Oregon may prescribe the following devices and supplies:
 - Diabetic blood sugar testing supplies;
 - Injection supplies;
 - Nebulizers and associated supplies;
 - Inhalation spacers;
 - Peak flow meters;
 - International Normalized Ratio (INR) testing supplies;
 - Enteral nutrition supplies;
 - Ostomy products and supplies; and
 - Non-invasive blood pressure monitors
