Re: Renewal Information for Pharmacy Technician licenses expiring 6/30/2023

On February 16, 2022, the Oregon Board of Pharmacy adopted temporary rules regarding pharmacy technician licensure, found in Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 855, Divisions 025, 021 and 110. These changes included the option to renew a Pharmacy Technician (PT) license.

In the period of April 2022 - June 30, 2023, the total fees to renew a PT license is \$54.00. For additional information regarding applicable fees, please see OAR 855-110-0005(8).

Once renewed, a PT license will have an expiration date of 6/30/2024. No Continuing Education (CE) is required for the 6/30/2023 renewal of a PT license but will be required for renewal in 2024.

You must now do **one** of the following by June 30, 2023, to maintain active licensure:

## **OPTION 1**

Renew PT license no later than 6/30/2023.

- If you have taken and passed a national pharmacy technician certification exam offered by the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) or the National Healthcareer Association (NHA), you are now eligible to apply for licensure as a Certified Oregon Pharmacy Technician (COPT). Please submit a COPT license application as soon as possible to avoid a lapse in active licensure.
- Licensure as COPT is optional, for continued licensure. The PT license is renewable, and you may choose to remain licensed as a PT.

## **OPTION 2**

Take and pass a national certification exam and obtain licensure as a COPT prior to June 30, 2023.

- Once you have taken and passed the national certification exam, submit a COPT license application as soon as possible, but before June 30, 2023, to avoid a lapse in active licensure.
- Please check with your employer regarding any employer requirements to obtain national certification and hold COPT license.

## **Certified Oregon Pharmacy Technician License Information:**

If you have taken and passed a national pharmacy technician certification exam offered by the PTCB or the NHA, you are eligible to apply for licensure as a COPT. Please submit a COPT license application as soon as possible, but before June 30, 2023, to avoid a lapse in active licensure.

To ensure timely issuance of your COPT license, be sure to submit all required documents at the time of application. Submission of an incomplete application, delay in completing the fingerprinting requirement and the review of any arrest or violations of the law, will increase the time it takes for a license to be issued.

Please note: extension of a pharmacy technician license is no longer applicable. Your new COPT license will be issued once the Board receives a complete application and the license has been approved.

• If this occurs after 6/30/2023, you will need to renew your PT license to maintain active licensure until your COPT license is issued.

- All newly issued COPT licenses will have an expiration date of 6/30/2024.
- CE requirements for the 2024 renewal can be found in <u>OAR 855-021</u>.
- See OAR 855-135 for CE requirements effective 7/1/2023.
