7 **(3) Fees for initial licensure as a Pharmacist may be reduced to one half of a biennial rate**

9 ~~(3)~~ **(4)** A delinquent fee must be paid:

10 (a) When an application is postmarked after the date specified in these rules; or

11 (b) When the Board requests additional information from an applicant and this information is not
12 provided within 30 days.

13 ~~(4)~~ **(5)** A delinquent fee may be assessed when an application is submitted incomplete and the
14 Board requests the missing information.

19 **Licensing Fees**

20 (1) Pharmacist license examination (NAPLEX) and re-examination fee — \$50.

21 (2) Pharmacist jurisprudence (MPJE) re-examination fee — \$25.

22 (3) Pharmacist licensing by reciprocity fee — \$200*. (*Temporary revenue surplus fee reduction
23 pursuant to ORS 291.055(3)). Fee reduction shall be effective retroactive to July 1, 2013.

24 (4) Pharmacist licensing by score transfer fee — \$200*. (*Temporary revenue surplus fee
25 reduction pursuant to ORS 291.055(3)).

26 (5) Intern license fee. Expires November 30 every two years — \$50.

27 (6) Pharmacist:

- 28 (a) **Biennial** License fee. Expires June 30 **each odd numbered year.** ~~annually~~ **The biennial**
29 **license fee is** — \$120.* Delinquent renewal fee, (postmarked after May 31) — \$50.
30 (~~*Temporary revenue surplus fee reduction pursuant to ORS 291.055(3)~~).
- 31 (b) Electronic Prescription Monitoring Fund fee. Due by June 30 ~~annually~~ **biennially** — \$25 **50**.
32 (This is a mandatory fee, required by ORS 431.972 that must be paid with the pharmacist license
33 renewal fee).
- 34 (c) Workforce Data Collection fee. Due by June 30 **biennially** — \$5. (This is a mandatory fee, it
35 may be charged annually at \$2.50 per year as required by OAR 409-026-0130 that must be paid
36 with the pharmacist license renewal fee).
- 37 (7) Certification of approved provider of continuing education course fee, none at this time.
- 38 (8)(a) Pharmacy Technician license fee. (This is a one year non-renewable license unless under
39 the age of 19).— \$50.
- 40 (b) Under 19 years of age expires September 30 ~~annually~~ — \$50. Delinquent renewal fee,
41 (postmarked after August 31) — \$20.
- 42 (9) Certified Pharmacy Technician:
- 43 (a) License fee. Expires September 30 ~~annually~~ — \$50. Delinquent renewal fee, (postmarked
44 after August 31) — \$20.
- 45 (b) Workforce Data Collection fee. Due by June 30 ~~annually~~ **biennially** — \$5. (This is a mandatory fee, it
46 may be charged annually at \$2.50 per year as required by OAR 409-026-0130 that must be paid
47 with the Certified Pharmacy Technician license renewal fee.
