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A message to Oregon Consumers and Pharmacists:

Be aware that a new drug product, Zephrex-D, manufactured by Westport Pharmaceuticals in St. Louis, Missouri, is being marketed as a tamper-resistant formulation of pseudoephedrine 30mg that purportedly cannot be used for methamphetamine manufacture.

Note: Pseudoephedrine remains a Schedule III Controlled Substance in Oregon and does require a prescription, regardless of formulation.

OAR 855-080-0023(1): Schedule III consists of the drugs and other substances by whatever official, common, usual, chemical, or brand name designated, listed in 21 CFR part 1308.13; and

(1) Products containing pseudoephedrine or the salts of pseudoephedrine as an active ingredient.
