

Approved PSRB Administrative Board Meeting Minutes
Psychiatric Security Review Board
April 29, 2026

An administrative meeting of the Psychiatric Review Board was convened on Wednesday April 29, 2026, at 9:04 am via Microsoft Teams and teleconference. The meeting was recorded and posted on the Board's agency [website](#). The following provides a brief summary of the meeting minutes.

Chair Kenney opened the meeting at 9:04 am with all board members present. No public comments were offered.

Dr. Bort requested approval of the 2/24/26 meeting minutes. Dr. McKelvey motioned to accept, Chair Kenney seconded and Chair Kenney, Dr. McKelvey, Khara Kerns, Julie Duke, and Michele DesBrisay voted yes.

Dr. Bort announced an applicant has been chosen for the new alternate/senior board member position. Pending approval by the Governor and the Senate, the new member would start July 1, 2026. She reminded the board that this role – approved last year- is intended for a former board member who can support her and the board in their duties, vision, and future direction.

The Civil Commitment RAC update was presented, led by Alysson Bocciolatt, with Dr. Bort recognizing her work.

A draft has been submitted to OARD for review and, if accepted, will be posted to the bulletin. Dr. Bort walked the board through the PSRB rulemaking webpage, which includes RAC information and the 2026 Rulemaking Planning Calendar. The public hearing is scheduled for Monday, June 8 at 2:30 p.m., and written public comments may be submitted beforehand and will be posted online.

She asked the board to review the draft rules and send questions or additions prior to the June meeting, where the vote will occur.

The next RAC, covering victim issues and hearing procedures, is set for June 4, 2026. A fall RAC will address End of Jurisdiction and Conditional Release Processes to strengthen rules supporting clients and CR monitors.

Several board trainings have occurred, with more scheduled. Recent sessions included gun relief training and a tour of OSH Salem, where staff provided insight into campus operations. Dr. Bort and Chair Kenney expressed appreciation for the tour, and board members noted its value in understanding the wraparound care the staff provides clients and adding vital context to hearings. Dr. Bort also thanked all providers for their work with this specialized population, referencing earlier SRTF tours that highlighted varying levels of care.

Dr. Bort announced that the upcoming technology training will cover shifting the board's communications to Teams. She also reminded members to complete annual Workday trainings on cybersecurity and professional conduct.

Future board meetings are scheduled closely to allow timely rule votes and will be held June 10, July 15, and August 26. Additional trainings are being planned on confirmation bias, medications, and legal decisions related to mental health. An all-day working retreat is scheduled for October 2026.

Chair Kenney reopened public comment; none were offered. The meeting adjourned at 9:24 a.m.
