Updates

- ◆ 859-030-0016 Process to Reinstate Contact
 - ◆ victim requests have the same confidentiality as other items of the record.
 - ◆ References to "individual" instead of "person" for the PSRB client and "PSRB" instead of "Board"
 - ◆ Will be filed for Division 30
- ◆ 859-070-0022 Victim-Safety Considerations in Community Evaluations, Conditional Release Plans, and Conditional Release Modifications
 - ◆ Any provision in judgement placing under Board is retained unless modified
 - ◆ Eliminated redundant or unnecessary references to information handling
 - ◆ Clarified confidentiality and that limited information shall be shared and used for a decision
- ◆ 859-070-0027 State Requests for Victim-Safety Modifications of Conditional Release
 - ◆ 14-days for response for outpatient supervisor, State, client's attorney
 - ◆ Clarified route to submit the request: State to PSRB and client's attorney, PSRB to outpatient supervisor to discuss with client. Client receives formal notice if it goes to hearing.

Required Rulemaking Considerations

◆ **Fiscal Impact (ORS 183.335(2)(b)(E))**

- ◆ What fiscal impacts, if any, do you anticipate these proposed rules may have on state agencies, local governments, or the public? Please consider both direct and indirect costs, potential cost shifts, and any operational or administrative impacts that may result from implementation.

◆ **Small Business Impact (ORS 183.336)**

- ◆ What potential economic effects might these proposed rules have on small businesses? In your view, are there aspects of the rules that could result in a significant impact, and are there ways those impacts could be minimized while still achieving the purpose of the rule?

◆ **Racial Equity Impact**

- ◆ How might the adoption of these proposed rules affect racial equity in Oregon? Please consider whether the rules may have differing impacts across communities, including potential unintended consequences, and identify any opportunities to mitigate disparities or promote more equitable outcomes.

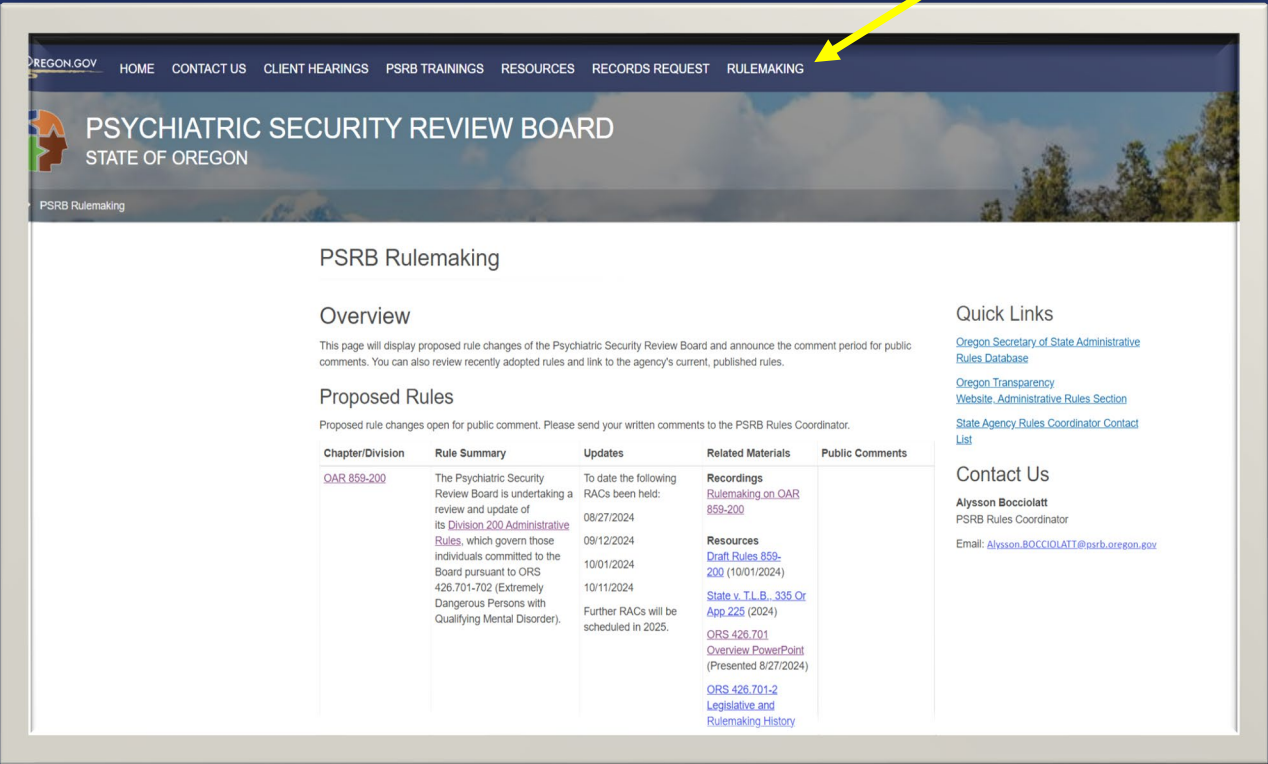

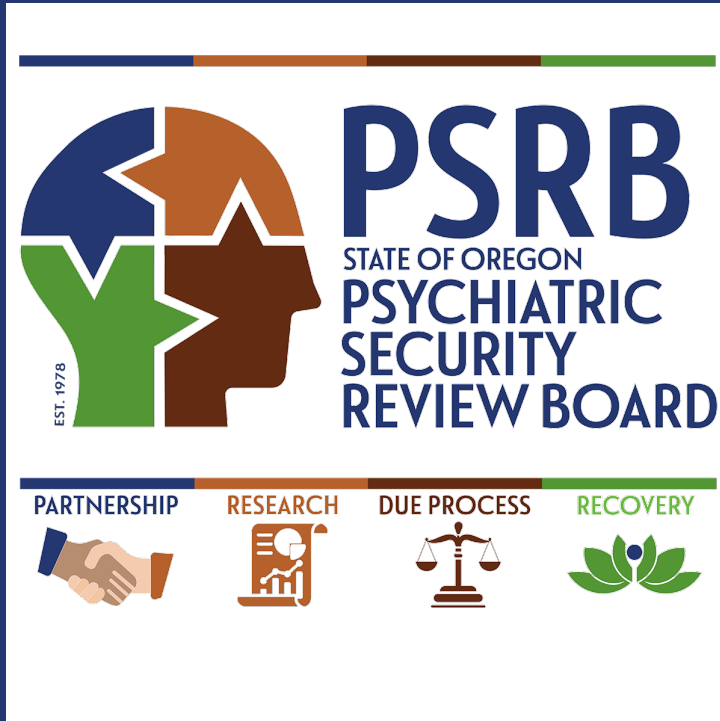
