

SAMPLE/Affidavit in Support of Revocation

I, Susan Johnson, being first duly sworn and on oath, depose and say:

I am the Bark County Behavioral Health Director.

John Jones is on conditional release under the jurisdiction of the Psychiatric Security Review Board pursuant to an order signed on July 23, 2014.

On August 14, 2014, I spoke by telephone with Jessie Smith, QMHP, Bark County PSRB Case Manager. Mr. Smith was designated by the Board as having primary reporting responsibilities in Mr. Jones's case. Mr. Smith reported that from the time Mr. Jones was conditionally released from the Oregon State Hospital to Watery Creek, a residential treatment facility located in Bark County, there were immediately concerns regarding his affect, demeanor and willingness to abide by the facility rules. Within 24 hours of Mr. Jones's arrival at Watery Creek there were some "red flags" such as Mr. Jones intimidating staff there. In the weeks leading up to the most recent incident of August 1, 2014, Mr. Jones started disengaging in groups and acting in such a way that there was suspicion about whether or not he had been using illegal substances.

On August 1, 2014, Mr. Smith noticed that Mr. Jones had not taken his morning medication and that he had missed his group therapy. Mr. Smith later met with John Jones and asked him why he had not taken his morning medications and why he had missed that group. Mr. Jones told Mr. Smith that the voices did not want him to take drugs or go to groups. Jessie Smith also noticed that John Jones was not keeping his room clean, no longer wanted to attend 12-Step meetings and appeared to be generally agitated. Staff at the facility also approached Mr. Smith with concerns about John Jones' recent behavior and noticeable mental health decompensation.

Based on the above information, it is my recommendation that John Jones's conditional release be revoked and that he be ordered transported to Oregon State Hospital for care, custody and treatment.
