

# Acceptable Documentation for Oregon Lifeline

## Program Documentation

If you are applying for Oregon Lifeline on the basis of Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8), Veterans or Survivors Pension benefits, or any of the tribal benefits, please submit a document that includes:

- Your name,
  - The name of the Lifeline-qualifying program,
  - The government department that issued the document, and
  - An issue date within the last 12 months or a future expiration date that aligns with the benefit period.

## Income Documentation

If you are applying on the basis of total annual household income at 135% or less of the federal poverty guidelines (see chart below), please submit one or more of the following documents.

| Household Size | Total Household income |
|----------------|------------------------|
| 1              | \$17,226               |
| 2              | \$23,274               |
| 3              | \$29,322               |
| 4              | \$35,370               |
| 5              | \$41,418               |
| 6              | \$47,466               |
| 7              | \$53,514               |
| 8              | \$59,562               |
| 9              | \$65,610               |

For each additional person, add \$6,048.

- Last year's federal or state income tax return
- Current annual income statement from employer
- Pay stubs for any three consecutive months within the last 12 months
- Veteran's administration statement of benefits
- Unemployment or Workers' Compensation statement of benefits
- Social Security statement of benefits
- Retirement or Pension statement of benefits
- Divorce decree or Child Support documentation containing income information

If documentation of income does not cover a full year, such as current pay stubs, submit documentation that covers three months in a row within the past 12 months.
