## Clean energy investments are creating a more sustainable energy future.

### Since 2002, our work has:

Saved and generated **1,006 aMW** of electricity

Saved **87 million therms** of natural gas

Avoided **22.3 million tons** of carbon dioxide

Installed **20,000 solar systems** at homes and businesses

Added **\$10.4 billion** to Oregon's economy

Saved **\$5.3 billion** on customer energy bills

Energy Trust is governed by a volunteer board of directors and guided by three stakeholder advisory councils. Every unit of energy saved and generated is reported in our quarterly and annual reports. Every dollar received is accounted for in our monthly, quarterly and annual financial statements.

## Who we serve:

Energy Trust serves 2 million customers of the state's investor-owned electric and natural gas utilities. In 2021, 90% of Oregonians were eligible for our services, including residential, commercial and industrial customers.
