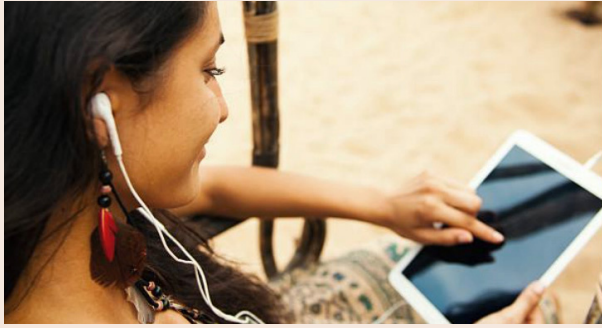


How Do I Qualify?



- ▶ Be at least 18 years or older, live on federally-recognized tribal land, and receive one of the following benefits:

No documentation required:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Medicaid

Documentation required:

- Federal Housing Assistance (Section 8)
- Veterans or Survivors Pension
- Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) General Assistance
- Tribal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (Tribal TANF)
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations
- Tribal Head Start (Only Households that meet the income qualifying standard)
- Total household income is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines

Oregon Lifeline is a federal and state government program that provides a monthly discount of up to \$37.25 on phone or up to \$41.25 on broadband service for qualifying low-income residents on federally-recognized Tribal lands.



Tribal Link Up

- ▶ Provides qualifying Tribal residents with a one-time discount of up to \$100 on the initial installation or activation of wireline or wireless phone service.
- ▶ Allows residents to pay the remaining amount that they owe on a deferred schedule, interest free.

Qualifying Tribal residents may be eligible for Link Up again only after moving to a new primary residence. Not all wireline or wireless phone companies offer Tribal Link Up.

How Do I Apply?

Choose one option:

1 Discounted Service

You may qualify for a discount on your phone or broadband service with a participating company in your area.

or

2 Free Monthly Wireless Phone Service

You may qualify for free wireless phone service.
