

Obtaining service from someone other than the COLR


- Wireless Internet Service Providers

Reasons why this is not happening everywhere?

- Rural areas are sparsely populated – Makes for a hard financial business case
- Landscapes provide challenges and can require additional resources
- The secluded end user gets forgotten
