

PUC Migration Plan to Valence system

March 24, 2026

Migration from BizApps, eDockets, and Huddle to Valence

On Thursday, May 28, the PUC will take down its current docketing and discovery systems at 8:00 a.m. to prepare for the switch to its new Valence docketing and discovery system.

This means that the Filing Center will not be able to process filings, and Huddle will not be available for discovery.

On Monday, June 1, the new Valence Docketing and Discovery system will Go Live at 9:00 a.m.

To allow time for the Filing Center to process filings that may have been sent to the Filing Center during the downtime and to process log in requests from external users, the Filing Center will not be accepting filings until Wednesday, June 3 at 8:00 a.m.

Similarly, the Discovery Process will need to halt until June 3 at 8:00 a.m. to allow the Utility Support Power Users to set up access to discovery docketing.

When considering and setting docket schedules, do not set due dates between May 27 at 3:00 p.m. and June 3 at 8:00 a.m. to facilitate the transition to the new Valence system. Also please review your existing procedural schedules and revise as necessary to accommodate these dates.

Planned schedule for Go Live:

Filing Center Closed	May 28, 2026, at 8:00 a.m.
Discovery (Huddle) Closed	May 28, 2026, at 8:00 a.m.
Filing Center and Discovery open only for access requests from external users	June 1, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.
Filing Center and Discovery open for all business	June 3, 2026, at 8:00 a.m.

Also, it is important to note that existing links to documents in eDockets will not work once we switch to the new system. For example, if in a past public meeting staff report, staff linked to orders or other documents in eDockets, the links in those historical documents will not work.
