ORDER ON DEFAULT AND ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

- 1.1 On September 4, 2013, the Real Estate Commissioner issued, by certified mail, a notice of intent to levy civil penalty against Richard Matthews (Matthews) The Real Estate Agency (OREA) sent the notice of intent to Richard Matthew's last known address of record with the OREA. The notice of intent was also mailed to Matthews by regular first class mail in a handwritten envelope.
- 1.2 The certified mailing was returned to the OREA as "Unclaimed Unable to Forward." The first class mailing was not returned to the OREA.
- 1.3 Over twenty (20) days have elapsed since the mailing of the notice issued in this matter and no written request for hearing has been received.
- 1.4 Copies of the entire investigation file are designated as the record for purposes of default, including any submission from respondent and all information in the administrative file relating to the mailing of notices and any responses received.

Based upon the foregoing and upon a review of the above described investigation reports, documents and files, the Real Estate Commissioner finds:

2.1 Oregon Administrative Rule 863-001-0006 states, in part, that a notice of intent is properly served when deposited in the United States mail, registered or certified mail, addressed to the real estate licensee or to any other person having an interest in a proceeding before the Commissioner at the licensee's or other person's last known address of record with OREA.

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ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to ORS 696.397, Matthews immediately cease and desist from engaging in any management of rental real estate as defined in ORS 696.010(11) unless Matthews first obtains a license from the OREA to perform management of rental real estate. In addition, pursuant to ORS 696.990, and based upon the violation set forth above, Matthews, pay a civil penalty in the sum of \$500.00, said penalty be paid to the General Fund of the State Treasury by paying the same to the OREA.
